A, B OR C-ROD: RHP Carlos Rodriguez will get the start in the series finale for the Sounds on Sunday afternoon. The Brewers' no. 22-rated prospect got the series started with 4.0 IP and one run allowed on a season-high seven hits and a season-low three strikeouts. Rodriguez did not earn a decision in Nashville's 3-1 win and did see his ERA rise to 1.26 despite the one run allowed. Rodriguez enters Sunday's start with the third-best ERA among qualified International League pitchers and his 36 strikeouts are T-4th. Sunday will be his fifth career appearance against Gwinnett and he enters the game with a 2-0 record and 2.86 ERA against the Stripers with 23 strikeouts and nine walks. Gwinnett has gotten the better of Rodriguez through his two starts this season with 13 of the 24 total hits he has allowed and half (6) of the total runs the right-hander has surrendered.

GONE FISHIN: The Sounds took their third series win of the year with the victory on Saturday night and own a 6-5 record against the Stripers on the season. The Sounds are 27-25 all-time at Coolray Field and have a 56-38 record all-time against Gwinnett since 202. The series finale on Sunday will be the final game Nashville will have against Gwinnett this season with the Stripers set to play two series at First Horizon Park the remainder of the way.

MAS MIS: Jacob Misorowski picked up his second win and first as a starter as he worked his second quality start of the season and his second in his last three games on the mound for Nashville. The Brewers' no. 4-rated prospect allowed one run over six innings on Saturday night, and his five strikeouts gave him the International League lead with 43 on the year. He also lowered his ERA to 1.77, good for the sixth-best among qualified pitchers in the league. His 35.2 IP is second-most behind former Sound and current Jacksonville pitcher Janson Junk (36.1 IP). The third inning run allowed is the only blemish in his last 17.0 IP and brought an end to a 13.1 scoreless inning streak he had dating back to his first start against Durham last week.

SHORT REST: Tyler Jay worked in back-to-back games for Nashville on Friday and Saturday night. His 0.2 IP again on Saturday gave him seven straight games without allowing an earned run dating back to April 17th. He has worked 7.1 IP during the stretch and allowed five hits and has six strikeouts to help keep the streak alive despite five walks over the span. Jay leads the Amarillo bullpen with 12 appearances this year and has worked scoreless outings in all but two as he lowered his season ERA to 0.82 in 11.0 IP in total.

McSAVE AND A FISH FILET: Easton McGee collected the save in 1.1 IP on Saturday night before needing to head back to the mound in the bottom of the ninth. It was the first save of his professional career as he worked in his 132nd career game. McGee is now 1-for-2 in save opportunities in his career with both save chances coming with Nashville this season

SLEEPING AT THE QUALITY INN: Logan Henderson made it two straight quality starts with Nashville and three overall including his Major League debut after working six innings of one run ball against Gwinnett on Friday night. With the win, Henderson has got the win in each of the last four games he has been handed the ball. Since allowing five earned in his season debut against Jacksonville in 4.0 IP, the Brewers' no. 12-ranked prospect has worked 22.0 IP with Nashville and allowed just two runs on eight hits and has 27 strikeouts. His four wins have him a four-way tie for the most in the International League while his 35 strikeouts are eighth-most in the league. He's the owner of the ninth best ERA (2.42) among qualified pitchers and his .157 BAA is fourth and he has a 0.96 WHIP on the season which is eighth as well.

USED THE BIG FLY ROD: Oliver Dunn and Wes Clarke combined to hit back-to-back home runs in the top of the sixth inning in Friday's win. The pair are the third set of Nashville teammates to leave the yard in consecutive at-bats this season. For Dunn, his two-run home run was his first with Nashville in 13 games this season and his first trip around the bases since hitting a leadoff home run for Nashville on May 17, 2024, on the road in Jacksonville. Clarke has now been a part of two of the three back-to-back instances for Nashville in which his solo home run to start the back-to-back with Anthony Seigler on April 26th vs. Durham was his last home run. Clarke continues to be a thorn in the side of Gwinnett pitching as the former South Carolina product has eight home runs in 25 games against the Stripers after his long ball on Friday night.
