> ON THE RUN: The Shorebirds currently ranked 11th in the league in stolen bases, but have been running much more lately as they have 62 steals in the month of August, which is the most in the league. The most stolen bases they've had previously in one month is 30 and that was achieved in July.

A LITTLE EXTRA: The offense for Delmarva leads the league in extra-base hits this season with a total of 292. They are top five in the league doubles (179), triples (32), and home runs (81).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: The newest additions to the Delmarva bullpen have impressed as Blake Money, Ty Weatherly, Jack Maruskin, Braxton Bragg, Teddy Sharkey, and Zane Barnhart have collectively given up just 2 runs in 14 combined innings with 18 strikeouts. Bragg and Sharkey recorded six out saves in their Single-A debuts.

FINAL ROAD SERIES OF THE SEASON: The Shorebirds continue their final road trip of the season as they begin a six-game series against the Columbia Fireflies after a series split last week in Lynchburg. Delmarva faced Columbia last season just one time and split their lone series with the Kansas City Royals affiliate. The playoffs remain a long shot for the Shorebirds as they enter tonight's game with an elimination number of 5 with 13 games left to play.

TODAY'S STARTER: Deivy Cruz gets the start in the series opener against the Columbia Fireflies on Tuesday night, making his 23rd appearance of the season and 15th start.

LAST OUTING (8/23 @ LYN): Cruz took the loss last time out on Wednesday as he pitched 4 innings, allowing 2 runs on 4 hits. Allowed a home run to Angel Genao in the fourth inning, which proved to be the decisive run as the Shorebirds were defeated 2-1.

vs. COLUMBIA: This will be the first time Cruz pitches against the Columbia in his career.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: At 18 years old, Deivy Cruz was a bright spot in the in the Orioles organization pitching most of the season in Delmarva. He began in the FCL and made 3 starts that covered 13 innings, striking out 17 with 4 earned run allowed. Was moved up to the Shorebirds on June 21 and would appear in 13 games, 12 starts where he finished with an ERA of 4.02 and a 2-5 record. Opponents hit .224 against Cruz as he struck out 52 with 37 walks during his time in Delmarva. He was very effective in his first two months in a Shorebird uniform as he allowed just 3 earned runs across his first 6 starts that covered 26.1 innings in June & July.

REVERSE SPLITS: Despite being left-handed, Cruz has handled rig handed batters better than lefties as he owns an opponent batting average of .202 versus righties with an opposing OPS of .674



FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019. He is the brother of current Oakland A's Outfielder J.J. Bleday.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

HITTING COACH



Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.

DEVELOPMENT COACH



Collin Murray is the Shorebirds Development Coach and this is his second season as a coach in Delmarva and in the Orioles' organization. Prior to joining the Orioles, Murray worked with three other MLB clubs (Tigers, Marlins, and Angels), most recently as a Baseball Information Assistant with the Detroit Tigers in 2021.
