### History vs. Wisconsin

The Lugnuts are 82-60 all-time vs. the Timber Rattlers, 44-25 at home and 38-35 in Appleton. After not meeting in 2021, the Nuts won four of six at Wisconsin in 2022.

This series included the Midwest League debut for Mason Miller on August 28, allowing one run (a Ben Metzinger HR) in two innings. Miller made three appearances total for the Nuts last year; this year, he made his MLB debut on April 19. Unfortunately, he was placed on the Injured List on May 8 (UCL sprain).

**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second game in a 12-game, 13-day road trip at the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. These are the only meetings between the Nuts and Timber Rattlers this season. The Lugnuts won four of six games in Appleton last season, but dropped the opener in a whitewashing last night.

**Yesterday: Timber Rattlers 3, Lugnuts 0.** Touted Brewers prospect **Jacob Misiorowski** dazzled in his home debut with 4 2/3 scoreless innings, combining with three relievers on a four-hit shutout in the series opener. The only runs of the game came in rapid succession in the second inning, scoring on a **Max Muncy** throwing error, a wild pitch and a **Je'Von Ward** RBI single.

**On the Air:** Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with **Chris Mehring** on the call, and an audio-only broadcast via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler**.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play the Timber Rattlers through Sunday, take a day off on June 26, and then continue this two-week road trip with a six-game series at Great Lakes. The next Lugnuts home game will be on the 4th of July against the Lake County Captains.

### LUG•NOTES

**Blanked:** Last night marked the eighth time that Lansing has been shut out this season. Entering today, the Lugnuts are 3-4 in the game following those shutouts.

**Among the League Leaders:** **Daniel Susac** is seventh in batting average (.282); **Junior Perez** is seventh in steals (18); **Jonny Butler** is second in triples (6), ninth in steals (16) and tenth in slugging percentage (.433); closer **Tyler Baum** is tied for second in saves (7); and the promoted **Jack Perkins** is first in WHIP (0.97), third in ERA (2.52) and third in average (.182)

**Guante in Spanish, By the Way, Means Glove:** **Wander Guante**, a pitcher with Single-A Stockton, a level below the Lugnuts, has been honored in two consecutive weeks as the California League's Pitcher of the Week, firing seven two-hit scoreless innings on Sunday. Guante has allowed one run in 21 innings this month, allowing eight hits, walking seven and striking out 17. Lansing has already seen two Stockton starters, **Jake Garland** and **Jose Dicochea**, receive promotions to the Midwest League to replace promoted aces **Blake Beers** and **Jack Perkins**.

**What a Debut:** 2018 Lugnuts infielder **Samad Taylor** made his Major League debut Saturday for the Kansas City Royals, becoming the 178th Nut all-time to reach the Majors and the fifth this year. (The previous four debuted with Oakland: **Ryan Noda**, 3/30; **Hogan Harris**, 4/14; **Mason Miller**, 4/19; and **Garrett Acton**, 5/14.) Taylor's first MLB hit was of the game-winning variety, a walk-off RBI single off the center field wall to send the Royals to a wild 10-9 victory over the Angels. Taylor finished the game 1-for-3 with two runs scored and two walks. **Bobby Witt, Jr.** rushed out to center field to get the ball for Samad.

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C **Tyler Soderstrom**.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Ángeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2013:** The Lugnuts were no-hit for the second time this season (and there's still one more no-hitter to go before the year ends), falling 14-1 at Bowling Green. The Nuts' only run was scored on a third-inning fielding error by 1B Ryan Dunn. Future MLBer Blake Snell pitched the first three innings for BG, walking five and striking out four, and three relievers took it the rest of the way. Meanwhile, the Hot Rods scored eight in the fourth, piled up 15 hits (four by Dunn) and romped. The final Hot Rods pitcher, Marcus Jensen, who pitched the last 1 1/3 innings and struck out Kevin Patterson to end the game, had no idea that he had completed a no-hitter and did not understand why he and his fellow pitchers were posing for a picture after the game. The Lugnuts scored exactly one run in each game of the three-game series at Bowling Green Ballpark in getting swept.

**2019:** In his return from the Injured List, Otto Lopez homered off the very first pitch he saw (thus extending a 23-game on-base streak), and the Lugnuts won at Dayton, 4-0, behind six scoreless innings from Troy Watson.

**Personal:** Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass' like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason after spending 2020 hiatus planning his wedding in addition to preparing for the 2021 season... made seven appearances for the Lugnuts in 2021 before suffering ACL tear... 687 days between MiLB appearances, June 15, 2021, and May 3, 2023, in returning from Tommy John.

**Raising Expectations:** An MLB.com article from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers, specifically, as Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."

**Pro Debut:** Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

**Draft Day:** Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggle and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019... joins 2022 ninth-rounder Caeden Trenkle as Oklahoma State Cowboys on the current Lugnuts roster.

**College Days:** Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater with the intention of becoming a financial advisor after his playing career ends.

**Let Your Babies Grow Up to be Cowboys:** Oklahoma State players in MLB have included Allie Reynolds, Robin Ventura, Jeromy Burnitz, Pete Incaviglia, Mickey Tettleton, Mike Henneman, Doug Dascenzo, Andrew Heaney, Matt Hague and Jordy Mercer.

**Baseball Runs in the Family:** Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

**Hometown:** Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... named All-District in football, averaging 29.9 yards per catch as a receiver with one primary route: go deep... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt; Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland.
