## FRES-NOTES

**SINCE WE'VE BEEN GONE:** The Grizzlies are the hottest offense in the California League, leading the circuit in batting average (.284), runs (89) and hits (130) while posting a 7-5 record in the two weeks away from home. The pitching staff has struck out 131 batters in 105 innings and the Grizzlies have pulled into a tie for first place with the San Jose Giants.

**COOKING UP THE RIVALRY:** While the Grizzlies won the opening series of the season against the Rawhide, it was one of two trips to Visalia that are just three games. The Grizzlies are 59-28 all-time against the Rawhide and have won the season series three of the first five years, tying once and losing the season series for the first time last season.

**BULLPEN TURNING THE CORNER:** One of Fresno's biggest developments entering the Visalia series has been the emergence of the bullpen. Seth Clausen, Austin Emener and Dylan Crooks have combined to stabilize late innings over the last two weeks, with Clausen converting four saves while holding opponents to a .137 average. Crooks has quietly become one of Fresno's best swing-and-miss arms, striking out 17 hitters in just 9.0 innings while allowing only three hits all season. Fresno's relief group helped keep the Grizzlies in every game during the high-scoring San Jose series and now faces a Rawhide club capable of creating pressure with speed and athleticism.

**EXTRA-BASE DAMAGE:** Fresno continues producing some of the loudest contact in the California League entering this week's rivalry matchup. The Grizzlies rank 2nd in the league with 38 home runs while also ranking near the top of the league in doubles, total bases and slugging percentage. Derek Bernard, Ethan Holliday and Tanner Thach have combined for 17 home runs and 81 RBI already this season, giving Fresno one of the deepest middle-of-the-order groups in the league.
