3 coaches join the Captains for the 2025 season in: Bench Coach **Yan Rivera**, Pitching Coach **Andrew Moore**, and Assistant Athletic Trainer **Laura Gutiérrez-Sogel**. Rivera was Lake County's Bench Coach for its 2022 Midwest League runner-up squad.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: Lake County's offense was held to just 1 run on 3 hits, as West Michigan defeated the Captains by a final score of 13-1 on Wednesday night at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

HARTLE'S HIGH-A DEBUT: LHP Josh Hartle, MLB Pipeline's No. 23 Cleveland prospect, got the start in his High-A debut and Guardians organization debut. The left-hander pitched 3.1 innings, allowing 3 hits, 4 runs (3 earned), and 3 walks, while throwing 4 strikeouts in 59 pitches (32 strikes).

BENJAMIN DRIVES IN A RUN: In the bottom of the 8th inning, 3B Juan Benjamin drove in Lake County's only run of the night with an RBI double. **The 21-year-old out of Santiago, Dominican Republic has now hit safely in each of his first 4 High-A games, and ranks T-5th in the Midwest League with a .385 AVG.**

GONZÁLEZ'S STRONG START: OF Esteban González hit a single on Wednesday night to extend his hitting streak to 4 games to start the 2025 season. **Through his first 4 games, the Maracaibo, VZ native leads the Midwest League in AVG (.467), SLG (.800), OPS (1.329), and H (7, tied), while also ranking top-3 in OBP (.529, T-3rd) and TB (12, T-3rd).**

LAKE COUNTY IS BACK: Lake County has had a strong offensive start so far this year. **Through their first 5 games of the season, the Captains lead the Midwest League with 6 HR**, while ranking T-2nd in R (29) and TB (58).

WELCOME TO THE TEAM, MOKORO! Lake County's Bat Dog, Mokoro, is set to make her Captains debut tonight. **Read more about Mokoro's background on Page 3.**

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: This season, the Captains are looking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. **Lake County will look to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.**

TRENDS & NOTABLES

THE 14-YEAR VOYAGE IS COMPLETE: **The Captains won their 2nd championship in franchise history, and their 1st since 2010, the team's 1st year in the Midwest League.** This year marked Lake County's 4th Midwest League Championship Series appearance, and 2nd in the last 3 seasons. The Captains also appeared in the 2003 South Atlantic League Championship Series in their 1st season as a franchise.

REGULAR SHOW: Lake County went 77-53 during the 2024 regular season, owning the best winning percentage in the MWL for the 2nd time in the last 3 seasons. **The Captains' 77 wins were tied with the 2010 MWL Championship team for the 2nd-most in a season in franchise history.**

NO SCORE ZONE: **Lake County led the Midwest League with a 3.55 ERA, securing its 2nd league ERA title and 1st since leading the South Atlantic League in 2003.** Former Captain and current Double-A Akron RHP Trenton Denholm won the MWL individual ERA crown with a 3.29 ERA, while fellow former Captain and current Double-A Akron RHP Carter Spivey finished 2nd with a 3.32 mark. **Denholm was the 1st Captain to lead the MWL in ERA since the team joined the league in 2010.**

TUGBOAT CRUISE: Last year, LHP Matt Wilkinson led MiLB with an average of 13.20 K/9 across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg. He also ranked 2nd in MiLB with 174 strikeouts, a 1.90 ERA, a .169 opposing AVG, and a 0.91 WHIP. **Wilkinson nearly became the 1st Minor League pitcher to win both the MiLB ERA and strikeout titles since eventual 3-time MLB All-Star and 2-time World Series Champion Josh Beckett did so in 2001 across Class A-Advanced Brevard County and Double-A Portland.**

WELCOME BACK, OMIR! On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would be returning for his 3rd season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains franchise history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With a 145-119 (.551) record at the helm, **Santos is 26 victories away from becoming the winningest manager in Captains history.**

CHAMPS BACK FOR ANOTHER: 17 of the 28 players on Lake County's 2025 Opening Day roster return from the Captains' 2024 Midwest League Championship team. This group includes 2 of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 CLE prospects in 1B/LF Ralph Velazquez (#5) and C Jacob Cozart (#16).

M-V-PI M-V-PI: OF Jaison Chourio, MLB Pipeline's No. 3 Cleveland and No. 57 MLB prospect, had a remarkable season last year with the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. **The 19-year-old was named the 2024 Carolina League MVP and Top MLB Prospect, as well as Baseball America's 2024 Cleveland Guardians Minor League Player of the Year.**

NEW FACES FROM NEW PLACES: 3 players on Lake County's 2025 Opening Day roster were acquired in offseason trades. OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 26 Cleveland prospect, was acquired from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for former Captains and Guardians RHP Eli Morgan on Nov. 20, 2024. Then, on Dec. 10, LHP Michael Kennedy and LHP Josh Hartle, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 and 23 Cleveland prospects, respectively, were acquired from the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Guardians also received RHP Luis Ortiz as part of a trade package in exchange for INF Spencer Horwitz.

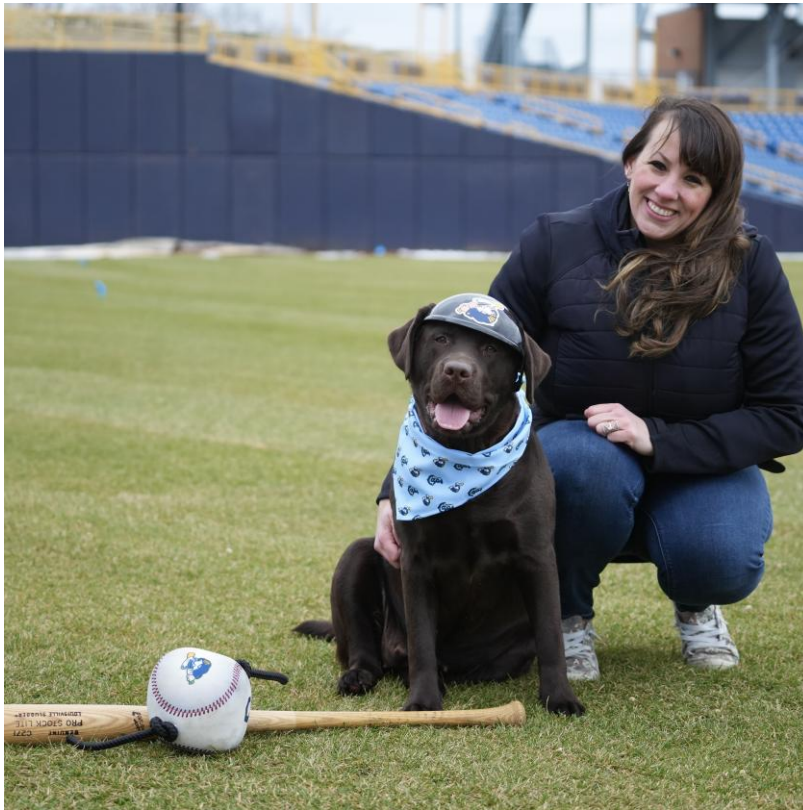

BIO

Mokoro (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy, LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games this season!**

Mokoro is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

LAST TIME OUT: LHP Matt Wilkinson (ND) got the Captains' 2025 Opening Day start on Friday, April 4 at Great Lakes. The left-hander pitched 3 innings, allowing just 3 hits, 1 unearned run, and 3 walks, while throwing 5 strikeouts in 72 pitches (42 strikes). **Wilkinson's** lone run allowed was when a Loons runner stole third base and scored on the play due to a Captains throwing error from C **Jacob Cozart**. However, Lake County would eventually score 8 unanswered runs in a commanding 8-1 Opening Day victory.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Wilkinson is currently the No. 18 Cleveland prospect according to *Baseball America*. **Baseball America on Wilkinson:** "He's a functional mover on the mound despite his size and creates plenty of deception thanks to a low release height and crossfire landing. **Wilkinson** has a three-pitch mix that is uninspiring in a vacuum but effective in practice."

A HISTORIC 2024 CAMPAIGN: Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, **Wilkinson** led qualified Minor League pitchers with 13.20 strikeouts per 9 innings and a 37.6% strikeout rate. He ranked 2nd in MiLB in: strikeouts (174), ERA (1.90), opposing AVG (.169), and WHIP (0.91). **Wilkinson became the only MiLB pitcher with a 0.95-or-lower WHIP, 1.90-or-lower ERA, and at least 170 strikeouts in a season since at least 2005.**

2024 HONORS: Wilkinson was named to the 2024 All-MiLB Prospect Second Team and *Baseball America* Second Team Minor League All-Star Team. He was also named a 2024 Midwest League All-Star, as well as *MLB Pipeline's* 2024 Cleveland Guardians Pitching Prospect of the Year and the *Canadian Baseball Network's* 2024 Wayne Norton Award winner (*Top Canadian Minor League Pitcher – Affiliated*). From his High-A debut on May 25 through the end of the regular season, **Wilkinson led High-A in ERA (2.30) and opposing AVG (.174), while leading the Midwest League in strikeouts (103).** He also finished 2nd in both the Midwest League and High-A in WHIP (0.98) during this span, going 5-5 in 16 regular season starts for Lake County.

PLAYOFF HEROICS: Wilkinson made 2 starts for the Captains during the 2024 Midwest League Playoffs. The left-hander was the only pitcher to log double-digit innings (12.1) during the 2024 MWL Playoffs, while also leading in win percentage (1.000, 1-0), wins (1, tied), and games started (2, tied). **Wilkinson** saved one of the best performances of his career for last with Lake County's season on the line in Game 2 of the 2024 MWL Championship Series vs. Wisconsin. **The southpaw recorded the longest start of his professional career, pitching a career-high 6.2 innings in his first career postseason quality start.** He allowed just two earned runs, and two walks, while throwing five strikeouts in a career-high 96 pitches (career-high 60 strikes). **Wilkinson ultimately helped force a decisive Game 3, which Lake County eventually won the following night to clinch the 2024 Midwest League Championship.**

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing **Wilkinson** run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels." MiLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote, *"I love it, I love being called Tugboat," Wilkinson said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."*

THE INVISI-BALL: When **Wilkinson** trained at the Okotoks Dawgs Academy in Canada early in his career, a place where he still trains during the offseason, one of his coaches, Joe Sergeant, took note of the left-hander's unique delivery, particularly for his fastball. **"He's just got a certain run and life on his fastball that you don't see in regular pitchers. There's just another gear that comes out of his hand," Sergeant told Ian Wilson of AlbertaDugoutStories.com. "It's just the way the ball comes out of his hand – we call it the 'invisi-ball.'"**

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, 2024, **Wilkinson** made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MiLB.com's Jesús Cano, **Wilkinson became the 5th MiLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hit.** The MiLB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom **Wilkinson** said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (2015).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: **Wilkinson** was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April 2024 as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. **In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing AVG.** **Wilkinson** also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, **Wilkinson** pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO), where he was **the 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year.** In 2023, he went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts), and won the NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series in 2022. Following his 2023 campaign, **Wilkinson** eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, **Wilkinson** had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. **In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat.** "(The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," **Wilkinson** told *The Daily Sentinel's* James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

MORE ON WILKINSON: **Wilkinson** grew up in Ladner, British Columbia, the same hometown former longtime MLB LHP **James Paxton**. Has 2 Australian Kelpie dogs, Reggie and Mookie, named after Baseball Hall-of-Famer **Reggie Jackson** and 8-time MLB All-Star **Mookie Betts**.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains made their MLB debut during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, **INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006.** Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, **LHP Raymond Burgos** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. **Burgos** made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies.
