#### **SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

THIS OFFENSE IS ON FIRE: Since the All-Star Break, the Shuckers have won 13 of their last 17 games, the best record out of any team in Double-A.

- 📚 Since the All-Star Break, the Shuckers have scored 139 runs, an average of 8.2 per game... The Shuckers have scored at least six runs in 15 games over that span, and have tallied at least 10 hits in 11 games... Their 139 runs are the most out of any team in Minor League Baseball.
- Solver that span, the Shuckers are among the best in Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (2nd, .526), OPS (3rd, .913), average (5th, .303) and home runs (T-8th, 29).

SOMETHING IN THE WATER: Over the last six games between the Shuckers and Blue Wahoos, the winning team has scored at least nine runs in every game... In eight games at Blue Wahoos Stadium in 2023, the teams have combined to hit .293 with a .375 on-base percentage and a .898 OPS... The teams have also combined to hit 28 home runs and average a combined 14.6 runs per game.

WES' WAY IS THE WAY: C/1B Wes Clarke tallied his third multi-home run game on Wednesday, capping it off with a 455-foot, two-run shot to left-center in the ninth inning... The multi-home run performance was his second with the Shuckers, and his first in 2023.

- SEntering today, Clarke has hit eight home runs since the start of July, the third-most out of any player in Double-A... Over that span, Clarke owns a .910 OPS and a .573 slugging percentage.
- 📚 Clarke has homered in three of his last five at-bats dating back to the series opener on Tuesday... His grand slam on Wednesday was Biloxi's second of the year, and the first since INF Ethan Murray hit one on April 22 at Rocket City.

CHOURIO'S MULTI-HIT MADNESS: OF Jackson Chourio has tallied multiple hits in 13 of his last 18 games, including doing so in four of his last five games... Chourio's 32 multi-hit performances are more than anyone else on the Shuckers', and he's the only player with at least 20.

- 📚 Chourio enters today with 68 RBI, the second-most in the Southern League... He enters today with the fourth-most in a Shuckers season in franchise history (since 2015), and six away from the franchise record of 74, set by **OF** Corey Ray in 2018.
- Street Chourio is the first teenager to tally at least 15 home runs in a season in the high minors since INF Fernando Tatis Jr. did so in 2018 with the Double-A San Antonio Missions... Six players have reached the mark since 2005... Chourio is the first since **OF Giancarlo Stanton** in 2006 to hit at least 16 as a teenager in Double-A.
- 📚 Chourio enters today four home runs away from becoming the first teenager to record a 20/20 season in the high minors since **OF Delmon Young** reached the mark with the Montgomery Biscuits in 2005.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI (0-0, 12.79): RHP Jacob Misiorowski makes his third Double-A start, and his first against the Blue Wahoos... The 21-year-old is set to make his 18th start of the year between Single-A, High-A and Double-A... Over his first 17 starts, Misiorowski has struck out 81 in 56.2 innings, an average of 12.9 per nine innings.
