RHP George Kirby (0-0, 6.00) vs. RHP Bradley Blalock (0-0, 6.48)

TODAY'S GAME: Tacoma holds a 2-1 series lead after Albuquerque secured a 5-4 walk-off win last night on Ryan Ritter's RBI double ... The win ended the Isotopes three-game home losing streak ... Bradley Blalock is slated to take the hill for the Isotopes while Seattle Mariners right-hander George Kirby is expected to make a rehab start for the Rainiers.

WALK-OFF: The walk-off win last night was Albuquerque's fourth of the year and second via an RBI double (last/also: April 29 vs. Salt Lake, Sam Hilliard RBI double).

BY MAY 15: It's the second time in Isotopes history the club has recorded four walk-off wins by May 15 (also: 2006, four).

WALK-OFF VS. TACOMA: Last night was the seventh all-time walk-off against the Rainiers and first since July 12, 2024 (7-6), the second of back-to-back walk-off wins against Tacoma.

ONE-RUN GAMES: Albuquerque improved to 6-8 in one-run games and 4-2 at home. The club has won two of its last three one-run games at home.

CHALLENGE: Last night was the 10th game of the season without the Isotopes challenging a pitch and back-to-back games against Tacoma (excluding the first series in Sacramento when the system was down).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Albuquerque recorded five doubles yesterday, tied for the season-high (also: April 22 at Reno).

PITCHES THROWN: Albuquerque hurlers threw 104 pitches last night , tied for the season-low (also: May 13 vs. Tacoma). The last time the Isotopes threw fewer pitches in a nine-inning game prior to May 13 was April 24, 2022, at Round Rock (100)

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Sam Hilliard has 233 RBI with Albuquerque, second all-time in Isotopes history ... Jason Wood (2003-06, 08) holds the record with 328 RBI.

BEHIND THE DISH: Albuquerque catchers (Braxton Fulford, Austin Nola and Ronaiker Palma) have combined to slash .364/.418/.580 with 52 hits, 13 doubles, six homers and 23 RBI on the year, leading the PCL in hits, doubles, average, OBP and slugging percentage.

TRIPLE-A DEBUT: Mason Albright made his Triple-A debut last night and tossed 6.2 frames and allowed four runs on 10 hits and one homer with three strikeouts. It was the longest start for an Isotope since Tanner Gordon spun 8.0 shutout innings on

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard singled vesterday and has reached base in 30 of 31 games played on the year ... Five of his nine doubles have come in May (10 games) ... Drove in two runs last night, his first RBIs in six games.

ON-BASE STREAK: Sam Hilliard's 24-game on-base streak from April 3-May 6 is the longest in the PCL.

RIT: Ryan Ritter collected two doubles in a game last night for the fourth time in his pro career (last: June 17, 2023) ... It was his eighth multi-hit contest and fourth multi-RBI game of the year ... Has an RBI in five of his last eight games.

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura singled and drew two walks last night and has a hit in nine of 10 games played in May ... During the month, is slashing .343/.425/.600 with a triple, double, two homers and four RBI after hitting .141 over his first 24 games ... Has drawn two walks in a game four times this year.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson doubled twice Wednesday for the second time this year (also: April 17 vs. El Paso) ... Has a four-game hit streak, slashing .538/.600/.769 with three doubles and two RBI. Drove in two runs for the third time this year (also: April 25 at Reno and April 10 at Sugar Land).

BRAX: Braxton Fulford produced his sixth multi-hit contest on the year Wednesday and first since April 11, the tail end of a five-game multi-hit streak ... Eleven of Fulford's 23 hits with Albuquerque this season have gone for extra bases ... Has a hit in 14 of his last 16 contests.

VEEN: Since being sent back down to Albuquerque April 24 (14 games), Zac Veen is 14-for-56 with four doubles, one triple, one homer and five RBI.

COOLING OFF ?: From April 10-30 (15 games), Warming Bernabel slashed .362/.403/.621 with nine doubles, two homers and 17 RBI ... Over his last 11 games, however, is 5-for-36 with one homer and four RBI.

JC: Julio Carreras doubled last night to end a three-game hitless streak. It was his first extra-base hit in seven contests.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is 6th in walks (27) ... Sam Hilliard is T-1st in triples (4) and T-8th in XBH (17).

AVERAGE: Albuquerque's .238 team batting average in May is the third-lowest in the Pacific Coast League this month (lowest: Sacramento, .215).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
