Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Knights play game three of the six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. The teams have split the first two games of the series and Nashville holds a 6-2 record over Charlotte this season. Right-hander Chad Patrick will be on the bump for the Sounds and face off against right-hander Nick Nastrini for the Knights.

DL Hall: The 25-year-old left-hander makes his 10th start for Nashville this season. He is 0-1 with a 2.95 ERA (18.1 IP/6 ER) and a 16/14 K/BB ratio. Hall was gearing up to end his rehab stint when he was struck by a line drive on the arm that forced him to not make a start from July 9 - 21. In his last outing at Norfolk, he went 2.2 innings with two earned runs allowed. It was his first start against his former team after he made 39 appearances for the Tides in 2022-23. Hall has seen an increase in pitch count with an average of 54.66 pitches per start in July after averaging 39.40 per start in June. He was originally placed on the injured list on April 21 with a left knee sprain after he made four starts for the Brewers at the beginning of the season. The Valdosta, Georgia native was drafted by the Orioles 21st overall in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of high school. He made his MLB debut on August 13, 2022, for the Orioles and made 18 appearances (zero starts) for the Orioles in 2023 but was traded to Milwaukee in the offseason along with INF Joey Ortiz in exchange for Corbin Burnes.

Jake Eder: The 25-year-old left-hander makes his second start of the season for Charlotte. In his Triple-A debut on July 21 at Gwinnett, he went 2.0 innings and gave up eight runs (six earned) with two strikeouts. Before he was transferred to Charlotte, he made 15 starts in Double-A for the Birmingham Barons. He was 2-5 with a 5.09 ERA (74.1 IP/42 ER) and 86 strikeouts. His best month was May where he picked up his only two wins of the season and had a 3.34 ERA (32.1 IP/12 ER) in six starts. In his first season of professional baseball in 2021, he went 3-5 with a 1.77 ERA for Pensacola and was selected to the Futures Game. The Boynton Beach, Florida native attended Vanderbilt from 2018-20 and was drafted in the 4th round in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft by the Marlins. He notched a three-inning save to close out the 2019 College World Series final versus Michigan. Eder was traded to the White Sox on August 1, 2023, for Jake Burger. He is currently ranked as the no. 10 prospect in the White Sox system according to MLB.com.

Fresh Faces: Reliever Devin Williams made his second rehab appearance with the Sounds last on Wednesday night. He pitched a scoreless inning with one walk and strikeout on July 21 at Norfolk. He has not allowed a hit in 3.0 innings of work since returning from injury. Joe Ross also made a rehab outing on Wednesday which was his third with Nashville. Tyler Jay made his Sounds debut last night with a scoreless sixth inning and one strikeout. He was acquired in a trade with the Mets on July 21 for RHP TJ Shook after making three appearances with New York this season. Freddy Zamora was reinstated from the 7-day injured list and played in his first game for Nashville since July 6. He went 1-for-3 with one RBI.

Running Wild: In last night's win, the Sounds had a season-high six stolen bases which tops their previous best of five set on June 19 vs. Durham. Tyler Black had three which was also the most by a Sounds player in a single game. Black has stolen at least three bags in a game on two other occasions (4 vs. Fort Wayne on May 7, 2022, & 3 vs. South Bend on May 21, 2022). The last time a Nashville player had at least three stolen bases in a game was Esteury Ruiz (5) on September 14, 2022, vs. Jacksonville. The Sounds are 12-for-14 in stolen base attempts in the series vs. Charlotte. Hicklen has a stolen base in three consecutive games and is one behind the league leaders in the International League with 29 this season.

McKendry Closer: For the second-straight night, a Sounds player picked up his first save of the season. After Carlos Rodriguez did it last night, Evan McKendry tossed 3.0 innings, allowing four hits, and two earned runs in a save. It was the fourth save of his career with the previous three coming for Bowling Green in 2021.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 735-630 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,327-2,150 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Hall pitched in his first game in 12 days at Norfolk on July 21. It was his first time facing Norfolk after making 39 appearances for the Tides in 2022-23.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Hall has faced Charlotte three times in his career; Twice with Norfolk in 2022-23 and once on May 23. He allowed four earned runs across 3.0 innings at Charlotte on May 20, 2022. He picked up the win on August 5, 2023 in a 2.0-inning relief appearance. He made his season debut with the Sounds versus Charlotte in May and tossed a scoreless first inning.

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Started the season of the Opening Day roster
- Went 0-1, with a 7.71 ERA (16.1 IP/14 ER) in four starts in March and April before being placed on the 15-day injured list on April 21 due to a left knee sprain
- Tweaked knee injury fielding a ground ball in rehab start vs. Charlotte... moved to the 60-day injured list on June 8 with a left knee sprain

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Entered the season as the fifth-best prospect in the Orioles organization according to Baseball America
- Went 2-2 with a 3.98 ERA and 1 save in 19 games (12 starts) between Triple-A Norfolk (17g, 11gs) and Rookie FCL Orioles (2g, 1gs).....the appearances in the Florida Complex League came at the end of July to help build arm strength and velocity (was in Sarasota from the middle of June to the beginning of August)
- Held opponents to a .203 batting average with 78 strikeouts in 52.0 innings
- Had two stints with Baltimore (4/29 and 8/26-end of season)
- Went 3-0 with a 3.26 ERA in 18 relief appearances with Baltimore
- Held opponents to a .237 batting average with 23 strikeouts in 19.1 innings
