Moring Game Part Two

The Fightin Phils remain home following a season-long two week/13-game road trip at New Hampshire and Portland. It is the second of 12 matchups between Reading and the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, this season. Wednesday is the second-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium, before the teams meet for six games at FNB Field in Harrisburg from July 21-26. Reading went 4-8 against Harrisburg in 2025, which included taking two-of-six games in both series with the Senators. The Fightin Phils lead the season series 1-0 over Harrisburg after Tuesday afternoon's win.

Offense Back Clicking

The Reading Fightin Phils improved to 22-24 with a dominant 10-1 win over the Harrisburg Senators in the series opener at FirstEnergy Stadium, breaking out for 13 hits after a quiet stretch in Portland. Aaron Escobar jumpstarted the offense with a first-inning solo home run, and Bryson Ware added a sacrifice fly in the second to make it 2-0. Harrisburg got on the board in the third, but Reading responded in the fourth when Austin Murr delivered a two-run single to extend the lead. Murr stayed hot in the eighth, launching a solo homer to spark a six-run inning as the Fightin Phils pulled away. Ware and Dante Nori each drew bases-loaded walks, and Dylan Campbell capped the surge with a bases-clearing double. Braydon Tucker earned the win with a season-best seven innings, allowing just one run on five hits while striking out four. Murr, Alex Binelas, and Erick Brito led the offense with multi-hit performances as Reading controlled the game on both sides of the ball.

Still In It

Despite a tough week at Portland, and a 5-8 road trip between Maine and New Hampshire, the Fightin Phils still see themselves just 3.0 games back of first place New Hampshire in the Northeast Division Standings. There are 23 games and four series remaining in the first half, which ends on Sunday, June 21. Reading will play Portland and Hartford during the final two weeks of the first half in what is an extremely tight race for the first half Northeast Division crown.

An Impressive Trend Ends

With Reading dropping five-of-six games at Portland, the Fightin Phils dropped their first six game series of the season. Prior to last week, the R-Phils had won three series, tied three and their only other series defeat was a three-game sweep by Akron to open the season. By this point last season, Reading had already lost four six-game series, so the Fightin Phils are still way ahead of their pace from 2025.

Wood You Believe It

Phillies No. 2 prospect, and top pitching prospect, Gage Wood made his Double-A debut last Friday night and is scheduled to make his FirstEnergy Stadium debut on Thursday this week. On Friday, Wood struck out six over three innings and his lone blemish was a solo home run by Boston's top prospect Franklin Arias to lead off the bottom of the first. Wood was promoted to Reading from Clearwater (A) on Monday, skipping High-A Jersey Shore. He joined the Fightin Phils after just nine-career starts with Clearwater. With the Threshers, Wood was 0-2, with a 3.42 ERA (10 ER, 26.1 IP) over eight starts. He had sent down 40 batters on stikes, good for a 13.67 SO/9.0 IP mark, which was 7th in the FSL amongst pitchers with at least 20.0 IP. At the time of his promotion, Wood was seventh in the Florida State League in strikeouts. Wood joins the Fightin Phils less than one year following his selection in the first round (26th overall) by the Phillies out of Arkansas, where he pitched from 2023-25.

Pitching Powers

The Fightin Phils pitching staff continued their recent strong stretch with a strong road trip at New Hampshire and Portland. Over their last 17 games (since May 8), Reading leads all of Double-A with a 2.50 ERA (38 ER, 136.2 IP). On the season, the R-Phils team 4.12 ERA ranks second in the Eastern League, which comes after finishing last in the league with a 4.58 ERA in 2025. Reading's pitching staff has also showcased some of the best control in the league as well, issuing the fewest walks in the league at 137, which is well ahead of the second fewest, Portland with 171. Strong fielding has helped out the Fightin Phils pitching staff, as Reading enters play on Wednesday with a .979 fielding percentage, which is second best in the Eastern League.

Money McFarlane

Alex McFarlane continued his excellent season with a scoreless inning on Tuesday. On the season, the Phillies No. 17 prospect has a 0.51 ERA (1 ER, 17.2 IP). McFarlane has not allowed an earned run in 12-straight outings and has not allowed one in 17-of-18 appearances on the season. Amongst Eastern League pitchers that have fired at least 17.0 IP this season, McFarlane has the lowest ERA at 0.51.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 27, 2015: At New Hampshire, Reading pounds out 21 hits in a 12-10 win over the Fisher Cats. All 9 Fightin Phils starters have at least one hit and all but Gabriel Lino have multi-hit games. Tony Thomas has the biggest night, going 3-for-5 with a homer, 2 doubles, 4 RBI and 2 runs scored.

Here Comes Harrisburg

Harrisburg enters play today with a 24-22 record, which is third in the Eastern League's Southwest Division. The Senators most recently split a series at home against Akron and return home next week to welcome Somerset. Harrisburg's roster features seven of the National's Top-30 prospects: Travis Sykora (2), Jarlin Susana (3), Alex Clemmey (12), Alejandro Rosario (16), Sam Peterson (23), Eriq Swan (26) and Caleb Lomavita (27).

Hurling for Harrisburg

Lefty, and Nationals' No. 12 prospect, Alex Clemmey makes his 10th start of the season for Harrisburg. So far, Clemmey is 1-2, with a 4.67 ERA (18 ER, 34.2 IP), along with 45 strikeouts (11.68 SO/9.0 IP). He last pitched on Thursday against Akron, allowing one run on two hits over six innings, with a season-high 11 strikeouts. Clemmey split 2025 between Wilmington (A+) and Harrisburg, combining to go 7-5, with a 3.47 ERA (45 ER, 116.2 IP), along with 136 strikeouts. He began his pro career in 2024 between Lynchburg (A) in the Guardians' system and Fredericksburg (A). Clemmey was traded to Washington in 2024 in a deal that sent Lane Thomas to Cleveland. The Guardians took the 20-year old in the second round of the 2023 draft out of Bishop Hendricken High School in Warwick, Rhode Island.
