On this day in 1993, the Sounds took Game 7 of the American Association Championship Series to extra innings, falling 3-2 in an 11-inning walkoff loss to Iowa. After going down 3-1 in the set, the Sounds won games 5 and 6 to force the decisive seventh game.

**Extra, Extra!:** Last night was Nashville's 17th extra-inning game of the season, tying the single-season franchise record also set in 1980, 1988, 2005 and 2012. The club is 10-7 in extra-inning games in 2023, with the most extra-inning wins coming in 1980 (14-3).

Junk has taken the loss in four of his last five starts, while the Sounds have lost in each of his last seven outings.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Junk has two career starts against Charlotte, posting a 0-1 record and 3.38 ERA (13.1 IP/5 ER). Junk took the loss despite a quality start on August 19 vs. the Knights (7 IP, 2 ER).
