Leading Off

Tonight, Reading continues a six-game series against Binghamton after falling Thursday night. It'll be a showdown between Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel and Luis Moreno.

Looking Back

Reading fell again 10-8 to Binghamton last night to fall down 0-2 in the series. The R-Phils allowed 14 hits, which matched a season high and also matched a season-high with eight extra-base hits allowed. The pitching did register 15 strikeouts though. Ethan Wilson, Johan Rojas and Herbert Iser all homered. For Iser, it was his first of the season and first since Sept. 9, 2022 against New Hampshire.

De La Cruzin'

Carlos De La Cruz has been red-hot for the Fightin Phils. He currently holds a 23-game on-streak and has hits in 14 straight. Over his 14-game hitting streak, De La Cruz is hitting .328 and is also hitting .409 over his last five games.

Rojas Rolling

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Offensively, he is 6-8 this week and Rojas is hitting .450 over his last five games. Rojas also leads all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks seventh in the Eastern League with a .301 average.

Kroon Crushing It

Matthew Kroon joins the party of hot R-Phils at the plate lately. He joined Rojas with a four-hit performance Tuesday and is 5-8 on the series and is hitting .444 over his last five games. He ranks sixth in the Eastern League with a .308 average.

Bullpen Blues

This week's series features the two bullpens with the highest ERA in the Eastern League. Reading enters tonight ranked 11th with a 5.48 ERA, and Binghamton is 12th with a 5.66 ERA. A recent bright spot in the R-Phils bullpen has been Phillies No. 17 prospect Andrew Baker. Baker has turned in four-straight scoreless inning and five of his last six outings have been scoreless.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies came from behind in the ninth inning for a 3-2 win over the Tigers thanks to a walk off hit from Kody Clemens. Zach Wheeler also pitched over seven no-hit innings before allowing a hit. Lehigh Valley fell 5-2 in the opening game at Syracuse. Jersey Shore swept a doubleheader over Hudson Valley to move one-half game out of first place. Finally, Clearwater beat Fort Myers 2-0 to improve to 39-14 on the season and are now just one-win away from clinching a first-half title.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 9, 2006: At Reading, the Phils use a 6-run 1st and a 2-run 2nd to build an 8-1 lead, then hold on to beat Trenton, 9-7. Michael Bourn reaches base all five trips to the plate, going 3-for-3 with a pair of walks, two stolen bases and two runs scored.

Ponies Rumbling into Reading

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Binghamton. The Rumble Ponies sit in fourth in the Northeast standings, five-games ahead of Reading. The Ponies entered the series losers of five straight since winning game one at Altoona next week. After this week, Binghamton returns home to welcome Portland after finishing off a 12-game road trip.

Ponies Pitcher

Righty Luis Moreno gets the start for Binghamton tonight. It will be his 11th appearance and 10th start. Moreno is 3-2 with a 6.55 ERA and has 33 strikeouts to 30 walks over 44 innings. At Altoona on June 1, he went 4.1 innings and allowed five-earned runs in a loss. Moreno split 2022 between St. Lucie and Brooklyn and was signed out of the Dominican Republic in 2019 at 20-years old.

2023: Entered season as Phillies second-ranked prospect, trailing only Andrew Painter. Earned invite to Phillies spring training. Appeared in two games (one start) and threw three innings. Allowed no runs and one hit. Struck out two and walked two. 2022: Split season between High-A Jersey Shore and Double-A Reading. Went 7-8 over 18 starts with Jersey Shore. With Reading, he started five games and went 1-3 with a 4.01 ERA. 2021: Spent entire season with Single-A Clearwater. He started 14 games and went 1-3 with a 4.43 ERA over 44.2 nnings pitched. 2020: Was first round selection of Phillies out of Jesuit High School in Portland, Oregon. High School: First baseman and pitcher for Jesuit. Injured shoulder as sophomore and required surgery. As a junior Abel posted a 10-0 record with a 1.26 ERA and 111 strikeouts in 72+1/3 innings pitched while also batting .294 with 12 runs scored and 14 RBIs as he helped lead the Crusaders to a state championship and was named the Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year and a Junior All-American by MaxPreps. In 2019, he was selected for U-18 United States national baseball team. Entering his 2020 senior season Abel was named a preseason All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America and was considered to be a top prospect for the upcoming draft. He was also ranked the fourth best collegiate prospect in the nation and committed to play at Oregon State University after his freshman year of high school. PERSONAL: Abel grew up in Cedar Mill, Oregon, and helped lead the Cedar Mill Little League team win a state title as a youth.
