ABOUT LAST NIGHT... A six-run opening frame and five shutout innings of relief from Adrian Hernandez led the Vancouver Canadians to a 9-5 win over the Everett AquaSox (Mariner) Thursday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

The C's led wire-to-wire thanks to six runs on five hits in the bottom of the first. Back-to-back walks got things started for Cameron Eden, who singled home the first run of the game. An error brought in another run then Luis De Los Santos delivered an RBI single to make it 3-0. Ryan Gold grounded into a force out that plated another tally before Rafael Lantigua hit his first home run of the year, a two-run shot that put the Canadians up 6-0.

Hernandez (W, 2-0) - who entered the game to start the fifth with the score 8-5 after starter Adam Kloffenstein went four innings and allowed five runs on six hits with three walks and five strikeouts - was nearly perfect in the third Advanced-A outing of his career. The 21-year-old baffled the potent AquaSox offense for five innings and allowed just two base runners on a pair of walks to go with a season-high nine strikeouts. He has logged ten innings of relief this year and surrendered three hits, walked four and struck out 15.

Despite a six-run lead after the first inning that proved to be the difference, Vancouver added a pair of runs in the second on a walk, an Eden triple and an RBI groundout from Spencer Horwitz.

Everett scored a run in the second, two in the third and two more in the fourth to chase Kloffenstein, but that would be all the 'Sox offense would muster.

Tanner Kirwer belted his team-high sixth home run of the season in the sixth for the final run of the night as the C's went on to win 9-5.

Eden paced the offense with two hits, two RBI and two runs scored while Kirwer finished with a pair of hits, two runs, an RBI, a walk and a stolen base. Tanner Morris contributed a hit, scored twice and worked two free passes.

FEELING FROGGY: Everett returns to Hillsboro this week for their second series of the season with Vancouver. The 'Sox last hopped into town May 25-30 when the C's split a six-game set. The Mariners affiliate has been ranked as one of the most prospect-laden rosters in all of baseball and have lived up to that billing; they have outscored the Canadians 50-39 this season and have plated a league-best 246 runs.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY: June 18, 1973 - The A's stage a Father's Day's Mustache Day promotion, giving fans with hair above their upper lip free admission into the ballpark. Charlie Finley offers his players a \$300 bonus for growing facial hair for the event, and all do except Vida Blue, who is still bitter about his recent contract negotiations with the team owner.

LIGHT ON THE LONG BALL: The C's pitching staff has surrendered 24 home runs this year, the second fewest in Advanced-A. Hudson Valley has given up 23 dingers, but Vancouver has pitched 31.2 more innings than the Renegades.

BIG INNINGS: Vancouver scored six runs in the first inning yesterday, the most they've scored in the opening frame this year and the second-most in a single frame this season. They set a season high with seven runs in the fifth on Tuesday night in a 16-9 loss.

TOOLS: Tanner Kirwer leads the league in stolen bases (24) and is the team leader in home runs (6). He stole a base and hit a home run in yesterday's win. The C's are 5-1 when he goes deep.

THAT'S A LOT OF Ks: Tonight's starter Luis Quinones is averaging an eye-popping 15.4 K/9 this year.

ON THE HILL: Luis Quinones climbs the slope for Vancouver in what will be his third start of the year. After consecutive dominant outings, the right-hander had a small hiccup in his last turn on June 10 in Spokane; that day, the Arcibco, PR native only allowed two runs on one hit with eight strikeouts, but he issued a team-high six walks through four innings pitched to take the loss. Despite that, Quinones has been nearly untouchable in his first Advanced-A season. In 14 innings, the 23-year-old has surrendered just three hits (opponents average: .071) and K'd 24 batters. He was a 34th round pick in the 2019 draft out of San Jacinto JC in Texas.

MLB.com's #13 Mariners prospect Levi Stoudt gets his second taste of the C's tonight. The right-hander faced Vancouver on May 26, when he gave up three runs on four hits - including a Davis Schneider home run - with season-high six walks and four strikeouts.
