**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, look to halt a season high four-game losing streak when they play the finale in a six-game series at the Fort Wayne TinCaps, the High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. The Lugnuts won the series opener in a rout, but Fort Wayne has won the last four games. Today is the 429th all-time meeting between Lansing and Fort Wayne.

Starting Matchup: Right-hander Christian Fernandez, who started the Nuts' lone victory in the series on Tuesday, striking out seven while allowing two runs in five innings, takes on Padres No. 7 prospect Victor Lizarraga, who signed for \$1 million as an international free agent in 2021.

Last Night: TinCaps 4, Lugnuts 0. Fort Wayne tossed its second consecutive shutout, outdueling a professional high 6 2/3 innings from Jack Perkins.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with John Nolan, and via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler.

On Deck: The Lugnuts enjoy a day off on Memorial Day before returning to Jackson Field to host the Cedar Rapids Kernels in a six-game series stretching into June.

### Lug•Notes

**Bagels:** The Lugnuts have been shut out for 27 consecutive innings by Fort Wayne since scoring a run in the top of the 1st inning on Thursday. The last time that Lansing was blanked in two straight games was June 23, 2021, shut out in a full doubleheader by Cedar Rapids 4-0 and 1-0, part of a 22-inning scoreless streak.

Home / Road Splits: At home, the Lugnuts are outhitting the opposition by a .255 to .235 avg. (though they've been outscored by 25 runs), but on the road, the disparity is .211 to .273 (and they've been outscored by 22 runs). The biggest contrasts among players: Danny Bautista, Jr., is hitting .315 at home compared to .185 on the road, Daniel Susac is batting .329 at home (with a .404 OBP and .544 SLG) compared to .222/.300/.302 away from Lansing, and Jack Winkler is hitting .301 with a .402 OBP at home while batting .159 with a .256 OBP away from Michigan's state capital.

Keep it Down: The Nuts lead the MWL with a 1.15 GO/AO ratio and 36 ground-ball double plays turned.

Second Impression Success: Southpaw Hogan Harris fired five scoreless one-hit innings for the Oakland A's against the Houston Astros last night, striking out five in a no-decision. It was Harris's second career MLB appearance. (In the first one, he recorded one out, allowing one hit, five walks and six runs.)

**Stop Sign in Center:** Yesterday marked center fielder **Junior Pérez's** fourth outfield assist of the season in just 26 games, tying him for second most in the Midwest League. Pérez is the only MWL outfielder with two double plays.

**Hogan:** 2022 Nuts prospect **Tyler Soderstrom** blasted two home runs for Triple-A Las Vegas in a 12-11 victory last night over Tacoma. The 21-year-old Soderstrom is now slashing .274/.324/.549 for Las Vegas with 13 doubles, one triple and 10 home runs.

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

#### Today in Lugnuts History

**2012:** The Lugnuts' ridiculous hitting against Lake County peaked with 19 more hits in a 14-7 romp over the Captains, opening with a six-run first inning, and cruising from there. Jon Berti and Kevin Pillar led the way, each going 4-for-6. Lansing collected 49 hits in three days against the Captains' staff

2016: Jon Harris's 30 1/3 scoreless innings streak ended in the third inning, and the South Bend Cubs scored six runs in the fifth and eight in the eighth in a 17-3 win.

**2017:** With two outs in the bottom of the 12th, Bo Bichette chopped an RBI single through the open right side of the infield, bringing in J.B. Woodman to walk off the Great Lakes Loons, 1-0, in a thriller. Patrick Murphy pitched seven scoreless innings, Jackson McClelland blanked the Loons in the eighth and ninth, and Tayler Saucedo held the visitors at bay from the 10th-12th. It was the Lugs' second walk-off win in a four-day span.

**In a Nutshell:** Making second start in this series... started against Fort Wayne on Tuesday, allowing a pair of two-out first-inning runs, but blanked TinCaps over next four innings, striking out seven in Lugnuts' 11-4 victory... idolized Justin Verlander as a kid.

Life as a Lugnut in 2022: Assigned to Lansing on July 10, 2022, after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

**The Early Word:** When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings andmisses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury.

**Home Cooking:** Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include MLB ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

Path Through the Pros: Debuted in 2016 in Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in Appalachian League... missed 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).

2022 Dominance in the Rays' System: Opened this season as a middle reliever in the Charleston RiverDogs bullpen, striking out five in 2 1/3 innings vs. Myrtle Beach on April 10 in season debut; it had been 958 days since his last MiLB appearance on August 27, 2019... pitched out of the bullpen through late May, peaking in final appearance with eight strikeouts in four innings vs. August, May 20... moved into the starting rotation May 26 vs. Delmarva and responded with four scoreless innings, six strikeouts... made five starts in June: 3.27 ERA, 22 IP, 10 BB, 30 K, .195 avg. ... in two starts in July: 2.79 ERA, 9 2/3 IP, 3 BB, 10 K, .263 avg. ... excelled at home (33 2/3 IP, 2.14 ERA, .197 avg., 1 HR) compared to road (24 1/3 IP, 3.70 ERA, .207 avg., 5 HR)... because of change-up, very tough on lefties (.179, 0 HR) vs. righties (.223, 5 HR)... limited opposition to .179 avg. with runners in scoring position.
