Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds begin a six-game series against the Charlotte Knights, affiliate of the Chicago White Sox. Nashville is coming off a series win at Indy, while the struggling Knights were swept by Gwinnett. Left-hander Eric Lauer starts for the Sounds. He'll face Chase Solesky.

Eric Lauer: 28-year-old Eric Lauer makes his 13th start and fourth with Nashville tonight. The left-hander is 1-1 with a 6.17 ERA (11.2 IP/8 ER) with the Sounds this season. He had his first start since July 28 last week at Indianapolis, working 3.0 scoreless innings in game one of a doubleheader on August 10. He gave up three hits with a couple walks and four strikeouts in Nashville's 8-0 win. In three appearances this month, Lauer has allowed one run (ER) across 7.0 innings. He began the year with Milwaukee and found himself on the 15-day injured list with right shoulder impingement on May 22 (retro to May 21). He was optioned to Nashville after a few rehab appearances after coming off the injured list on June 14, then placed on the inactive list on June 21. Lauer returned to Nashville after several outings with the ACL Brewers in July. Lauer attended Kent State University after graduating from Midview High School in Grafton, Ohio. The Golden Flash was selected in the first round (25th pick) by San Diego in the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

Chase Solesky: 25-year-old Chase Solesky starts the series opener for Charlotte. The right-hander has yet to find his first Triple-A win, starting 0-8 with a 7.28 ERA (47.0 IP/38 ER) through 10 starts. He began the year with Double-A Birmingham and went 3-2 with a 3.23 ERA (39.0 IP/14 ER) before his promotion to Charlotte on June 16. Solesky allowed a couple runs (both earned) in 4.0 innings in a loss on August 9 vs. Gwinnett. Eight of his 12 outs recorded came via strikeout, Solesky's most since June 23, 2021 vs. Fayetteville with Kannapolis. He was drafted by the White Sox in the 21st round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Tulane University.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in the second half of 2023: First: 6 (Tied), Second: 9, Third: 11, Fourth: 8, Fifth: 4, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

That's All We Got: Though Nashville won the series, the Sounds mustered only one hit, a single by Keston Hiura, in Sunday's 4-0 loss to Indianapolis. It was the second time the Sounds were held to a singular hit this season (last was on May 17 at Durham), also just a lone single.

Scouting the Standings: Entering the day, the Sounds trail International League leaders Lehigh Valley and Worcester by four games in the second half standings. Though only a handful of games back, the Sounds are tied for 10th in the league, with Durham, Jacksonville, St. Paul, Iowa, Gwinnett, Scranton/WB and Norfolk checking in above Nashville.

I Can Be Your Hiura: Keston Hiura extended his on-base streak to 12 games with a single on Sunday. It is Hiura's third-longest on-base streak this season. During that span, he is batting .319 (15-for-47) with three doubles, two homers, 14 RBI and a .896 OPS.

The Legend of Pat the Bat: Despite a quiet day on Sunday, Patrick Dorrian still paces league leaders with a power surge since the All-Star break. The infielder has a team-best 19 home runs, including 10 since the All-Star break. That is tied for the second-most in the IL since then, trailing only Luken Baker of Memphis (11). The infielder also ranks among International League leaders in slugging percentage (T-2nd, .726), RBI (T-4th, 26), total bases (T-7th, 61), extra-base hits (T-7th, 16) and OPS (10th, 1.104) during that time.

Extreme ERAs: This week's series pairs the league's best and worst pitching staffs (by ERA). The Sounds pace Triple-A with a 4.46 ERA and leads the league with a 1.41 WHIP. Charlotte holds the league's worst ERA (and 29th in Triple-A) at 6.59, which is far-and-away higher than Toledo's 19th-best ERA at 5.67. The Knights have also allowed the second-most home runs (168) and second-most walks (590) in the league.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's recently updated Top-30 Milwaukee prospects list. Infielder Tyler Black is the No. 5 prospect and No. 56 in baseball (previously No. 5/No. 91), left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 6 prospect (previously No. 7) and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the organization's No. 30 prospect (previously No. 11).

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 660-570 record during an eight-season span.
