ENCARNACION HOMERS AGAIN BUT SHRIMP LOSE

Jerar Encarnacion homered for the second consecutive day, but the Jumbo Shrimp dropped a 7-1 decision on Wednesday to the Bulls. Tristan Gray launched a two-run home run in the second to get the scoring start for the Durham. One inning later, Jim Haley bopped a two-run shot of his own to put the Bulls ahead 4-0. Durham plated two more in the fourth and added another in the eighth to go up 7-0. Encarnacion then blasted a solo shot in the ninth for Jacksonville to avoid its first shutout loss of the season. Jeff Brigham fanned six batters in 2.0 hitless innings of relief, and the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen yielded just one run on two hits in 5.0 innings.

FOUR SQUARE

Jacksonville 7-1 loss to Durham on Wednesday meant the Jumbo Shrimp's losing streak his four games - the club's longest of the season and two contests off their six-game skid from July 3-9, 2021, which marked their biggest rut of 2021. The Jumbo Shrimp have yielded at least seven runs in each of their four consecutive defeats and five of the last six games. Jacksonville has lost five of those last six affairs, getting outscored by a margin of 48-24. The club's 7.67 ERA over the last six games is third-worst in Triple-A.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville boasts a 12-6 record on the road thus far in 2022, but the club has struggled at home, posting just an 8-12 mark. Interestingly, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit far better on the road, posting a team batting line of .299/.368/.516. The club's resulting .884 OPS places third in Triple-A. When playing at 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville is hitting .235/.323/.388, with the club's .711 OPS ranking 21st at the Triple-A level. Despite playing in more games at home than on the road, just 22 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 53 home runs have come at home.

SIX & DIP

Heading into play on Thursday, Jacksonville has scored at least six runs in 17 of their last 30 games, and 19 of the club's 38 contests (50.0 percent) this year. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent). When scoring at least six runs this season, Jacksonville is a robust 16-3 (.842).

JERARSSIC PARK

At the time of his May 17 promotion to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola, Jerar Encarnacion had been ravaging the Southern League, ranking in the circuit's top 10 in average (1st, .358), hits (2nd, 43), runs (2nd, 26), on-base percentage (3rd, .426), OPS (3rd, 1.010), slugging (4th, .583) and home runs (T-4th, 8). Encarnacion has picked up precisely where he left off in Double-A in his transition to the International League. Through his first two games with the Jumbo Shrimp, the native of Bayaguana in the Dominican Republic is 5-for-8 with one double, two home runs, three RBIs and two runs scored.

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Dating back to April 23, **Charles Leblanc** has reached base in 21 of his last 22 games, going 29-for-88 at the plate for a .330/.379/.489/.868 line with five doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs and 11 runs scored. On the season, the Laval, Quebec City native has reached base safely in 31 of his 34 games, with multiple trips on in 17 of those contests. Leblanc ranks second in the IL in batting average (.344), fourth in hits (45), sixth in OPS (.973), tied for sixth in RBIs (27), eighth in slugging (.565), 10th in on-base percentage (.408) and tied for 15th in home runs (7).

BLEDAY OF THE DEAD

Over the season's first 18 games, Jacksonville outfielder JJ Bleday struggled, going just 10-for-63 at the plate with two doubles and two home runs for a .159/.321/.286/.607 batting line. However, over the last 17 games, Bleday is 16-for-59 with three doubles and five home runs, slashing .271/.419/.576/.995. Including a nine-game hitting streak from April 28-May 7, Bleday has reached base at least once in 15 of those last 17 contests. Among the 123 qualified hitters in the IL, Bleday has posted the circuit's highest fly ball rate (58.0 percent), fifth-lowest groundball rate (28.4 percent) and 10th-lowest line drive rate (13.6 percent).

SHRIMP BITE

Left-hander **Will Stewart** gets the nod in Thursday's contest against Durham. Stewart will be the 10th different starting pitcher for the Jumbo Shrimp through 39 games this season. In 2021, Jacksonville set a franchise record with 21 different starting pitchers.

ABOUT WILL

-Stewart was originally drafted by the Philadelphia Phillies in the 20th round of the 2015 draft out of Hazel Green High School (Huntsville, Ala.).

-The southpaw was included by Philadelphia in the February 7, 2019 trade with Miami along with right-handed pitcher Sixto Sánchez, catcher Jorge Alfaro and international bonus slot money in exchange for catcher J.T. Realmuto.

-In the past, Stewart has said that he needs to be a pitcher who "doesn't care who he's facing" to bring out the best version of himself on the mound. He told the *Miami Herald*, "I could face Bryce Harper. I don't care. I'm going to get him out. I have the mindset of I'm going to get you. You're not going to beat me. Not today. Not tomorrow. Not ever. That's who the best Will Stewart is."

2022 SEASON

-Stewart was promoted to Jacksonville on May 19 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion he ranked eighth in the Southern League in WHIP (1.19) and ninth in batting average against (.231).

-Among the 146 pitchers in the Southern League with at least 20.0 innings pitched on May 19, Stewart had posted the eighth-highest ground ball rate (56.0 percent) and seventh-lowest fly ball rate (25.3 percent). He also had registered the 13th-lowest swinging-strike rate at 10.1 percent.

2021 SEASON

-Stewart had fairly even splits against both lefties and righties in 2021. Left-handed hitters batted .256 with a .712 OPS against him, while righties posted a .258 average and .739 OPS against him.

2019 SEASON

-Seven of Stewart's 21 starts lasted at least seven innings, including a season-best 8.2 frames on July 20,2019 against the Palm Beach Cardinals.

-Stewart had two starts in which he gave up nine earned runs and two others in which he surrendered six earned runs. In his other 19 appearances, 17 of them starts, his ERA was 3.60

-In each outing in which he gave up nine earned runs, he followed those starts up by going at least seven innings and yielding three earned runs or fewer.

-The southpaw surrendered 11 home runs to right-handed hitters in 354 at-bats (32.1 AB/ HR). However, against left-handed hitters, he allowed just two long balls in 145 at-bats (72.5 AB/HR).

2018 SEASON

-The Huntsville, Ala. native gave up three earned runs or fewer in 19 of his 20 starts during the 2018 campaing. He also never walked more than three batters in any outing, including 14 starts with one walk or fewer.

-Stewart's 62.1 percent ground ball rate was the third-highest out of 579 qualifiers throughout all of Minor League Baseball,.

-In the month of May, Stewart compiled 0.74 ERA, yielding five runs, three earned, on 23 hits with seven walks and 34 strikeouts in 36.2 innings.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Stewart surrendered 13 home runs during the 2019 season (129.1 innings - 9.9 IP/HR). However, in the four seasons prior to that, he gave up just 12 dingers (239.0 innings - 19.9 IP/HR). He ceded nine long balls in 99.2 innings in 2021 (11.1 IP/HR).
