### LANGFORD SPARKS RIDERS IN SHUTOUT WIN:

**Wyatt Langford** stuffed the box score on Wednesday night with a double, a single, a sacrifice fly and a walk to lead the Frisco RoughRiders to a 4-0 victory over the Northwest Arkansas Naturals at Riders Field. Langford was starting for the second time since his promotion to Frisco (30-29, 61-66). He recorded his first Double-A RBI on a sacrifice fly in the first inning and notched his first Double-A base hit by grounding a ball into center field in the third. He drew a walk in the fifth inning and doubled in the seventh. The Naturals (28-30, 57-70) were held to just two hits on Wednesday. **Dane Acker** tossed four shutout innings with only two hits allowed for Frisco. Over his last two starts, the right-hander has spanned nine innings without a run allowed. The Frisco bullpen recorded five hitless innings: two frames from **Aidan Anderson** (1-3) to earn the win and one inning each by **Andy Rodriguez**, **Michael Brewer** and **John Matthews**. With the win, Frisco drew one game closer to Amarillo for first place in the second half standings. The Riders are still five games back with 10 contests remaining. The Riders took the lead in the first inning after **Keyber Rodriguez** singled to open the frame. He stole second, advanced to third on an error and scored on Langford's sac fly. **Scott Kapers** added to the lead in the second with a two-out, two-run single. He grounded a ball off the second base bag and it scored both **Aaron Zavala** and **Chris Seise**. Seise picked up an RBI of his own in the sixth inning on a base hit, going 2-for-4 on the night. Eric Cerantola (0-1) was saddled with the loss, allowing two earned runs over his five-inning start.

### WELCOME, WYATT:

**Wyatt Langford**, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday.

### START ME UP AND NEVER STOP:

RoughRiders starting pitchers have been great recently. Over their last eight games, in 37.1 innings, starters have allowed just 10 runs for a 2.41 ERA. In those 37.1 innings, the Riders ceded just 30 hits while striking out 36 and walking 12.

### BROKEN BATS:

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.4 runs per game, a .238 batting average and 18 home runs over their 32 games. The 18 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A and the 11th-fewest in the minors.

### DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in six of the last 11 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 96 over their 127 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.371/.435/.806 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 633 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .356 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: **Evan Carter** (74, 5th), **Trevor Hauver** (71, 6th), **Kellen Strahm** (68, 8th) and **Aaron Zavala** (67, 9th). In 2015, **Drew Robinson** set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 133. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

### HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 40 games, Hicks is batting .305 (43-for-141)/.419/.397/.816 with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 22 RBIs, 23 walks and 18 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

### K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on August 17th in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 11 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.
