WALK-OFF NETS SHRIMP SEVENTH STRAIGHT WIN

Norel González's walk-off single in the 10th inning Friday pushed Jacksonville to a 3-2 victory over Gwinnett. The Stripers jumped out to a 2-0 advantage thanks to Preston Tucker's RBI double in the first and RBI single in the third. A **Bryson Brigman** RBI base hit in the bottom of the third halved the Jumbo Shrimp's deficit before González's home run in the fifth knotted the score. The tally remained 2-2 until the 10th, when a González base hit up the middle plated Charles Leblanc for the win. Robert Garcia and Jimmy Yacabonis each worked 3.0 shutout innings of relief.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Jacksonville has won seven consecutive games, their longest winning streak in a month of April since April 12-18, 2009, when they also took seven contests in a row. During their current seven-game winning streak, the Jumbo Shrimp are outscoring their opponents 51-14 with a 74-33 advantage in hits and a 11-1 margin in home runs. Since this roll began on April 15, the Jumbo Shrimp rank in third out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in runs, tied for third in hits and sixth in home runs. The club's 14 runs allowed is second-fewest in MiLB during this span, with Jacksonville's 1.55 ERA also placing second and .183 batting average against seventh. If Jacksonville can win on Saturday, it would be the club's first eight-game winning streak since a 10-game roll from April 23-September 1 of the 2014 campaign.

RETURN OF THE CARDIAC SHRIMP

The Jumbo Shrimp walked-off on Gwinnett 3-2 in 10 innings on Friday, marking Jacksonville's first walk-off victory of the season. In 2021, 21 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 75 wins came in their last at-bat, a rate of 28 percent. Of those 21 last at-bat triumphs, 11 were walk-offs at 121 Financial Ballpark, Those close victories helped Jacksonville go a whopping 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer in 2021.

Charles Leblanc went 0-for-4 on Friday, but he has still gotten off to a fantastic start in 2022. The Laval, Quebic City native has registered multiple hits in five of his 12 games this year, and on the season, ranks second in the International League in OPS (1.183) and fourth in average (.372), OBP (.462) and slugging (.721), respectively.

PITCH PERFECT

Through the season's first 10 games, Jacksonville starting pitchers ceded at least four runs on six different outings, posting a collective 7.85 ERA in the process. Over the last six games, though, Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded just six runs, three earned, in 28.1 innings for a 0.95 ERA. During this six-game run, the club's lid-lifters have registered 19 strikeouts against 22 hits and 10 walks.

THE ARM BARN

The Jacksonville bullpen has been outstanding during the club's current seven-game winning streak. During this run. the Jacksonville hullnen has ceded just five runs, all earned on 15 hits in 31.1 innings for a 1.43 ERA (37 K. 11 BB). Seven pitchers in the bullpen have tossed at least one inning without allowing a run and all have at least one stikeout during this span. Additionally, the club's relievers posted a 14.1 scoreless innings streak from April 16-21.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 21 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking tied for fourth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

Both Lewin Díaz and Peyton Burdick have gotten off to a strong starts. Díaz is 16-for-57, slashing .281/.373/.491/.864 with three doubles, three home runs, 15 RBIs and 11 runs scored. Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' reigning Minor League Player of the Year, is 11-for-43, slashing .256/.418/.488/.906 with a double, three homers, six RBIs and a league-leading 16 runs. Thus, of the 97 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks in a tie for second in the International League - the pair have accounted for 42 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs), a ratio of 43.2

ABOUT MATTHEW

-It took Kent until his third season at Texas A&M University to move into the Aggies' starting rotation. He totaled six starts out of 45 total appearances between his freshman and sophomore years in 2013-14. In 2015, the left-hander started 14 games out of his 19 appearances, going 9-1 with a 2.76 ERA (98.0 IP, 103 H, 12 BB, 84 K). That performance helped convince the Boston Red Sox to select Kent in the 13th round of the 2015 draft.

-After six seasons in the Red Sox organization, Kent elected free agency on November 7, 2021. Less than a month later, on December 3, 2021, he inked a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

2021 SEASON

-Kent started just three games out of 27 appearances in 2021. In his previous four campaigns, he started all but eight of his 112 outings.

-The southpaw held left-handed hitters to a .161 average and .450 OPS in 56 at-bats. However, over 178 at-bats, righties batted .315 with an .823 OPS against him.

-Kent struggled pitching with runners on base. With Double-A Portland and the bases empty, opponents recorded a ..256 average and 674 OPS in 133 at-bats. In comparison, with runners on, opposing hitters hit .307 with a .809 OPS in 101 at-bats.

2019 SEASON

-Kent still had platoon splits in 2019, but far less pronounced than he would experience in 2021. In Double-A, opposing right-handed hitters posted a .755 OPS against him in 294 at-bats compared to a .629 OPS for left-handed batters in 187 at-bats.

2018 SEASON

-Over 170 at-bats while Kent pitched for Double-A Portland, left-handed hitters collected a .650 OPS. In comparison, right-handed batters registered a .723 mark in 387 at-bats.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-An outstanding hitter in addition to his pitching prowess at Midway High School in Waco, Texas, Kent went 10-1 with a 0.63 ERA and 122 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched as a senior while also batting .421 with 24 extra-base hits. In the district playoffs, he tossed three consecutive no-hitters.
