On the Road Again

The Fightin Phils hit the road and continue a six-game series at the Akron Rubber Ducks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. It is the eighth-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and second-of-six at Canal Park. The Rubber Ducks took four-of-six from Reading at FirstEnergy Stadium from July 9-14, and currently lead the season-series 5-2. This is Reading's first trip to Akron since Apr. 12-16, of the 2022 season.

Late Inning Heartbreak

A walkoff home run led the RubberDucks to a 3-2 win over Reading on Tuesday night. The Fightin Phils were up 2-1 with two outs in the ninth, when Cristian Hernandez allowed the game-winning, two-run, home run. Reading's offense was limited to just two hits, which matched a season-low. Justin Crawford drove in both of the R-Phils' runs with a single in the top of the fifth. Konnor Ash opened and struck out four over two-scoreless innings. Andrew Baker was spectacular, striking out five of the six batters he faced in two-perfect innings as well. Tommy McCollum also posted a zero in two innings on the mound.

Welcome Back Walker

Taijuan Walker will make his second rehab start with the Fightin Phils on Wednesday night. Walker was scheduled to start Tuesday night for Triple-A Lehigh Valley at home, but that game was postponed and the weather in the Philadelphia area is iffy over the next few days. So, Walker will join Reading Wednesday night and pitch en route to his way back to the Phillies rotation. Walker pitched for Reading last Wednesday, July 31, against Hartford. He allowed three runs (two-earned) on four hits, over 2.2 innings pitched. Walker also struck out three hitters and walked one.

Welcome to the Bakeshow

Andrew Baker perhaps turned in his best outing of the season on Tuesday night. Baker struck out five over two-perfect innings. It set a new career-high in strikeouts for Baker, surpassing his previous high of four, which he did four times in his career, dating back to 2021. Baker has not allowed a run in his last two outings.

Crawford's Cruising

Justin Crawford had another hit and two RBI in Tuesday night's game for the Fightin Phils. The Phillies No. 3 Prospect has been on a roll since making his Double-A debut on July 19 at Portland. Over 12 games since then, Crawford is slashing .320/.370/.400, with a .770 OPS. Crawford's added five runs, four doubles, six RBI and six stolen bases over that stretch as well. He's also currently on a seven-game hitting streak, dating back to July 26.

Double Trouble

Since the conclusion of the All-Star Break on July 19, the Fightin Phils have turned 21 double plays, which is the most in the Eastern League over that stretch. Heading into action on July 19, Reading ranked last in the Eastern League in double plays turned at 46, but just 15 games later, the Fightin Phils now rank ninth in the Eastern League with 66 double plays.

Bombs Away

The Fightin Phils currently sit second in the Eastern League in home runs hit at 110 this season, which trails first-place Somerset by three. Since June 1, Reading has hit the most home runs in the Eastern League with 68, which leads second place Somerset by six. The R-Phils have also hit 78 home runs over 57 home games this season (1.4/game), which is the most in Double-A by 15. Reading's 78 home runs at home also ranks tied for seventh in all of Minor League Baseball.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 7, 1967: At the Abraham Lincoln Hotel, Phillies president Ruly Carpenter and farm director Paul Owens announce that the Phils have renewed their stadium lease with the city of Reading for the 1968 season. Carpenter and Owens are "extremely pleased with the Reading operation" and would be "extremely pleased if renewal becomes feasible on an annual basis".

The Ducks

Akron enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for the first half with a 37-32 record. They are first in the Southwest Division with a 23-11 record in the second half of the season. Akron most recently split a six-game series with Harrisburg at FNB Field. Following this week, Akron heads to Erie. Akron's roster features six players ranked amongst the Cleveland Guardians' top-30 prospects: Chase DeLauter (1), Kahlil Watson (13), Petey Halpin (14), Parker Messick (20), CJ Kayfus (25) and Dayan Frias (26).

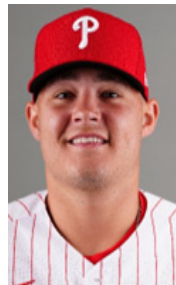
Duck on the Bump

Righty Austin Peterson makes the start tonight for Akron. This season, Peterson is 5-1, with a 2.65 ERA over six starts with Akron. Peterson last pitched July 31 at Harrisburg, earning a win, while allowing three runs on six hits over seven innings pitched. It was his second-straight seven-inning start and third in six starts with Akron. Peterson earned the win against Reading on July 10, allowing two runs over 5.2 innings pitched. Peterson was called up from High-A Lake County on June 24, after going 7-2, with a 2.44 ERA over 14 starts for the Captains. He made his pro debut in 2023 with Single-A Lynchburg, going 6-8, with a 4.54 ERA over 24 starts. Cleveland drafted Peterson in the ninth round of the 2022 draft out of Connecticut, where he pitched from 2021-22.

Made Double-A debut Apr. 18 at BNG, and had no decision. Started strong, retiring the first eight Rumble Ponies' hitters he faced. Threw strikes on 64% of pitches. Walked four hitters in no-decision Apr. 24 vs SOM, but allowed just one hit and no runs. Four walks was career-high. Season-high four innings May 1 at Portland. Matched season and career-high with four walks. Placed on 7-day IL May 9. Began rehab assignment with FCL-Phillies on June 27, coming out of bullpen in one inning against FCL-Yankees. Made two-inning start with FCL-Phillies July 12 vs FCL-Blue Jays, then made three-inning start with Single-A Clearwater July 19 against Fort Myers. Activated off 7-day IL July 25.
