FROM THE CROW'S NEST

LAST TIME OUT: After the score remained close the majority of the way Thursday night, the Marauders saw Lakeland pull away with a three-run eighth inning in a 9-4 loss... **Anthony Solometo** allowed just one run over four innings in his second start, striking out four and leaving with the score tied, 1-1... **Brenden Dixon** had tied the score with an RBI-single in the top of the fourth, but after a three-run Flying Tigers rally in the fifth off **Carlos Lomeli** and **Darvin Garcia**, the Marauders would not pull even again... Lakeland saw three hitters collect three or more hits, led by Izaac Pacheco's 4-for-5 performance... The Marauders' 13 hits allowed matched a season-high (April 29 vs Dunedin)... Starter Nick Davila tossed five innings for the Tigers, holding Bradenton to one run and striking out five.

THE OPPONENT: The Flying Tigers' loss Wednesday ended a five-game winning streak... Lakeland is in third place in the FSL West Division, two games ahead of the Marauders... The team's roster currently features seven players in *Baseball America's* latest top 30 prospect rankings for the Tigers organization: RHP Jackson Jobe (#3), OF Roberto Campos (#7), INF Izaac Pacheco (#13), INF Cristian Santana (#16), INF Manuel Sequera (#18), OF Jose de la Cruz (#24), and LHP Brant Hurter (#29).

STARTING STRONG: Over the last four games, Bradenton's starting pitchers have combined for a 1.71 ERA and a 1.00 WHIP (21 IP total), including just two walks and 21 strikeouts... The stretch includes back-to-back quality starts from right-handers **Valentin Linarez** and **Joelvis del Rosario** on Tuesday and Wednesday, respectively.

CATCHING UP WITH CAMPY: **Sergio Campana** has reached base safely in 17 of his last 20 games, posting a .385 OBP and stealing 9 bases during that period... His 11 total stolen bases (15 attempts) lead the team... Campana also owns a 36-game errorless streak in the outfield, tied for the longest errorless streak in the FSL.

SO FAR FROM HOME: The Marauders are 8-16 away from LECOM Park this season, compared to 13-11 at home... Bradenton has not won a road series since the opening series of the season, a two-games-to-one series victory at Dunedin, April 8-10.

TOP PIRATES PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently includes two prospects in *Baseball America's* Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: LHP **Anthony Solometo** (#11) and OF **Rodolfo Nolasco** (#28)... *Baseball America* lists the Pirates' farm system as the third-best in baseball.

FIELD STAFF: Manager **Jonathan Johnston**, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer **Yorman Bazardo** is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate **Mendy López** joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... **Casey Harms** is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... **Gustavo Omaña** is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021.

HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS: The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Hank Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS/INFO

2022: In season debut April 9 at Dunedin, allowed a leadoff double in the first inning that later scored on a sac fly, but proceeded to retire the final 12 batters he faced... April 16 vs Lakeland, allowed a first-inning RBI-single, worked around two walks in a scoreless second inning but was lifted in the fourth after an RBI-single (threw season-high 68 pitches in 3.1 IP)... April 23 at Daytona, held Tortugas scoreless across first three innings (allowed 2 BB, 2 1B) and pitched a perfect fourth inning before leaving with one out in the fifth after an RBI-single (two inherited runners later scored)... April 30 vs Dunedin, allowed a leadoff walk to begin the game (later advanced on a throwing error, eventually scored on an infield single), but an inning-ending double play began a streak of 13 straight batters retired to finish his outing through five innings... May 6 vs Tampa, matched career-high with 7 strikeouts but allowed season-high 4 runs... May 14 at Jupiter (game 1 of doubleheader): allowed three runs across first two innings, then retired 10 of last 11 batters faced... May 21 at Palm Beach (G1 of DH): allowed five hits (4 singles, 1 double) in a four-run first inning, then retired the final seven batters he faced through three innings... Last Thursday vs Fort Myers: allowed career-high 5 runs on 3 BB, 3 H but matched career-high 7 K in loss...

2021: Made stateside debut with 6 stellar starts for FCL Pirates Black, posting a 0.69 ERA and 0.69 WHIP while holding opponents to a .191 AVG... Promoted to Bradenton on August 25 and made his Low-A debut four days later at Fort Myers (tossed 2 IP scoreless before surrendering 4 runs in 3rd inning... Marauders eventually won, 22-5)... Faced 107 batters before issuing his first career walk (Fort Myers' Alerick Soularie in 3rd inning on August 29)... On September 12 at Clearwater, tossed a career-high 7 innings, holding the Threshers scoreless and allowing just three hits, all singles...

2020: Signed with Pirates as an international free agent on October 7...

2019: Was a member of the world champion U-18 Chinese Taipei national team... During the tournament, posted a 1.29 ERA in 14 IP against Panama, Korea, and the U.S....

PERSONAL: Pirates GM Ben Cherington: "Po-Yu Chen is an exciting young pitching prospect who has been a prominent part of the Taiwanese national program and in International competition. He has good size, moves well on the mound, and has a quality pitch mix with the ability to keep getting better." ... Chen's father, Ping-Nan Chen, was the baseball coach at his school and pitched professionally in the Chinese Professional Baseball League... Chen considers his father one of his main role models... Hometown of Taoyuan City has a population of 2.2 million... "Taoyuan" is Chinese for "peach garden," as the city was once home to many peach trees... Taoyuan International Baseball Stadium is home to the Rakuten Monkeys of the Chinese Professional Baseball League...
