JOHNSTON AND GARCÍA HOMER IN 5-4 WIN

Troy Johnston finished a triple shy of the cycle, Avisaíl García homered and Patrick Monteverde pitched 5.2 strong innings Friday to win his Triple-A debut for the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in a 5-4 victory over the Gwinnett Stripers in front of 5.775 fans at 121 Financial Ballpark. After falling behind 1-0, the Jumbo Shrimp answered with Johnston's first homer with Jacksonville in 2023, to take a 2-1 lead. Avi blasted another two-run homer in the bottom of the third, giving Jacksonville a three-run lead. Trailing 5-2 in the eighth, the Stripers came back with two runs in the eighth but Jacksonville held on 5-4.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 42 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 65-for-177 at the plate, slashing .367/.412/.480/.892 with six doubles, one triple. four home runs, 26 RBIs and 37 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in the International League in batting average (.349) and tied for seventh in OBP (.419). Among the 296 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances. Edwards ranks third in swingingstrike rate (4.1 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 50 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-175 (.291/.371/.663/1.034) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.3 percent of the time in 2023.

NFFD FOR SPFFD

Xavier Edwards stole a base successfully on Saturday, pushing his personal streak to 24 attempts in a row without getting caught. The Jumbo Shrimp as a whole have been one of the best teams in baseball in stealing bases; lacksonville's 84.6 percent stolen base success rate is second in Triple-A and third out of the 120 full season MiLB teams. Only two Jumbo Shrimp have been caught stealing since July 9, with the club swiping 17 bags in that span.

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 29 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 43-for-128, hitting .336/.380/.453/.833 with 10 doubles, one triple, one home run, 12 RBIs and 23 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 11 multi-hit games in his last 18 games, batting 31-for-84 (.369/.398/.488/.886) with seven doubles, one homer, eight RBIs and 15 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 222 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the fourth-highest opposite field rate (44.5 percent). His 30.2 percent line drive rate is seventh.

ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 19 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 8-11, with all but one of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those 11 defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 53 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -25 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester, Nashville & Gwinnett).

THE PENDUIUM SWINGS

Jacksonville started their series at Nashville with strong performances from their bullpen. In the first two games against Nashville, Shrimp relievers surrendered only one run on seven hits in 11.0 innings of work, combining for 12 strikeouts against seven walks. However, things devolved quickly from there; over the next three contests, Jacksonville's relief corps combined to allow 21 runs, all earned, on 24 hits in 17.0 innings with 23 strikeouts against 12 walks. Over the last five games, the bullpen has regained its footing, firing 18.1 innings of seven-run ball, ceding nine hits and nine walks while picking up 22 strikeouts.
