TODAY: The Stripers play their first doubleheader of 2022, games two and three of a six-game series vs. the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It is the eighth and ninth of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season. Gwinnett is looking to snap a five-game road losing streak (lost 4 at DUR from 5/12-15, 1 at NOR on 5/24).

VS. NORFOLK: The Stripers have lost four straight games at Harbor Park and are 1-6 in Norfolk since the start of the 2021 season. The club's last win at the home of the Tides came on 6/24/21, a 6-2 victory (Ryan Casteel's grand slam was the difference). Gwinnett is 9-2-1 in 12 season series all-time vs. Norfolk (since 2009).

STRIKEOUT LEADERS: Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 455 in 43 games (10.58 SO per game). That's one more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 454 SO in 44G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (T-5th, 49) and Touki Toussaint (T-7th, 46) both rank among the IL top five in strikeouts through 5/25.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin homered for the second straight game on Tuesday, hitting a solo shot (#5) off RHP Denyi Reyes in the sixth to avert a shutout. He also opened the game on 5/22 vs. Memphis with a solo homer off RHP Johan Oviedo, his first career leadoff homer with Gwinnett in his 269th game with the club.

- Mashing in May: Gosselin has notched hits in 13 of 15 games this month, batting .333 (19-for-57, 4 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 9 R, 7 RBI, 2 SB, 1.005 OPS).
- GWN Career: Over parts of four seasons with the club (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .296 (294-for-994, 58 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 133 R, 97 RBI, 10 SB. .771 OPS) with 81 multi-hit efforts in 270 games.
- Rising Up the Ranks: With two hits last night (#293-294), Gosselin passed Barbaro Canizares for seventh on Gwinnett's all-time hits list. Canizares tallied 293 hits over 256 games with Gwinnett from 2009-10.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake tallied the first triple of his Triple-A career on 5/22 vs. Memphis (1-for-4, R). He is 5-for-11 (.455) in his last three games, including the second four-hit game of his career on 5/21 vs. Memphis (4-for-4, 2B, R, RBI). Through the first 33 games of his Triple-A debut. Shewmake is batting .295 (36-for-122. 8 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 17 R, 7 RBI, 4 SB, .786 OPS).

RISING WATERS: Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, Drew Waters is batting .286 (14-for-49, 1 2B, 2 HR, 7 R, 5 RBI, .743 OPS) in 12 games. His seventh-inning RBI single on 5/18 vs. Memphis was the difference in a 4-3 win, marking his second GWRBI of the year (also hit walk-off single for 6-5 win on 5/8 vs. CLT). Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.

DICKERSON DROPPING BOMBS: After hitting .161 with no homers in his first eight games with Gwinnett, Alex Dickerson is batting .270 (10-for-37, 3 HR, 5 R, 6 RBI) in his last 10 games. He homered twice in the series vs. Memphis, including a game-winning two-run shot (off LHP Zack Thompson) in a 5-3 victory on 5/19.

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 27 of 31 games with Gwinnett, posting a team-best .402 on-base percentage (T-7th in IL). Overall he's batting .269 (25-for-93, 4 2B, 0 3B, 0 HR, 12 R, 10 RBI) with a team-high eight stolen bases (8-for-12, 66.7%). For his career (MiLB and MLB), DeShields has 413 stolen bases in 1,298 games.

VODNIK DEBUTS: Since joining Gwinnett on 5/17, Victor Vodnik has made two scoreless relief appearances (3.0 IP. 0 H, 3 BB, 1 SO). Vodnik has yet to allow a run over 10.0 IP (4 H, 6 BB, 15 SO, .125 BAA) in nine outings between Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi this season. He is the sixth player to make his Triple-A debut with the Stripers in 2022, joining Justin Dean, Greyson Jenista, Braden Shewmake, Allan Winans, and William Woods.

TROMP, SINCE THE HISTORIC STREAKS: Chadwick Tromp is batting .077 (2-for-26, 1 R) in seven games since posting three memorable streaks for the Stripers. He notched a 13-game hitting streak (.385) from 4/24-5/12, IL-best 11-game RBI streak (23 RBI) from 4/28-5/12, and IL-best nine-game extra-base hit streak (11 XBH) from 5/1-12.

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller struck out five over 5.0 innings (6 H, 2 ER, 3 BB) in a no-decision on 5/20 vs. Memphis, raising his season strikeout total to 49 (T-5th in IL). Muller owns a 10.99 SO/9.0 IP ratio (142 SO in 116.1 IP) over 24 career starts with Gwinnett since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, going 7-6 with a 3.48 ERA, .231 BAA, and eight quality starts.

PROSPECTING: Gwinnett's active roster features five on the MLB.com Braves Top 30 Prospects list: OF Drew Waters (2), LHP Kyle Muller (3), RHP Bryce Elder (4), SS Braden Shewmake (5), and RHP Victor Vodnik (12). None are ranked in the MLB.com Top 100.

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE: The Stripers' roster includes three players who saw time with the World Series champion Atlanta Braves last year: Kyle Muller, Touki Toussaint, and Huascar Ynoa. Of that group, only Ynoa pitched in the Postseason, appearing once in the NLDS (0-0, 18.00 ERA, 2 ER in 1.0 IP). Additionally, Greyson Jenista, Nolan Kingham, Braden Shewmake, Victor Vodnik, and coach Devon Travis were all part of the Double-A South champion Mississippi Braves in 2021.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) .. In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TODAY'S START: Nolan Kingham makes his 13th appearance and third start of the season in game two of a six-game series at Norfolk.

- <u>GWN Career:</u> Makes his 20th appearance (9th start) for the Stripers ... Is 1-5 with a 6.66 ERA and .285 BAA with the club since making his Triple-A debut in 2021.

2022 SEASON: Was a member of Gwinnett's Opening Night roster for the first time in his career ... Made his first six appearances as a reliever (0-0, 1.54 ERA, .154 BAA) ... Did not allow a run over his first five games (9.1 IP) ... **4/30 vs. NOR:** Made his first start of the 2022 season, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings (1 H, 1 BB, 2 SO in 5-0 win).

2022 SPRING TRAINING: Appeared in one Spring Training contest for the Braves, 3/25 vs. Boston ... Retired the only batter he faced -- David Hamilton -- on one pitch to secure Atlanta's 6-3 win and earn the save ... Assigned to Gwinnett on 4/4.

2021 SEASON: Opened and closed the year with Double-A Mississippi, going 6-1 with a 2.08 ERA and .225 BAA in 12 games (10 starts) ... Went 5-1 with a 2.29 ERA in his final six starts before his promotion to Gwinnett on 6/29 ... Named the Double-A South Pitcher of the Month for June (3-0, 0.83 ERA, .193 BAA in 5 starts) ... With the Stripers from 6/29-8/15, went 0-5 with a 10.13 ERA and .365 BAA in seven games (6 starts) ... Transferred back to Mississippi on 8/17 ... Served as the M-Braves' closer in the Double-A South Championship Series, converting all three of his save opportunities (2.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO) including the series-clinching 2-1 win on 9/26.
