- The Blue Jays tallied nine runs on nine hits, four hit by pitches and four walks to take the series opener, 9-6 from St. Lucie.
- Tucker Toman started the scoring with a first inning RBI double that missed a homer by mere feet. Dunedin's lead grew to 4-0 in the second, thanks in part to a two-run homer from Manuel Beltre.
- The Mets sliced the lead in half with two solo homers in the top of the third inning.
- Jorge Bautista made his Dunedin debut, throwing five innings, allowing 4 earned runs, striking out 5 while walking 2 to eventually earn the win
- Dunedin broke the game open with a three-run fifth inning, scoring on RBIs from Victor Arias, Alexis Hernandez and Jean Joseph.
- JJ Sanchez turned in a 2.1 inning save, working back-to-back 1-2-3 innings to close the victory.

#### CALL IT EVEN

Last night's victory put the Blue Jays back at the .500 mark for just the second time in a month. Before the Jays reached 20-20 last week, the team was last .500 at 9-9 on April 25th. The last time the team was above .500 was April 24, as the Jays dropped to 9-8 with a loss to Jupiter. Dunedin dove as far as six-games below the .500 mark (13-19, 14-20).

#### JAYS JUICE

With Manuel Beltre's homer last night, the Blue Jays have homered in 13 of their last 15 games. Across that stretch, nine different players have gone deep. Dunedin is second in the Florida State League with 33 homers. Dunedin's 22 homers this month are the most in the FSL in May. In six games in Bradenton last week, the team went deep seven times.

#### **TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT**

33 of the Blue Jays 46 games this season (72%) have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 16-16 record in those games. Dunedin has played 15 one-run games (7-8). Each of the Blue Jays' last seven wins have required saves.

#### MANNY LOVES MOM

Manuel Beltre has solidified his status as a mama's boy with his performances at the plate. On Mother's Day, Beltre went yard at Fort Myers on May 12. On Sunday, Mother's Day in the Dominican Republic, Beltre homered again. With his home run last night, Beltre has homered in back-to-back games for the first time this season. 3 of his 4 homers have come this month.

#### **HOW ABOUT HERNANDEZ?**

Alexis Hernandez extended his hot stretch with a 2-4 outing last night. On Saturday night, the outfielder went 4-5 with a homer, double and 3 RBIs. Hernandez becomes the second D-Jay this season to collect four hits in a game. Across his current four-game on base streak, Hernandez is 7-16 with 6 RBIs and just 2 strikeouts.

#### WELCOME BACK, WILLIAMS

First baseman Peyton Williams begins a rehab assignment with the D-Jays tonight. Williams, a 2022 7th round draft pick, has spent parts of the last two seasons with Dunedin, hitting .274 with 7 homers in 45 games. He was selected as the league's best first baseman according to Baseball America's survey of FSL coaches last season. Williams is the seventh minor or major league rehabber to appear in Dunedin this season.

#### TAKE A WALK

This week's six game set pits the Florida State League's most walk-prone pitching staffs against each other. The Blue Jays have issued 236 walks to lead the league, while St. Lucie is not far behind with 233.

#### **RELYING ON RELIEF**

Much of the Blue Jays' success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 3.08 ERA with a 1.20 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 5.79 ERA with a 1.72 WHIP.

#### THE BIG TWO OH

Blue Jays catcher Edward Duran celebrates his 20th birthday today. While not all that old, Duran's plate approach has been wise, walking 20 times while striking out 21 times - the best BB:K ratio on the team.

- Throws a four pitch mix that features a low-90s fastball, slider, curve and changeup. Mid-80s slider has been considered his best pitch by scouts. Slider is occasionally identified as a cutter by Statcast does not throw a cutter.
- Was a three-sport star at Hanford High School... was the school's starting varsity quarterback and also played basketball.
- Was originally committed to Texas Tech out of high school, but Red Raiders pulled offer after a football injury suffered his senior year.
