LAST GAME OUT

(MOOSIC, PA, May 7) -The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders had their six-game winning streak snapped Tuesday night at PNC Field, losing the first game of their series with the Rochester Red Wings 8-5. The team did total nine hits, including four doubles.

The Red Wings started the scoring early in the top of the first. Joey Gallo, with Rochester on a MLB Rehab Assignment, reached on an error that allowed Darren Baker to score from third. James Wood also scored on a different error on the same play, extending the lead to 2-0. Travis Blankenhorn followed with his tenth home run of the year for a 4-0 Rochester advantage. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre chipped away at Rochester's lead in the bottom of the second. After Carlos Narvaez walked and Oscar Gonzalez singled, Josh VanMeter reached on an error to score Narvaez. Jeter Downs plated Gonzalez from third with a sacrifice fly to make it 4-2. In the top of the fourth, Darren Baker singled in Stone Garrett and Jackson Cluff, giving the Red Wings a 6-2 lead.

The RailRiders continued to play catch-up in the bottom of the frame. Downs started the inning with a double to left field, Caleb Durbin ripped an RBI single to center to score Downs, making it 6-3. Durbin used his speed to steal his team-leading 15th base of the season. It was the RailRiders' league-leading 53rd stolen base of the year. Rochester extended their lead to 7-3 in the top of the sixth when Cluff hit a 384-foot home run to right field. Drew Millas hit a home run in the top of the eighth to complete the scoring for the Red Wings. Down five runs in the bottom of the ninth, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tried to rally. Luis Gonzalez scorched a double down the left-field line to lead off. Durbin hit an RBI single to center to send Gonzalez home, making it 8-4. Durbin advanced to second on a wild pitch, and T.J. Rumfield drove him in with an RBI double to cut the lead to three runs. Rochester reliever Rico Garcia came in for the final two outs to earn the save for the Red Wings.

Will Warren (L, 3-1) suffered his first loss of the year, giving up seven runs, six earned, on eight hits. Tim Cate (W, 2-1) notched the win for Rochester, pitching 1.2 innings, striking out fourlooking, including fellow rehabber Gallo.

NEWS & NOTES

TOP TEAM: Even with a loss to Rochester, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre are in sole possession of first place in the International League. The team now has a two-game advantage over Omaha and have the highest run differential (+50) in the league.

BURDI'S BEST: Nick Burdi made his Scranton/Wilkes-Barre debut in the top of the seventh on a big league rehab assignment, striking out all three batters. He tossed just 12 pitches and finished out his workload in the bullpen. The righty was picked up as a free agent in January and made seven scoreless appearances for New York. He was placed on the injured list on April 17 with right hip inflammation.

A GOOD DAY!: The RailRiders love playing on Wednesday's, when they are 4-0 in games. They also are in the positive column for day games (before 5:00pm first pitch), with a 10-5 record.

THROWING GAS: The RailRiders pitching staff has the lowest earned run average in all of Triple-A baseball with a 3.49. Sacramento follows with a 4.07 ERA. The RailRiders have also allowed the least amount of runs with 132 this summer, 16 fewer than the next team. The team are also lead in saves with 13 total.

KEEP IT GOING: Caleb Durbin extended his hitting streak to 11 games last night with a pair of hits and two runs batted in. Teammate Luis González extended his hitting streak to ten straight with two doubles in the contest.

MISCUE MAYHEM: SWB committed two errors in the contest last night that were impactful in their loss. The team has now totalled 29 miscues, middle of the pack in Triple-A baseball. The RailRiders are 13-1 when they do not make an error, but 4-4 when they record two or more in a single game. However, they have not made more than three errors in a contest this season.

SIX INNINGS STRONG: Last night, starter Will Warren went six complete innings for the fourth consecutive time this season. He allowed a season high seven runs, six earned. The RailRiders were 6-0 when a starter pitched six or more frames, but move to 6-1 with a loss last night.

FOR THE TEAM: Jeter Downs smacked a sacrifice fly in the game last night to help the RailRiders get on the board. Carlos Narvaez leads with three to his name. The team has now hit 14 sac flies on the season and have three sac bunts to drive in runs.

LIKE IT A LATTE: Clayton Beeter started his day with a hot latte this morning in case you were wondering. He's upped his game these past few starts, reaching 5.2 innings on 89 offerings in Jacksonville. The righty has lowered his ERA to a 2.74 and is looking for his team-high fourth win of the summer. This will be his second day contest after tossing 3.1 scoreless earlier this season.

MLB DEBUT: Made the 2024 Opening Day roster and his New York Yankees debut on March 29 at Houston...Entered in the ninth inning and threw three pitches, all strikeouts...Allowed one single to Jose Altuve, got an odd 5-6-3 DP, and a flyout; Was optioned to SWB on 3/30

ORIGINALLY DRAFTED: Selected in the Competitive Balance B-Round by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech... received a \$1.2 million signing bonus, over the \$1 million slot value for the No. 66 overall selection... Competitive Balance Round B pick was acquired as part of the Dodgers' February 2020 trade with the Minnesota Twins

YANKEES GOT HIM: Was ranked by MLB.com as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect at the 2022 Trade Deadline in August... traded by the Dodgers to the New York Yankees for LF Joey Gallo at the Trade Deadline on Aug. 2, 2022... was assigned to Double-A Somerset upon the trade... was a Rangers and Gallo fan growing up

TJ TIME: Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

FUTURE FARMHAND: Was one of two Yankees prospects selected to the All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. The righty tossed just nine pitches, five for strikes, to record two outs in the seventh. He got San Diego's Jackson Merrill to ground out and recorded a strikeout against Jackson Chourio. Chourio is the #3 ranked prospect in all of MiLB according to MLB Pipeline, while Merrill stands at #10.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeout

• 2023: In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP... Split the 2023 season with Double-A Somerset (12GS) and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (15G/14GS), combining to go 9-7 with a 3.62 ERA (131 2IP, 105H, 54R/53ER, 75BB, 165K, 18HR) in 27 games (26 starts)... among Yankees farmhands, ranked 2nd in strikeouts, 3rd in starts and 4th in wins, innings pitched and opponents' batting average (.216)... his 165K also ranked eighth among all minor league pitchers... Began the season with Double-A Somerset, going 6-2 with a 2.08 ERA (60.2IP, 44H, 14R/ER, 31BB, 76K, 3HR) in 12 starts... was named the Eastern League's "Pitcher of the Week" from 6/5-11 after going 2-0 and tossing a combined 11.0 scoreless innings over two starts at Hartford on 6/6 and 6/11 (6H, 4BB, 17K, 3HP)... • 2022: Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR.
