series vs. the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Miami Marlins) at 121 Financial Park. It is the 12th of 24 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the last of 12 games the Stripers will play in Jacksonville.

VS. JACKSONVILLE: Following last night's loss, Gwinnett is 3-8 (.273) all-time in the state of Florida. The Stripers went 1-5 (.167) on their first trip to Jacksonville from 4/19-24, 2022, and were outscored 35-19 in that series (only win was 10-8 in 10 innings on 4/23). Entering this series, the Stripers were 1-2-0 in three series all-time vs. Jacksonville.

DAVIDSON GOES TO ELEVEN: Tucker Davidson struck out a career-high 11 batters over 7.0 innings (5 H, 3 ER, 1 BB) last night, turning in a quality start despite taking the loss. His previous high was 10 strikeouts, set on 6/13/19 with Double-A Mississippi vs. Mobile (5.1 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 0 ER). It's the first time Davidson has fanned 10-plus at the Triple-A level, but the sixth time in 15 career starts with Gwinnett that he's recorded at least eight strikeouts (4-5, 2.95 ERA, .217 BAA, 93 SO in 82.1 IP, 10.17 SO/9.0 IP ratio).

STIFLING STARTERS: Stripers' starters (Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa) have combined to post a 2.35 ERA (17 ER in 65.0 IP), 10.25 SO/9.0 IP ratio (74 SO in 65.0 IP), and six quality starts over the last 11 games (team is 5-6). The group has allowed 48 hits and just 18 walks in that span.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 615 in 59 games (10.42 SO per game). That's 13 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 602 SO in 59G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (2nd, 73), Tucker Davidson (T-6th, 53), and Huascar Ynoa (T-15th, 49) all rank in the IL top 15 in strikeouts.

WATERS STARTS IT WITH A BANG: Drew Waters tripled on the first pitch thrown by Jacksonville RHP Bryan Hoeing last night, his third extra-base hit on the first pitch of a game this season. He also hit first-pitch leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (off LHP Wes Benjamin) and 5/11 at Durham (off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff clouts of his Gwinnett career. In 26 games overall, he's batting .270 (27-for-100, 5 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 9 RBI, 1 SB, .732 OPS), including .471 against LHP (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.176 OPS) and .167 against RHP (1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, .503 OPS)

• GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .250 (153-for-611, 32 2B, 2 3B, 16 HR, 103 R, 57 RBI, 32 SB, .714 OPS) in 155 games.

EXTRA, EXTRA: Ryan Casteel went 1-for-3 with a double last night, giving him nine extra-base hits (3 2B, 1 3B, 5 solo HR) among his 13 total hits this season (69.2%). Career with Gwinnett, 23 of his 48 hits (47.9%) over 86 games have been XBH (9 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR).

DIFF'RENT STREAKS: Preston Tucker enters play looking to extend an 11-game on-base streak. He's batting .306 (11-for-36, 2 2B, 2 HR, 3 R, 5 RBI, 9 BB, .972 OPS) during the streak dating back to 5/27, his second of 10-plus games this year (had 13-game streak from 4/24-5/12). Phil Gosselin is riding an eight-game on-base streak since 6/1, batting .300 (9-for-30, 2 2B, 3 R, 4 RBI, 1 SB, 4 BB, .729 OPS) in that stretch.

TODAY: The Gwinnett Stripers play the finale of a six-game **THE GOOSE! Phil Gosselin** has hit safely in 22 of 28 games since 5/1, batting .314 (33-for-105, 9 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 15 RBI, .890 OPS) in that stretch. He ranks 13th in the IL with a .298 average (53-for-178, 12 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 23 RBI, 4 SB, .832 OPS) in 48 games.

- GWN Career: In 283 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), he's batting .296 (308-for-1042, 63 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 105 RBI, 11 SB, .769 OPS).
- 300 Club: He is one of seven in Gwinnett history with 300 hits, joining Sean Kazmar Jr. (675), Jose Constanza (437), Rio Ruiz (356), Todd Cunningham (334), Joey Terdoslavich (308), and Ernesto Mejia (302).

TUIASOSOPO REACHES 100-WIN MARK: Matt Tuiasosopo earned his 100th win as a Triple-A manager on Thursday (won 5-1). He is the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 wins, joining Dave Brundage (293 wins from 2009-12), Brian Snitker (161 wins from 2014-16), and Damon Berryhill (221 wins from 2017-19).

MULLDOZING: Wednesday night, Kyle Muller became the first Stripers pitcher to record consecutive quality starts this season, logging 6.0 innings (6 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 9 SO) in a no-decision. He is 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER in 13.0 IP), .213 BAA, and 17 strikeouts over two starts in June, including a season-high 7.0-inning effort in a win on 6/2 vs. Louisville (4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 SO in 5-3 victory).

- IL Leaderboard: He currently ranks among the IL top 15 in strikeouts (2nd, 73), ERA (4th, 3.09), innings (T-10th, 55.1), WHIP (T-11th, 1.27), and BAA (12th, .239).
- · GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 8-7 with a 3.27 ERA (49 ER in 135.0 IP), .230 BAA, and 166 strikeouts (11.07 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 27 starts.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte returned to the Stripers lineup on 6/1 vs. Louisville (1-for-4, 2 R), his first game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 162 of 190 games (85.3%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .284 (186-for-655, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 128 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .944 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Since joining the Stripers on 4/19, has pitched at least 5.0 innings in seven of his eight starts ... **4/24-5/26:** Over his first six starts, went 1-2 with a 5.64 ERA (19 ER in 30.1 IP) and .228 BAA ... **Since 6/1:** In two starts in June, is 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER in 12.0 IP) and .054 BAA (2 H, 7 BB, 13 SO) ... **6/7 at JAX:** Fired 7.0 no-hit innings (3 BB, 6 SO) for the win, combining with **Brandyn Sittinger** (1.0 IP, 1 H) and **Brad Brach** (1.0 IP, 0 H) on a one-hit shutout in a 7-0 victory.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made the Braves' Opening Day Roster for the second time in his career (also in 2021) ... Served as the fifth starter, going 0-2 with a 13.50 ERA (10 ER in 6.2 IP) and .355 BAA over two starts ... Optioned to Gwinnett on 4/19.

2021 REGULAR SEASON: In an injury-shortened year with Atlanta, went 4-6 with a 4.05 ERA and .224 BAA in 18 games (17 starts) ... Was on the Braves' Opening Day roster for the first time in his career ...
