TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds continue a six-game series against the Durham Bulls (Triple-A, Tampa Bay) at the Durham Bulls Athletic Park on Friday night. Right-handed pitcher Adam Kloffenstein is scheduled to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Nathan Wiles for Durham.
ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Memphis Redbirds continued a six-game road trip with a 1-0 loss at the Durham Bulls (Triple-A, Tampa Bay) on Thursday night at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. Right-handed pitcher Michael McGreevy (25) dominated the Bulls lineup in the loss. The right-handed pitcher allowed just one run on five hits, walked none and struck out 11 in the 8.0-inning complete game. The complete game is the third for Memphis this season and the first longer than 7.0 innings. At the plate, the Redbirds recorded just four hits on the night. Catcher Gavin Collins and designated hitter Jordan Walker each led the way with a double. Memphis stranded all six of its baserunners, including the would-be tying run in the top of the ninth inning.
MEMPHIS IN MAY: The Memphis Redbirds are off to a hot start to the month of May. Entering the series at Durham, the Redbirds are 12-6 in the month and are now a season-high three games above .500. Offensively, Memphis ranks third in the International League in batting average (.276), first in slugging (.471), tied-first in doubles (46), tied-4th fewest in strikeouts (139). Outfielder Matt Koperniak leads the way at the blate, batting . 382 with five doubles, two home runs and 11 RBIs. Infielder Cesar Prieto currenlty boasts an 1.111 OPS in May. On the mound, the Redbirds staff has dominated. The group has the fourth-best ERA in the International League this month (4.10) and has the lowest runs allowed per nine innings of any staff in the league (4.33). In six relief appearances this month, Jacob Bosiokovic is $2-0$ with a 1.00 ERA in 9.0 innings pitched. The right-handed pitcher has struck out 12 batters.

HAPPY 25th, AZP: To commemorate the 25th anniversary season of Redbirds baseball at AutoZone Park, the Redbirds will host a plethora of promotions and theme nights to celebrate. Since the opening of the downtown ballpark in 2000, many credit the stadium with the revitalization of downtown Memphis. The support of the Redbirds at AutoZone Park caught the attention of Michael Heisley, who then brought the Grizzlies to the city. "(AutoZone Park) was a catalyst for a lot of the things that downtown is today," Memphis Redbirds President and General Manager Craig Unger said. "So, I think even to this day today, you still see development going on around here. The Commonwealth building a few years ago, you know, Stewart and the group there that, that did that building talked about AutoZone Park. This entire block around Madison is still the catalyst for growth there. Sports is that catalyst."
BASEBALL AMERICA OUTLOOK: The St. Louis Cardinals enter the 2024 season with the No. 20 Minor League system in all of baseball according to BaseballAmerica. St. Louis currently has five players ranked in the Top-100 (No. 39 Masyn Winn, MLB, No. 75 Tekoah Roby, AA, No. 83 Victor Scott II, MLB, No. 84 Tink Hence, AA, No. 85 Thomas Saggese, AAA). BaseballAmerica's preview on the Cardinals system states "Jordan Walker's successful graduation to the majors has dropped the Cardinals' farm system back, though exciting up-the-middle hitters like Masyn Winn and Victor Scott II are ready to follow Walker to St. Louis. Getting the most out of arms like Tekoah Roby and Tink Hence is going to be crucial. The Cardinals pulled off the neat trick of adding two Top 100 Prospects when they dealt Jordan Montgomery to the Rangers for Roby and Thomas Saggese in July.

Ben Johnson enters his sixth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his sixth year in the Cardinals organization.

Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

TODAY'S START: Right-handed pitcher Adam Kloffenstein is scheduled to start game four of a six-game series at the Durham Bulls on Friday night.
LAST TIME OUT: The right-handed pitcher put together his best home start of the season last week against the Gwinnett Stripers. Kloffenstein allowed one run on three hits, walked one and struck out three to earn his first win of the season.

ROAD TO TRIPLE-A: For Kloffenstein, it hasn't been a quick rise through the minor leagues. The right-handed pitcher was drafted by Toronto in 2018. Kloffenstein reached Double-A New Hampshire last seson after his first six appearances at High-A Vancouver. In 36 appearances ( 35 starts) in his career with New hampshire, he holds a $7-10$ record with a 4.63 ERA. In 17 starts this season, he went 5-5 and was among the Eastern League leaders in ERA (2nd, 3.24), strikeouts (4th, 105), innings pitched (3rd, 89), average against (5th, .236), and WHIP (7th, 1.27).
MLB PIPELINE REPORT: " Standing tall on the mound at 6 -foot5 , Kloffenstein runs a low-90s sinker in on righties that helps him limit damage against same-side bats and generate groundball rates around 50 percent, and he can run a four-seamer up to 96 . He can work with both a mid-80s sweeper and an upper-80s cutter -- the latter of which came as a result of constant tinkering that led him to utilize a pitch with shorter action. It plays well off the two-seam and has helped fuel Kloffenstein's rise in K's. He'll show the makings of a curveball and changeup too, but the righty is often at his best when he's working east-west. Kloffenstein's walk rate has similarly improved as he's grown more confident in his stuff. Even during the dips in his rollercoaster career, the former TCU commit previously impressed Toronto brass by staying healthy and regularly taking his spots in the rotation. Now with sharper stuff and still young in his age-22 season, his chances at being a backend Major League starter are his best in years.
ALL-STAR: Kloffenstein was a Northwest League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star in 2019. In 80 career appearances before joining the Cardinals organization, 79 starts, he is $18-23$ with a 4.57 ERA and 398 strikeouts in 368.2 innings.
