

OPENING NIGHT: The Delmarva Shorebirds open the 2023 season on the road against their division rival the Salem Red Sox. Salem won the 2022 season series 15-9 with the Red Sox outscoring the 'Birds 153-125 in those 24 contests.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: The season begins with road match up against North Division rival, Salem with _____ taking the mound for the Red Sox.

BOUNCE BACK SEASON: 2022 was a rough campaign for the 'Birds who finished the season 49-81 overall, which was the worst overall record amongst teams in the Carolina League and third worst in all of Single-A (Stockton & Visalia, 45-87). The 2022 squad narrowly avoid being the least successful team in franchise history according to winning percentage as they just edged out the 2012 team that finished 52-86 (.376). However, the Shorebirds with plenty of fresh faces finished the 2022 regular season strong 15-12 in their final 27 game, which included a series victory of Down East in the final week of the regular season and taking 4 of 6 versus Lynchburg who finished as the runner-up in the Carolina League.

YOUNG MAN'S GAME: The debut roster for the Delmarva Shorebirds will showcase plenty of youth as the average of the team is 20.9 years-old.

HE WAS #1: Jackson Holliday became the second No. 1 overall pick to play for the Shorebirds (Adley Rutschman, 2019) when he debuted on August 25. Holliday was drafted first overall last out of Stillwater HS where he was named HS Player of the Year by Baseball America (.685/.749/1.392), setting the national record for hits in a season (89). Holliday is the son of seven-time All-Star Matt Holliday.

WHAT ABOUT US?: The Delmarva Shorebirds opening day roster features three other prospects in addition to Jackson Holliday. Catcher Samuel Basallo will begin his first run at full-season baseball as the Orioles No. 12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 15 by Baseball America suits up for the Shorebirds at just 18 years of age as he showcases big time power and a strong arm behind home plate. Two other infielders make the rankings as infielder Carter Young (No. 30 MLB Pipeline) and Anderson De Los Santos (No. 30 Baseball America) look to make impacts on both sides of the ball.

TOP OF THE CLASS: For the second consecutive season, the Baltimore Orioles have the #1 ranked farm system according to both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America. Baltimore has 8 players in MLB Pipeline Top-100 including the Gunnar Henderson (No. 1), Grayson Rodriguez (No. 7) who are both currently with the big league club. Jackson Holliday is the No. 3 prospect for the Orioles and ranked 12th overall.

REMEMBER US?: There will be plenty of familiar faces on the Shorebirds Opening Day roster with 24 players who suited up at least once for Delmarva will be on the team to start the season.

WELCOME BACK FELIPE: Felipe Rojas Alou Jr. takes the helm for the second straight season in Delmarva as the team's manager. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization and he'll be joined by pitching coach Adam Bleday, Hitting Coach Josh Bunselmeyer, Fundamentals Coach Daniel Fajardo, Athletic Trainer Julio Ibarra, and Strength and Conditing Coach Juan Sanchez.

OPENING DAY SUCCESS: Opening Day has treated the Delmarva Shorebirds well as they have won their last four opening days and are 11-6 on opening night since 2005. Delmarva defeated Fredericksburg 9-6 in the first game of the season in 2022 at Perdue Stadium.

LAST OUTING (9/6 vs. Down East): Nunez finished his 2022 campaign strong by dealing 4 innings of scoreless baseball versus the Wood Ducks allowing no runs on just 1 hit and 1 walk. He did not factor into the decision as he did not pitch long enough, however, Delmarva won the game 5-2.

vs. SALEM: Nunez will face the Red Sox for the second time with his only prior start coming against them on August 19 in Salem, also his first career start as a Shorebird. In that outing, Nunez covered 3.2 innings on the mound 3 runs (2 earned) on just 2 hits but walked seven with no strikeouts. He did not factor into the decision but Delmarva won the game 6-3.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Traded to the Orioles at the deadline for All-Star closer Jorge Lopez. After being acquired by Baltimore, Nunez made two, three-inning starts with the Orioles FCL team before being moved to Delmarva where he impressed in four. The right-hander covered 14.2 innings and gave up just two earned runs. He finished the season tossing 12 consecutive scoreless innings.

DEADLINE DAY DANDY: Nunez was dealt to the Orioles from the Twins along with LHP Cade Povich, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Yennier Cano for All-Star closer Jorge Lopez. Nunez was originally signed by the Twins as an international free agent in 2019.

TWINNING: Although he didn't debut until 2021 in the DSL with the Twins, Nunez made an instant impact, going 2-4 with a 2.14 ERA with 62 strikeouts in 46.1 innings.

SHOREBIRDS COACHING STAFF

ELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

Returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH

Enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH

Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.


DEVELOPMENT COACH
