SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels split a doubleheader against the Sea Dogs. In Game 1, Logan Wyatt opened a 1-0 lead with a sac fly in the second, but the Sea Dogs scored four runs in the bottom of the second to take a 4-1 lead. Portland added a fifth run on a wild pitch in the fourth and won the game, 5-1. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels came from behind in the seventh to beat the Sea Dogs, 10-8. Brainer Bonaci hit a leadoff homer in the first to give the Sea Dogs a 1-0 lead. Andy Thomas tied the game with an RBI single in the second. Portland scored two in the second and one in the third to pull ahead, 3-1. In top of the fourth, Carter Aldrete closed the gap to two runs with a sac fly and Shane Matheny hit a three-run homer to give Richmond a 5-4 lead. Bonaci tied the score with a sac fly in the fourth. In the fifth, the Sea Dogs stretched the lead to 8-5 with a two-run homer by Phillip Sikes and an RBI single by Tyler Dearden. Brandon Martorano closed the score to 8-6 with a solo homer run in the sixth. Down to their last out in the seventh, the Flying Squirrels tied the game with back-to-back solo homers by Brady Whalen and Victor Bericoto. Wyatt moved Richmond ahead, 10-8, with a two-run homer. In the bottom of the seventh, Tyler Myrick stranded two runners on base to close his third Double-A save.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Richmond's first trip to Hartford since June 22-27, 2021. This series is the only set this year between the two teams.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 34-24 in their last 58 games since June 18, tied for the best record in the Eastern League in that span, but went 2-4 in last week's series at Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.97 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 435.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 597.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.77 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the 13th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE YARD GDATS have gone 1-7 in their last eight games since August 19. Their .230 team batting average is 11th in the Eastern League and their 5.42 team ERA is 12th. Hartford's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including SS Adael Amador (No. 1 - No. 21 overall), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 3 - No. 51 overall), 3B Sterlin Thompson (No. 6), OF Jordan Beck (No. 7), C Drew Romo (No. 9), 3B Warming Bernabel (No. 11), SS Julio Carreras (No. 17), LHP Carson Palmquist (No. 13) and OF Bladimir Restituyo (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes seven Hartford players, including Amador (No. 1 - No. 21 overall), Fernandez (No. 2 - No. 53 overall), Thompson (No. 6), Romo (No. 9), Bernabel (No. 10), LHP Joe Rock (No. 16) and Palmquist (No. 21).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Hayden Birdsong makes fifth Double-A start. He last pitched on Wednesday at Portland and allowed two runs over 1.2 innings in a no-decision. On the year, Birdsong ranks third among Giants minor league pitchers in strikeouts (130) and ninth in innings pitched (85.2). Among pitchers in the minors (min. 80 IP), Birdsong ranks third in strikeout percentage (35.4) and fifth in K/9 (13.66). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and pitched 12 games (10 starts). With San Jose, he led the California League in strikeouts (70) prior to his promotion to High-A Eugene on June 13. With the Emeralds, he went 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA in his final six starts before being promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 4. During his time with Eugene from June 13-July 30, he led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.92) and ranked second in strikeouts (46). Birdsong was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Eastern Illinois University, where he played two seasons minutes from his hometown. Birdsong is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more information on Birdsong, see page two.

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Connor Van Scoyoc makes his sixth Double-A start. He last pitched last Tuesday at Somerset and threw seven scoreless innings, his longest Double-A outing, and struck out three. Van Scoyoc was selected in the 11th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Angels out of Jefferson High School in Iowa. He began this year with High-A Spokane in the Northwest League, going 4-3 with a 2.76 ERA in 11 starts. On June 25, Van Scoyoc was traded to the Rockies from the Angels for 3B Mike Moustakas. He made four starts with Spokane, going 1-2 with a 3.33 ERA. Van Scoyoc was promoted to Double-A on July 27.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 18 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for second place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one behind the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and even with the Bowie Baysox. Harrisburg is five games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

THOMAS TRENDING UP: In last week's series, **Andy Thomas** reached base 10 times in 19 plate appearances. Last Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer and worked a walk in his three plate appearances. On Wednesday, Thomas walked three times and had two hits, including a three-run double in the first inning. On this road trip, Thomas is batting .357 (5-for-14) with a homer, two doubles, six RBIs and five walks. On the year, Thomas is tied for the team lead with 11 home runs and leads Richmond with 58 RBIs.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 57 times in his last 30 games since July 25 (32 hits, 24 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .311 (32-for-103) with six homers, six doubles, two triples and 24 RBIs adding a .438 on-base percentage. In the last home series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. He is hitting .200 (5-for-25) in his six games on this road trip. In the second game of Sunday's doubleheader, he hit a three-run homer. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 132 walks, ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

BERICOTO BASHING: Victor Bericoto has homered three times in his last four games dating back to Thursday. In his last 10 games since August 16, Victor Bericoto is batting .354 (12-for-33) with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs. On August 17 against Harrisburg, he hit walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. On Thursday at Portland, he homered and drove in two runs on the night. He added another homer on Saturday. He added a game-tying homer in the last inning of Game 2 of Sunday's doubleheader at Portland. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 22 homers (16 with Eugene and six with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 71 RBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt has homered twice in his last three games since Saturday. He hit a two-run homer in the ninth inning on Saturday night at Portland. On Sunday afternoon in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. Dating back to August 20, Wyatt is batting .333 (7-for-21) with three homers, three doubles and nine RBIs. His 15 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the fourth-most in the Giants organization.

GLOW SHOW: Jimmy Glownke is has picked up nine hits and five RBIs in his last five games dating back to last Wednesday, batting .563 (9-for-16) with two homers, a double and three walks. On Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the season, Glowenke is batting .319 (30-for-94) in road games, including all six of his Double-A homers. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .306 (37-for-121) with six homers and 25 RBIs in 37 games.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
