#### **ROCKER STRONG IN RIDERS LOSS TO MISSIONS:**

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the San Antonio Missions 5-2 on Friday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. Frisco (19-12, 63-37) starter **Kumar Rocker** showed off in his second Double-A start of the season, throwing four innings as he continues to work his way back from "Tommy John" Surgery. Over the four innings, he allowed just one hit while striking out four and walking one. In two starts with Frisco, Rocker has thrown seven innings, allowing just two hits while striking out eight and walking one. After Rocker's exit, the Missions (14-16, 45-53) broke the scoreless tie in the fifth with four runs on four hits against **Nick Krauth** (7-4). San Antonio starter Henry Baez (1-0) started the game retiring the first 16 batters he faced until **Cooper Johnson** homered in the top of the sixth inning to pull the Riders to within 4-1. It was his ninth home run on the season. **Keyber Rodriguez** then ripped an RBI double into left field in the seventh and the Riders just trailed 4-2, but San Antonio answered with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the seventh to push the lead to 5-2. Frisco had a base runner in the ninth against Ethan Routzahn, but he recorded his sixth save of the season. Frisco only managed four hits on the night after putting up double digit hit totals in each of the first three games of the series. The loss marked Frisco's first loss at The Wolff in 2024 in 11 games and snapped a 13-game winning streak head-to-head against San Antonio.

#### READY TO ROCK(ER):

ROUGHRIGHT TO ROCKIER;

RoughRiders starting pitcher **Kumar Rocker** has been fantastic in his two starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the two starts, he has pitched seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and one walk with eight strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 11.4 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

#### ABIMELE-LECTRIC:

Riders slugger **Abimelec Ortiz** has been crushing the baseball recently. While he is hitting well over his last 15 games, batting .315 (18-for-58)/.385/.534/.919 with four doubles, three home runs, eight RBIs and 10 runs scored, the success goes back even further. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting just .176/.241/.309/.550, but has hammered the ball in 26 games since, batting .281/.375/.449/.825. He has raised his average 37 points (.208), his slugging percentage 42 points (.353) and his OPS 86 points (.636) in the last 26 games.

#### MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders face their division opponents for the third time this season, but the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2023, Frisco went 13-11 against San Antonio and have gone 55-27 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021, including 32-9 at the Wolff. In the 16 games this season, in which they are 14-2, they have a 2.44 team ERA, outscoring the Missions 81-47. **Josh Hatcher** has driven in 12 runs over his 13 games against the Missions, hitting .367 with an .869 OPS.

#### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .700 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 28-22 with a 3.27 ERA, but a +23 run differential while averaging 4.1 runs per game and owning a .636 OPS. Cody Freeman is slashing .339/.398/.594/.992 at home this season with nine of his 12 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home

#### **OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:**

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 24 games, he is hitting .293 (27-for-92)/.389/.522/.911 with eight doubles, two triples, three home runs and 15 RBIs. Over his last 21 games, he is batting .304 (24-for-79)/.411/.544/.955 with six doubles, two triples, three home runs and 15 RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game.

#### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.10 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.51), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .227 BAA is on pace to be the best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

#### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned The RoughRiders clinicated the first-nail lexas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.
