HE IS THE KEY-NER: Left-hander Tate Kuehner will make his fifth start of the season in Thursday night's matchup against Charlotte. In his first outing against the Knights he matched his single-game career-high with five earned runs allowed on eight hits and struck out four over 4.0 IP. The 25-year-old has posted a 1-0 record with a 3.92 ERA in four appearances, including a quality start with Nashville this season.

9 ON BLACK: Tyler Black extended his hit streak to nine consecutive games, tying his season-long from last year from July 9-30. His longest hitting streak at the Triple-A level still remains at 16 straight games with Nashville from September 7, 2023 - March 30, 2024. Black finished his night going 2-for-5 with a run against the Knights which marked his second multi-hit of the season and current hitting streak. Over his last nine games, Black is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with a home run, two doubles, six RBI, six walks, and seven runs scored.

HURTS-TO-BE-2: Outfielder Jacob Hurtubise earned his first multi-hit and second multi-RBI game with Nashville, going 2-for-3 with two RBI against Charlotte Wednesday night. Hurtubise posted only five multi-hit games last season, including a 3-hit night against Triple-A Iowa, while he was with Triple-A Louisville early in the year. The 28-year-old has recorded 86 career multi-hit games in his six-year professional career, with Wednesday night being his 25th in Triple-A. He set a single-game career-high with a four-hit game on September 1, 2024 with Louisville on the road in Indianapolis.

SLAM SESSION: Peter Strzelecki allowed two grand slams in Wednesday night's 9-4 loss to the Knights with both long balls coming in the first and second inning of the game. Strzelecki entered the game having not allowed a grand slam throughout his career up until Lamonte Wade Jr. jumped on the second pitch Strzelecki threw after entering the game and inheriting the bases loaded situation in the bottom of the first inning for his first career Triple-A grand slam. The second one came when the Knights strung three consecutive singles off Strzelecki to start the second inning before Jared Kelenic crushed his second career Triple-A slam. The Sounds as a club have now allowed five grand slams to the Knights since 2023. Each of the last three grand slams allowed by the Sounds have come against Charlotte with Dominic Fletcher hitting one off Garrett Stallings on August 26, 2025 in Nashville.

UNEXPECTED REHAB: Major League Rehabber Quinn Priester made his season debut in Wednesday night's loss to the Knights. Priester walked three and hit a batter in his first inning of work before exiting after 29 pitches in the inning. He allowed four earned despite not allowing a hit and it was the first time Priester had given up 4+ runs in a game since August 10, 2025, against the New York Mets and when he surrendered six runs on a season-high 10 hits (2 HR).

IT'S A THREE FOR ALL: Brewers no. 8-rated prospect, Jeferson Quero, started the series against Charlotte off strong with his 3-for-4, 3-RBI day at the plate. He doubled off Charlotte starter Duncan Davitt in the second inning before hitting a single in the seventh. Quero busted the game open with a 3-run home run in the eighth to make it a 5-0 game and put him just a triple-shy of the cycle. It was a season-high in hits for Quero who had his most recent three-hit game on July 17 of last year against Indianapolis at First Horizon Park and just his third career 3+ hit game in Triple-A. Quero added another RBI in Wednesday's loss to give him a RBI in three-straight games, tied for the longest RBI streak for a Nashville player this season. **Quero owns the team lead with 12 RBI on the season.**

THE DOWN LO: Logan Henderson added another solid outing to begin his season with Nashville. The Brewers no. 7-rated prospect worked another scoreless 3.1 IP on Tuesday afternoon to lower his season ERA to just 0.76 through his first 12.1 IP in Triple-A in 2026. Henderson has allowed just one run through his first four games in a Sounds uniform this year. Two of his four games have been against the Knights, who he has held to just five hits over 6.1 IP with eight strikeouts and three walks. Since making his Triple-A debut during the 2024 season, Henderson has made 12 starts on the road and is 6-0 with a 1.43 ERA. He has allowed just nine earned runs backed by 63 strikeouts and 16 walks over 56.2 IP away from First Horizon Park.
