FRES-NOTES

LIVIING ON THE EDGE: Fresno and Stockton have split the first four games of this series, with Friday's 9-4 loss evening the week at 2-2. Even with the split, the Grizzlies still control the season series at 12-10 through 22 meetings, with two games left to play this week. Fresno also remains firmly in the second-half playoff race that made this series so important in the first place, with a chance to gain ground in the final two games. A strong finish to the series would let the Grizzlies close the week having both won the season series and taken a bite out of the standings gap with Stockton.

PORT WALK: Even with Friday's loss, Fresno's lineup has been the more productive of the two all series, hitting .297 (38-for-128) compared to Stockton's .268 over the four games. The Grizzlies have also out-walked the Ports 28-17 across the set, matching or exceeding Stockton's walk total in every single game this week. That kind of plate discipline has kept Fresno's lineup humming even on nights the results haven't gone its way, and it's a big reason the season series still sits in the Grizzlies' favor. With two games left, that edge in contact and patience gives Fresno every reason to expect more offense down the stretch.

GOLDEN SPIKES ON FIRE: Daniel Jackson has reached base in all four games of this series, hitting .500 (6-for-12) with a home run, four RBI, six walks and seven runs scored. He kept it going Friday, singling home Landyn Vidourek in the first inning and drawing a walk later in the game, extending an on-base streak that's fueled the top of Fresno's order all week. His blend of contact and patience has made him one of the most consistent forces in the lineup regardless of the final score. With two games left in the series, Jackson has been arguably Fresno's most reliable bat throughout.

JACK OF ALL GAMES: Jack Natili delivered the loudest swing of the day for Fresno on Friday, launching a three-run homer in the sixth inning that pulled the Grizzlies within two runs, 6-4, after trailing by as many as five. It was his second home run of the season, and it came with him now hitting .368 with a 1.244 OPS on the year. Natili has made the most of his looks against Stockton all series, following Wednesday's 2-for-3, two-RBI game — which included a double — with Friday's big fly. In limited action, he's quickly turned into one of the more dangerous bats in Fresno's lineup whenever his name is in it.
