LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox faltered late in a 9-4 loss to the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Tuesday night. Richmond scored eight unanswered runs from the fifth inning onward after Bowie took a 4-1 lead through four innings. Jud Fabian and Samuel Basallo homered to give Bowie an early lead but a three-run fifth, a four-run seventh and a run in the eighth gave Richmond its fifth victory of the season over Bowie this year. Starting right-hander Trace Bright lasted only four innings and allowed four runs on five hits.

JUD FLEXIN' ON EM

OF **Jud Fabian** has continued to stay hot in the month of May. The Orioles No. 12 prospect launched his team-leading eighth homer of the season in the first inning yesterday with a two-run shot. The homer was Fabian's sixth of the month, which is tied for the league lead along with Harrisburg's Brady House. In the month of May, Fabian is slashing .298/.354/.649 with six homers and 15 RBI. The 23-year-old is tied for fourth in the Eastern League with eight homers this season.

BASALLO BLASTS

C **Samuel Basallo** ended a 52 at-bat home run drought on Tuesday with an opposite field homer off LHP Nick Swiney. It was the second time this season that Basallo has teed off against the Richmond southpaw reliever and the homer was his fourth against a lefty this year. Last season, Basallo hit three homers against lefties across Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen. The Orioles No. 2 prospect has three multihit performances over his last four games.

STARTING OUT RIGHT

Bowie starting pitching was superb at Binghamton this past week. Starters **Ryan Long, Trace Bright, Brandon Young, Seth Johnson**, and **Alex Pham** combined to give up just four earned runs over 23.1 innings thrown (1.54 ERA). The Baysox staff ERA in the series was just 1.38, the lowest in all of MiLB for the week of May 14 - May 21.

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After five more innings and five more strikeouts from Baysox relievers yesterday, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (187.2) and strikeouts (231). 20 of the 21 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Bowie's bullpen also has a 1.16 WHIP, which is fourth-lowest in all of Double-A.

BRANDON ON THE BUMP

RHP **Brandon Young** makes his seventh appearance of the year and his sixth start. The 25-year-old is coming off his second scoreless start of the season after dealing 3.1 innings with seven strikeouts against Binghamton last Thursday, matching his season and Double-A high. In his last outing against Richmond on April 27, Young threw three perfect innings and struck out seven. The undrafted free agent is looking to pitch five innings for the first time since September 5, 2023 against New Hampshire.

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

Entering this week, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are fifth in the Southwest Division at 17-22 but most recently took five of six against Reading at home. The Double-A affiliate of the Giants took four of six against Bowie in the first meeting of the season at The Diamond. Seven of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), OF Grant McCray (OF), OF Vaun Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), C Adrian Sugastey (No. 23), OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26), and RHP Carson Ragsdale (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Hayden Birdsong receives the start for Richmond this afternoon. The Giants No. 6 prospect is coming off a strong outing vs Reading on May 16 where he threw five innings and allowed just one unearned run over four hits, three walks and five strikeouts to pick up the win. Birdsong has allowed just one earned run over his last 10 innings thrown. The 22-year-old last faced Bowie on April 26 at the Diamond and struck out five over five no-hit innings and allowed just two walks to earn the win.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.
