vs. the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Miami Marlins) at 121 Financial Park. It is the eighth of 24 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the eighth of 12 games the Stripers will play in Jacksonville.

VS. JACKSONVILLE: Last night's win was just the second ever for Gwinnett in the state of Florida (now 2-5). The Stripers went 1-5 on their first trip to Jacksonville from 4/19-24, 2022, and were outscored 35-19 in that series (only win was on 4/23, 10-8 in 10 innings). Entering this week, the Stripers were 1-2-0 in three series all-time vs. Jacksonville.

TUI ONE WIN FROM 100: Stripers' second-year manager Matt Tuiasosopo has guided the club to a 99-85 (.538) record in 184 games since the start of 2021. His next victory will make him the fourth skipper in Gwinnett history to reach the 100-win mark, joining Dave Brundage (293 wins from 2009-12), Damon Berryhill (221 wins from 2017-19), and Brian Snitker (161 wins from 2014-16).

NEAR NO-NO: Huascar Ynoa (7.0 IP, 0 H, 3 BB, 6 SO), Brandyn Sittinger (1.0 IP, 1 H) and Brad Brach (1.0 IP, 0 H, 1 BB, 1 SO) combined on a one-hit shutout last night. It was the fewest hits allowed in a game by Stripers pitchers since 9/9/21 at Columbus, when Bryce Elder (7.0 IP, 1 H), Thomas Burrows (1.0 IP, 0 H), and Yoan Lopez (1.0 IP, 0 H) also combined on a one-hitter in a 1-0 victory.

• No-Hitter History: There have been two no-hitters in the history of Gwinnett baseball, 5/28/10 at Louisville (Todd Redmond 9.0 IP CG in 4-0 win) and 6/30/16 at Louisville (Rob Wooten 6.0 IP, Matt Marksberry 2.0 IP, Jose Ramirez 1.0 IP in 3-0 win).

STIFLING STARTERS: Including Huascar Ynoa's 7.0-inning outing last night (ties his single-game career high), Stripers' starters (Ynoa, Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller) are a combined 3-1 with a 2.08 ERA (10 ER in 43.1 IP, 24 H, 12 BB, 42 SO) and four quality starts over the last seven games (team is 4-3).

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 571 in 55 games (10.38 SO per game). That's 10 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 561 SO in 55G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (T-2nd, 64) and Huascar Ynoa (T-10th, 49) both rank among the IL top 10 in strikeouts though 6/7.

RISING WATERS: Drew Waters tallied his second four-hit game of the season last night (4-for-5, HR, 2 R, RBI), his first since his 2022 Stripers debut on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (4for-4, leadoff HR, 2 R, 2 RBI). The switch-hitting Waters is batting .284 (25-for-88, 5 2B, 3 HR, 15 R, 8 RBI, 1 SB) in 23 games overall, including .556 (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.401 OPS) vs. LHP and .164 (1 2B, 2 HR, .482 OPS) vs. RHP.

• GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, batting .252 (151-for-599, 32 2B, 1 3B, 16 HR, 102 R, 56 RBI, 32 SB, .718 OPS) in 152 games.

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 33 of 40 games (82.5%) with the Stripers, batting .248 (28-for-113, 5 2B, 14 R, 10 RBI). He ranks among IL leaders in walks (9th, 30) and stolen bases (T-11th, 11), and his .412 OBP would rank fifth in the circuit if he had enough at-bats to qualify

TONIGHT: The Stripers play game two of a six-game series **THE GOOSE! Phil Gosselin** has hit safely in 21 of 25 games since 5/1, batting .337 (32-for-95, 9 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 15 RBI, .949 OPS) in that stretch. He ranks 11th in the IL with a .310 average (52-for-168, 12 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 23 RBI, 4 SB, .861 OPS) in 45 games.

• GWN Career: In 280 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), batting .298 (307-for-1032, 63 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 105 RBI, 11 SB, .773 OPS). He is one of seven players in club history with 300-plus hits.

LET'S GET TROMPICAL: Chadwick Tromp drove in the decisive runs last night (1-for-4, 2 RBI), raising his RBI total to a team-best 29. He also leads the club in homers (9) and is tied for second in total bases (66).

Mashed in May: Over 20 games in May, Tromp ranked among IL leaders in homers (T-3rd, 8), RBI (T-6th, 22), SLG (T-7th. .632), extra-base hits (T-10th. 12), and total bases (T-12th, 48). He was named the IL Offensive Player of the Week for 5/2-8 after batting .471 (8-for-17) with league highs in homers (4), extra-base hits (7), RBI (12), SLG (1.353), and OPS (1.879). Tromp's monster month included a Gwinnett-record nine-game extrabase hit streak from 5/1-12 (4 2B, 7 HR).

NEW ARRIVALS: The Braves have added two infielders to the Gwinnett roster since 6/1, both claimed off waivers: Joe Dunand (from Miami on 6/1) and Kramer Robertson (from St. Louis on 6/5).

- Dunand: In addition to playing for Jacksonville (.242, 6 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI, 2 SB in 20G), had his contract selected by Miami on 5/7 and made his MLB debut (.300, 1 2B, 1 HR, 2 R, 1 RBI) before being DFA'd on 5/29.
- Robertson: In addition to playing for Memphis (.220, 5 2B, 5 HR, 17 RBI, 12 SB in 38G), had his contract selected by St. Louis on 5/10 and made his MLB debut (.000, 0-for-1, 1 RBI in 2G) before being DFA'd on 6/3.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte returned to the Stripers lineup on 6/1 vs. Louisville (1-for-4, 2 R), his first game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Has reached base safely in 162 of 190 games (85.3%) since 2019, batting .284 (186-for-655, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 128 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .944 OPS).

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Kyle Muller makes his 10th start with Gwinnett and 11th start overall this season in game two of a six-game series at Jacksonville.

- IL Leaderboard: Currently among top 10 in strikeouts (T-2nd, 64) and ERA (5th, 3.47).
- GWN Career: Makes his 27th career start with the Stripers ... Is 8-7 with a 3.42 ERA, .228 BAA, and 10.95 SO/9.0 IP ratio (157 SO in 129.0 IP) since debuting in 2021.
- Triple-A Splits: Makes his 16th career Triple-A road start (4-4, 4.15 ERA, .219 BAA) and 23rd career Triple-A night start (6-6, 3.33 ERA, .231 BAA).

PROSPECTING: Muller is currently ranked as the Atlanta Braves' No. 3 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the top-ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's active roster.

2022 WITH GWINNETT: 4/5 at MEM: Was the Stripers' Opening Night starter (ND, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 7 SO in 2-1 loss), making him the first player in Gwinnett history to start consecutive season openers (also on 5/4/21 at Charlotte) ... 4/5-4/23: Made four starts (1-1, 3.66 ERA, .214 BAA) before being recalled by Atlanta on 5/1 ... 5/14 at DUR: Tied his career high with 12 strikeouts, but took the loss (6.0 IP, 6 H, 4 ER, 2 HR), pitched opposite his older brother Chris (1.0 IP, 2 BB, 2 SO with DUR in 6th) for the first time in his professional career ... 6/2 vs. LOU: Tossed a season-high 7.0 innings (4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 SO), falling one out shy of his career high (7.1 IP).

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Recalled by the Braves on 5/1 ... Dallas native started that night against the Texas Rangers in Arlington (loss, 2.2 IP, 4 H, career-high 7 ER, 6 BB, 3 SO in Braves' 7-3 loss) ... Optioned back to Gwinnett after the game.

2021 SEASON: Muller made both his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett (5-4, 3.39 ERA, .223 BAA in 17 starts) and Major League debut with Atlanta (2-4, 4.17 ERA, .202 BAA in 9G, 8 starts) ... Posted a 4.60 ERA in his first stint with the Stripers (7 starts) before being recalled for his MLB debut on 6/16 vs. Boston (1.0 IP in relief, 4 H, 2 ER, 1 SO) ...
