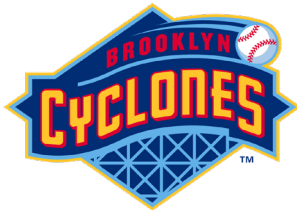

LAST TIME OUT: Cyclones earned their 4th consecutive win in an 8-5 victory at Asheville on Friday...Brooklyn scored 4 runs in the 5th and 3 more in the 7th to take a 7-2 lead...Tourists scored 3 in the 7th to pull within 2, but no closer...All 9 in the Cyclones lineup reached base and 8 picked up hits...DH **Kevin Parada**, RF **Stanley Consuegra**, SS **William Lugo**, LF **Omar De Los Santos**, and C **Christian Prgent** all tallied multi-hit games...Lugo and 3B **Chase Estep** each collected multi-RBI games, as well...RHP **Jordan Geber** struck out 6 and yielded 2 runs on 4 hits over 5.1 innings to earn his first win since returning off the injured list...RHP **Joe Joe Rodríguez** struck out 5 and earned a hold in his debut, while RHP **Luis A. Rodríguez** recorded the final 3 outs for the save in his...LF **Zach Cole** and 3B **Justin Williams** each had 2 hits and RBI for Asheville.

ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS: Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight play-off appearance and has won 7 of their last 11 series since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 7-2-2 in their last 11 sets...Brooklyn is 32-21 in the second half and 2 games ahead of Jersey Shore (30-23) atop the North Division of the SAL with 13 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn as a result of winning the season series (15-11).

THE BROOKLYN BATTING COMPANY: The Cyclones' streak of home runs in 7-straight games dating back to August 18 vs. Hudson Valley ended on Saturday night...Brooklyn blasted 15 round-trippers during the streak for an average of 2.14 per game...Over the last 8 games, Brooklyn has powered 5 more home runs than any other Single-A team...The 'Clones hold a 6-2 record and have accumulated 65 runs (8.13 R/G) and 80 hits (10.0 H/G)...The Cyclones also tied a season-high with 4 home runs in Thursday's win at Asheville...Brooklyn also blasted 4 long balls in a 6-1 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 23...The Cyclones have smashed 10 home runs (2.0 HR/G) in the first 5 games of the series against the Tourists, scoring 48 total runs (9.6 R/G)...Brooklyn has not clubbed that many round-trippers in a 5-game span since they walloped 11 between May 27 and June 1 at Bowling Green and at Jersey Shore, tallying 46 total runs.

LAST TRAIN RUNNING: Brooklyn scored a then-season-high 12 runs in Wednesday's 12-5 victory over Asheville and surpassed it with a 13-run performance in Thursday's 13-12 triumph in 10 frames...The Cyclones' previous high water mark was 11 on 2 separate occasions...Brooklyn bested Wilmington, 11-7, on both July 27 and 30 at Maimonides Park...The 13 runs scored are the most for the 'Clones since they scored 18 runs in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...RF **Stanley Consuegra** homered in both Wednesday's contest and the game on 8/28/22...The 25 combined runs over a 2-game period are the most for Brooklyn since scoring 26 between August 27-28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones beat the BlueClaws, 8-3, on August 27, and then throttled Jersey Shore, 18-1, on August 28.

JETT THE MET: INFs **Jett Williams** made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and has been stellar all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .341/.491/.635 with a 1.126 OPS, 28 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, 18 RBI, 36 walks, and 15 stolen bases in 36 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 160 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.491) or OPS (1.126)...He is also 2nd in slugging percentage (.635), walks (36), and 6th in batting average (.341)...On the season, Williams is tied for 8th in Minor League Baseball in walks (90)...Among teenagers, Williams ranks 2nd in MiLB...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 90 PA) in batting average (.337), on-base percentage (.476), OPS (1.090), doubles (8), and walks (21)...He is also tied for 1st in extra-base hits (13), and 2nd in hits (28) and stolen bases (9)...Among SAL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Williams leads in the circuit in OBP (.476), is 2nd in walk rate (20.0%), 4th in wRC+ (194), wOBA (.483), and 5th in OPS (1.091).

SUPER SUÁREZ: With 6 strikeouts on Friday night, RHP **Joander Suárez** broke a tie with RHP **Blade Tidwell** (112) for Brooklyn's single-season strikeout record...The 23-year-old holds the all-time mark with 118 punchouts in 2023...Tidwell set the mark earlier this season...Over his last 12 appearances (11 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 4-5 record, but a 3.34 ERA (21 ER in 56.2 IP), 17 walks (7.3 BB%), and 79 strikeouts (33.8 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 8 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 2-4, yet holds a 2.72 ERA (13 ER in 43.0 IP) with 10 walks (5.7 BB%) and 54 strikeouts (34.1 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez is tied for the SAL lead and tied for 4th in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (63).

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on Wednesday night...He added another blast on Thursday and is 3 home runs (19) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...Consuegra homered in each of the first 3 games of the series in Asheville, tying SS **Jett Williams** (8/19-22) for the most consecutive games with a round-tripper this year...The multi-home run night marked the 2nd of the season for Consuegra...Stanley tallied a pair of solo blasts in a 6-4 loss at Hudson Valley on July 19...He and C **Kevin Parada** (6/23 vs. HV & 7/15 vs. GBO) are the only 2 players to post multi-homer contests for Brooklyn in 2023...Since the Minor League stat portal began in 2005, Consuegra and Parada are just 2-of-3 Cyclones to post multiple 2-plus home run games...INF **Nick Evans** accomplished the feat in 2005 on July 22 vs. Jamestown and again on August 24 at Williamsport...Entering Sunday, Consuegra is tied for 4th in the SAL in home runs (19) and 6th in slugging percentage (.475).

vs. ASHEVILLE: Brooklyn begins a 2-week road trip with 6 games against the Astros' High-A affiliate...The Tourists possess 4 of Houston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Jacob Melton** (1), RHP **Miguel Ullola** (13), OF **Zach Cole** (18), RHP **Nolan DeVos** (24)...Brooklyn and Asheville are meeting for the second time in each franchise's history...Both squads met at McCormick Field to open the 2021 season...The Tourists took 3-of-5 games in the series from May 4-9...The final game of that series was canceled due to weather.

CLIFF NOTES: OF **Ryan Clifford** was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Sunday ranked 2nd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.503), 3rd in home runs (20) and 5th in OPS (.843)...Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.253), and 7th in wOBA (.373) and wRC+ (125).

THE HITS KEEP COMING: Brooklyn and Asheville united for 25 runs in the Cyclones' 13-12 win in 10 innings on Thursday night...The 25 tallies are the most combined runs in a single game for the 'Clones in 2023...It is tied for the 3rd-largest combined score in a South Atlantic League game this season...Aberdeen won at Greensboro, 16-14, in 9 innings on July 5, for a total ledger of 30 runs...The 25 combined runs were the most in a single game featuring Brooklyn since May 27, 2022...The Cyclones and Bowling Green Hot Rods united to scratch across 26 runs in Brooklyn's 20-6 victory.

WALK IT OUT: Brooklyn's 10 walks on Wednesday were the most for the squad in a 9-inning game this season...The Cyclones earned 12 free passes in an 11-inning, 9-8 win vs. Jersey Shore on Opening Day, April 7...The 10 walks were the most for Brooklyn in a 9-inning game since August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...LF **Rhylan Thomas** earned 4 walks in Wednesday's victory tying 3B **Jaylen Palmer** for the most by a Cyclone in a single game this year...Palmer accomplished the feat in Brooklyn's 9-8, 11-inning Opening Day win vs. Jersey Shore...The 4 free passes were the most by a Cyclone in a 9-inning game since 2B **Nic Gaddis** walked 4 times in a 10-3 win at Jersey Shore on July 22, 2022...Since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in 2005, no Brooklyn player has walked more than 4 times in a single game.

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.43 ERA (291 ER in 7631 IP) over their last 87 games, holding a 49-38 record in that span, which is 3rd lowest in the minors...Hudson Valley (3.41) is also tied atop MiLB...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 3rd in MiLB — in that span...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.641) and 4th lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.18), batting average against (.216).

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Sunday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in RBI and is 6 (85) behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (232), hits (158), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (83)...Ramírez is 4 hits behind Peroza (162) for the franchise record.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list last Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.


DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (119), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonathan Clasé** (118), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (116), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (113), and Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (111) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his second-straight defeat last Sunday afternoon vs. Hudson Valley...Surrendered 3 runs on 6 hits over 2.1 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out 3...Yielded a solo home run to CF **Spencer Jones** in the 3rd...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Hall** with a man at 1st and 1 out in the top of the 3rd and Brooklyn trailing 3-1...Bequeathed runner did not score...Renegades went on to defeat the Cyclones, 7-1.

THE ROCO SHOW: Colina has been on a tear since he struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley, which was matched on August 1 at Jersey Shore...Colina holds a 3-2 record with a 2.92 ERA (12 ER in 37.0 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 33 hits and walked 6 with 45 strikeouts over his last 10 appearances (5 starts)...Colina's strikeout rate is up 2.4 percent (30.6 K%) and the walk rate is down 2.2 percent (4.1 BB%) during the period.

ALWAYS MOVING: Colina has already pitched at 3 separate levels in 2023...The 22-year-old was assigned to Single-A St. Lucie to start the season...After making 1 appearance, Colina was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on April 16...Earned the win in his lone outing for the Rumble Ponies on April 18...He was transferred to Brooklyn on April 24.

2022: Split the season between St. Lucie and the Florida Complex League...Assigned to St. Lucie on May 2...Returned to the FCL on May 10 and reported back to St. Lucie on May 23...Registered an 0-5 record with a 7.99 ERA (29 ER in 32.2 IP) and 41 K's in 10 appearances (6 starts) in the Florida State League...Joined the FCL club for the remainder of the season on July 19...Posted a 1-0 mark with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER in 17.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts in 4 outings (2 starts).

STARTING TIME: Colina expects to make his 7th start of the 2023 season...Last season, the 22-year-old started in 8 of his 14 outings...In a starting role in 2022, Colina held a 1-3 record with a 5.56 ERA (21 ER in 34.0 IP) in 8 starts...He held a walk rate of 7.3% and a strikeout rate of 28.7%...In 4 relief appearances, the Punto Fijo, VZ native was 0-2 with a 6.32 ERA (11 ER in 15.2 IP)...Colina's walk rate was 12.7% and strikeout rate hovered at 28.2%.
