#### **SUNDAY'S RECAP**

The Chesapeake Baysox lost five of six in their opening series of the second half in a 6-4 defeat to Altoona on Sunday. The Baysox scored early in the first on an RBI triple from **Silas Ardoin** and an RBI single from **Max Wagner**. Orioles Major League rehabber **Tyler O'Neill** homered to tie the score at four after a four-run third from the Curve. **Ryan Long** threw five innings of two-run ball in relief but Chesapeake mustered just one hit in the final five innings of the game.

#### **HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR**

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** and RHP **Keagan Gillies** were both selected by MLB to participate in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game in Atlanta on Saturday, July 12. Bradfield and Gillies are the 15th and 16th Baysox players and the first duo in franchise history to be selected to baseball's top prospect showcase. Bradfield, the Orioles No. 2 prospect, stole the second-most bases last season (74) and won an MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in the outfield. Gillies holds a 1.15 ERA in 31.1 innings pitched out of the bullpen.

#### SILAS OF SWAT

C **Silas Ardoin** finished the month of June on a strong note. The 24-year-old is batting .450 (9-for-20) over his last six games, which is his best stretch of the season. Ardoin has driven in a run in five of the last six and has collected multi-hit performances in four of the last six.

#### **REED CAN RAKE**

OF **Reed Trimble** has delivered multi-hit efforts in three of his last six games played. Trimble is also on a seven-game on-base streak, which is the longest active streak on the team. On Friday, the 25-year-old collected his second walk-off hit of his career and his first at Double-A. It's Trimble's first walk-off hit since August 27, 2022 – an RBI single in the 10th while with Single-A Delmarva.

#### **GERMAN ON A MISSION**

RHP **Nestor German** is set to make his eighth start of the season for the Baysox since earning promotion from High-A Aberdeen on May 13. Amongst Orioles minor league pitchers, German is fourth in WHIP (1.21), sixth in innings pitched (61.0), and sixth in strikeouts (70). The Orioles No. 10 prospect is coming off his best month of the season where he recorded a 2.49 ERA and a 0.74 WHIP in 21.2 IP in the month of June.

#### **CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL**

Chesapeake has won 17 one-run games this season - **tied for the most in the Eastern League.** The Baysox have played 30 one-run games this season, **which is the most in all of Double-A.** Chesapeake won its ninth extra-inning game of the season on Friday, which is the second-most amongst full-season MiLB clubs (Quad Cities - High-A KC).

#### BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.95 ERA, which is fourth-best in Double-A and sixth-best in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 376 hitters, which is second-most in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

#### SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels - Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants - finished the first half with a 21-46 record, which was last in the league. Richmond started the second half with a home series loss to Reading. Richmond's roster includes five of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - LHP Joe Whitman (No. 6), IF Diego Velasquez (No. 15), IF Aeverson Arteaga (No. 16), IF Sabin Ceballos (No. 23) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 27)

#### **TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER**

LHP Jack Choate makes his 15th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. Choate is coming off his shortest outing of the season where he threw just 1.2 innings and gave up two runs on two hits with a season-high four walks on 58 pitches. The Giants No. 27 prospect last faced the Baysox on April 19 and struck out seven in 4.2 shutout innings. Choate was drafted in 2022 out of DII Assumption University (MA).

Attended same university as reigning AL Cy Young winner Tarik Skubal (Seattle Univ.)

2025: Threw 5.2 IP of two-run ball and struck out five over zero walks in most recent start on 6/25 vs ALT. Finished month of June with a 2.49 ERA (8th-best in EL), a 0.74 WHIP (2nd-best in EL) and a .135 BAA. Named EL Pitcher of the Week for 6/10-6/15 after 6.0 shutout, one-hit innings and 6 K on 6/13 vs HBG. First Baysox player this season to be named EL Player/Pitcher of the Week. Threw 11.2 consecutive scoreless innings to start month of June. Baysox are 3-4 when he starts. Pitched 5.2 shutout innings and struck out six in Double-A debut on 5/16 vs AKR. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 5/13. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made six starts and posted a 3.60 ERA with 37 K over 25 innings pitched over 10 walks allowed. Struck out seven batters in each of his final three starts with IronBirds before earning promotion. At time of promotion, was tied for 10th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts.

2024: Spent first season in Minors between Single-A Delmarva as a starter and High-A Aberdeen as a tandem reliever. Struck out 90 batters in 73.2 innings to a 1.59 ERA. Began season in Delmarva. Recorded a 1.49 ERA in 48.1 IP with 57 K. Missed a month of season from 5/15-6/14 due to injury. Promoted to Aberdeen on 8/1. In seven outings, posted a 1.78 ERA in 25.1 innings with 33 strikeouts over just three walks. Excelled at home: 0.69 ERA in 11 home outings.

#### CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

#### **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
