TRAVELERS JUMP AHEAD EARLY AS CARDINALS FALL 10-4: The

Cardinals made noise late but could not overcome an early six-run hole as Springfield dropped its third straight in a 10-4 loss to the Arkansas Travelers on Saturday evening at Hammons Field. RJ Yeager had three hits and Nathan Church extended his hitting streak to 11 with a single in the 8th inning. The Cards scored three runs in the bottom of the 8th on a two-run double by Matt Lloyd and an RBI single by Noah Mendlinger to cut the deficit to three, but Arkansas struck for three in the top of the 9th to put the game out of reach.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Logan Evans** makes his fifth start of the season for the Travelers, and second of the series...Last pitched in the series opener on Tuesday, aallowing just 3 H over 5.0 shutout innings with a season-high 8 K...Took the loss on opening day against the Cardinals at Dickey-Stephens Park allowing an unearned run on 2 H over 4.0 IP with 3 BB, a HBP and 2 K...Springfield won the game, 6-1...Making just his 10th career start...Went 1-0 with a 0.75 era in 3 starts with the Modesto Nuts of the Low-A California League last season, racking up 13 K's and allowing just 7 H in 12.0 IP...Made two starts in the Arizona Complex League after signing with Seattle and allowed 3 H with 3 K in 3.0 scoreless innings...Selected by the Mariners in the 12th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Pittsburgh...As a junior with the Panthers went 5-3 with a 5.88 ERA in 11 appearances (9 starts)...Went 4-8 with a 7.42 ERA in 14 starts as a sophomore in 2022...Opponents batted .298 against the right-hander in his two seasons at Pitt...Spent his first two collegiate seasons (2020-21) at Penn State...Also played football and basketball in high school...22 years old

CARDINALS, TRAVELERS CLASH FOR SECOND TIME IN FOUR WEEKS: The Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners) make their first of two trips this season to Hammons Field for a six-game series. The Cardinals swept a three-game series in North Little Rock to start the 2024 campaign and went 7-5 against the Travelers at home last season.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

CARDS, BARONS AT TOP OF DOUBLE-A: Despite a three-game losing streak, the Cardinals will still enter play on Sunday afternoon tied with the the Birmingham Barons (Chicago White Sox) for the best record in all of Double-A at 14-6. The Midland RockHounds are next at 13-7. The Cards entered Friday with the best mark in all of MiLB, but that honor now belongs to the Modesto Nuts who sit at 14-4.

COMEBACK CARDS: Of the Cardinals' 20 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in 13 of them. Of those 13 games, the Cards have won 9, making them 9-4 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, despite Springfield's opponent scoring first in 10 of 11 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals hold an 8-3 record through 11 games at home this season.

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE: Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through 19 games the Cardinals lead the Texas League with a .275 batting average, a mark that also leads all of Double-A; the Somerset Patriots are next at .263. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.366), RBIs (108) and runs scored (118). Springfield has also been particularly productive hitting situationally, with a league-high 11 sacrifice flies this season.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 141 times in 20 games, the second-fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals only trail the Spokane Indians (High-A, Colorado Rockies) who have K'd 125 times, although in three less games than Springfield has played (17). The Birds have struck out 10 less times than any other times in the Texas League (Frisco RoughRiders, 151). The Cards are averaging just 7.1 K's per game.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week after a big series in Amarillo. The UC Irvine product went 9-for-25 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs to go along with 6 BB. Church ranks in the top 5 in the Texas League in batting average (5th; .338), RBI (t3rd; 16), hits (2nd; 26), total bases (t5th; 38), and runs (t4th; 16). In 87 plate appearances this year, he has struck out just 5 times.

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS: With

his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on Tuesday night, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 205.

VICTIMS OF THE LONG BALL: Despite an overall solid season so far in which the Cardinal pitching staff has posted a 4.17 ERA, the Birds have fallen victim to the home run ball early in the 2024 season. Springfield pitchers have allowed 23 HR so far this year, 2nd most in the Texas League behind the Amarillo Sod Poodles (25).

STARTING ROTATION LOOKING FOR A GROOVE: Since the Cardinals saw their nine-game winning streak come to an end last Tuesday, the Springfield starting rotation has come back to earth. The Cards' starters sport a 5.57 ERA over their last 11 games since April 16, a mark that ranks last in the Texas League during that time, a stretch in which the Cardinals are just 5-6. During their nine-game winning streak to start the season, the Cards' starting rotation was 2nd in the circuit with a 2.88 ERA.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, **Bryan Torres** (Richmond, 2021) and **Matt Lloyd** (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the SprIngfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs.

Cardinals skpper **Jose Leger** is back for his fourth year as manager in Springfield.




