SATURDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats came back from two down in the ninth to win 6-4 against the Portland Sea Dogs on Saturday night. New Hampshire trailed 4-2 heading into the ninth before pulling together four runs on three hits to take the lead. Leo Jimenez's sac fly to right brought home Sebastian Espino to make it a one-run game before Trevor Schwecke delivered the go-ahead runs with a two-run single up the middle. Right-hander Luis Quinones made his fourth start of the season for New Hampshire and struck out five in 4.2 innings pitched in a nodecision. Out of the bullpen, four New Hampshire right-handers combined to throw 4.1 innings of just one-run ball. Andrew Bash struck out two in 1.1 innings, Troy Watson threw his second straight scoreless outing with a scoreless seventh, Fitz Stadler (1-0) threw a scoreless eighth and picked up his first win of the season and T.J. Brock collected his fifth Double-A save with a pair of strikeouts in the ninth.

NEVER SAY NEVER: Last night's victory was the first time this season where New Hampshire came back to win after trailing the first eight innings. It previously was 0-29 in games where it was behind after eight. The Fisher Cats have now rallied in the ninth to either tie or go ahead in back-to-back games after trailing by four on Friday and two on Saturday.

BECAUSE THEY GET ON BASE: IF Leo Jimenez continues to own the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League after reaching base for the 24th straight game yesterday...OF Steward Berroa has reached base in 17 consecutive games while IF Damiano Palmegiani has reached base in 14 straight games. These three Fisher Cats own three of the four longest active on-base streaks in the Eastern League.

IT'S TREVOR TIME: Trevor Schwecke is on a season-long eight game hit streak and is hitting .318 in the month of July with five multi-hit games in 11 games played. The utilityman has the best numbers of any Fisher Cat hitter against Portland pitching this season, hitting .381 (16-for-42) with a homer and six RBIs. In this series, he is 7-for-18 with two doubles, a homer and five RBIs.

BATS ARE HOT: The Fisher Cats are hitting a league-best .282 in the month of July, ahead of second-best Akron (.250). New Hampshire also leads the league in on-base percentage (.361) and OPS (.774) this month. This comes after New Hampshire had the second-lowest batting average in the month of June (.214) and scored a league-low 90 runs...Leading the way offensively this month has been Steward Berroa (.349), Phil Clarke (.321), Trevor Schwecke (.318), and Leo Jimenez (.315).

**READY FOR ROBBINS:** LHP **Jimmy Robbins** makes his 17<sup>th</sup> start of the season today and his fifth against Portland. The 25-year-old Orlando native is coming off his shortest start of the year after recording only two outs on 42 pitches Tuesday in a no-decision. Robbins was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the week of July 4-9 after pitching a career-high seven shutout innings with seven strikeouts and taking a no-hitter into the seventh against Hartford..

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (July 23, 2022)---The Fisher Cats tied the Sea Dogs in the bottom of the seventh on a Ryan Gold homer, and went ahead in the bottom of the eighth on a shot from Addison Barger in a 5-3 win at Delta Dental Stadium. Andrew Bash threw four scoreless innings in relief of Adam Kloffenstein to pick up the win.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (54-45) could not hold a 7-4 lead in the seventh and fell 9-8 at Seattle. Jays hit three homers in the fifth, Kevin Kiermaier, Brandon Belt and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. to take the lead. Seattle scored five in the bottom of the seventh and held off the Jays...Buffalo (45-49) gave up four in the bottom of the ninth and lost to the Syracuse Mets 8-7. Ronny Mauricio hit the two-run walk-off homer off Junior Fernandez. The loss spoiled a great game for Spencer Horwitz, who had four hits and drove in five runs...Vancouver (55-33) defeated Spokane 4-2. A four-run first, including a three-run shot by Cade Doughty, paved the way for the Canadians...Dunedin (41-48) shut out Lakeland 1-0 behind four shutout innings of relief and eight strikeouts by Pat Gallagher

LAST TIME OUT: Opened the series Tuesday night with shortest start of his Double-A career- knocked out in first inning by Portland.

v. PORTLAND- Makes his fifth start of the season and sixth overall against Sea Dogs. Still seeking a win. Has allowed exactly three runs in each of his five prior starts vs. Sea Dogs.

2023: Opened season with his third consecutive outing at Double-A without allowing a run. Earned the win 4/8 at Altoona. Picked up second win on June 3 in a 2-1 win over Reading at Delta Dental Stadium. Beat Akron 2-0 on June 16 when he worked the first five, striking out a Double-A high eight batters. Pitched a career 7.1 scoreless innings in a 4-0 win at Hartford on July 7.

2022: Made his AA debut at HFD 8/21- made 5 starts in all with the Fisher Cats and did not allow a run in three of them. At the time of his promotion to NH on August 15, Robbins had an 0-2 record and 3.08 on the season across two levels. Had 72 Ks in 52.2 innings. Started the season with Single-A Dunedin, where he had a 1.56 ERA in six outings (one start). Struck out 26 batters in 17.1 innings with the D-Jays. Promoted to High-A Vancouver on June 7. Was primarily a start with the C's (10 outings, 9 starts). Had a 3.82 ERA and 0-2 record with Vancouver, throwing a career-high 11 strikeouts vs. Everett on July 31.

2021: Missed the entire season due to Tommy John surgery

2019: Threw in seven outings with three starts between Bluefield Blue Jays and GCL Blue Jays. Had a 2.84 ERA with 24 Ks in 19.0 innings across both levels. Totaled season-best seven strikeouts in 3.0 innings on August 7 against the Greeneville Reds.

Obtained: Drafted in the 20th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Rollins College in Rollins, Florida.
