## Stockton Ports (14-12) RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (18-8)



### LHP Wei-En Lin (1-0, 2.70 ERA) vs. LHP Jakob Wright (0-0, 0.00 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as the Quakes wrap a six-game home stand with the final game of a six-game series against the Stockton Ports (ATH). Due to the rain earlier this morning, today's U.S. Bank Youth Clinic was postponed. Details will become available on the next U.S. Bank Kids Clinic on our website in the future. After today's game, kids will "Run the Bases", thanks to San Antonio Regional Hosptial. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com. **VS THE PORTS:** Today's game is the 12th of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the last of six at home. The Quakes dropped four of six in Stockton on their first road trip of 2025, but after taking four of five here at home, are now 6-5 against Stockton in 2025. In 2024, Rancho went 8-2 against the Ports, 3-1 here at LoanMart Field. LAST GAME: Four pitchers combined on a two-hit shutout over nine innings, as the Quakes blanked the Ports on Saturday night, 5-0 at LoanMart Field. Hyun-Seok Jang, Alex Makarewich (3-0), Jholbran Herder and Nicolas Cruz combined to allow two hits and one walk, while striking out 11 batters in helping the Quakes earn their second shutout of the year and their ninth win in their last ten games. Rancho's offense collected just eight hits, with Jaron Elkins being the only Quake to record two hits, finishing 2-for-4 with an RBI. Stockton starter Nathan Dettmer (2-2) took the loss.

PLENTY OF WINNING: Friday's loss ended Rancho's best run of the season, at straight games overall and five straight here at home. While both those streaks ended on Friday, Saturday's win gives them nine of ten overall, four of five in this series and six of seven at home. They're now 11-3 at LoanMart Field, having gone 3-0 against Lake Elsinore and 4-2 over San Jose. Last night's win gives them a third straight series-win at home. Their longest winning streak since moving from High-A to Low-A is 10 straight (2023). Their longest winning streak in franchise history was in their third and most recent championship season of 2018, when they won 15 straight.

SEAN PAUL RAISING THE TEMPERATURE: Sean Paul Linan was named Cal League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April, after dominating over five appearances (four starts). Linan went 2-1 with a 1.40 ERA, striking out 45 batters, while walking just six over 25.2 innings of work. Linan was also named Cal League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 20th, where he allowed one hit and one walk, while striking out ten over five in a win over San Jose. **PROSPECT HEAVY:** According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of

their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

JAKOB WRIGHT: Left-hander Jakob Wright makes his first start against Stockton, the second appearance of his procareer and his first appearance since coming off the Injured List with a blister on his left hand. Wright made his pro debut on April 6th against the Lake Elsinore Storm and tossed 3.2 innings of scoreless baseball, allowing just two hits and two walks, while striking out five in a no-decision. Wright was drafted by the Dodgers in the fourth round of the 2024 draft out of Cal Poly Pomona.

**WEI-EN-LIN**: Lefty Wei-En Lin makes his sixth appearance and third start for Stockton and his third appearance and second start against the Quakes. In two games against Rancho this year, he's allowed three runs on ten hits over eight innings, with 12 strikeouts and no walks. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on four hits over three relief innings in a no-decision against Rancho on April 29th. Lin signed with the A's in June of 2024 out of Taiwan and is now in his first pro season.
