SHRIMP CAN'T OVERCOME EARLY DEFICIT, FALL 7-3

Both **Heriberto Hernandez** and **Jack Winkler** hit home runs on Wednesday, but the Jumbo Shrimp dropped a 7-3 contest to the Redbirds. With one run in the first and two in the second, Memphis grabbed an early 3-0 advantage. Hernandez homered in the second and Jacksonville pulled within one on **Jakob Marsee's** RBI single in the third. Each team scored one run in the fourth, with Winkler's homer the run for the Jumbo Shrimp to make it 4-3. However, the Redbirds scored one in the fifth and two more in the sixth to put things out of reach at 7-3.

BIG, BEAUTIFUL INNINGS

Over the season's first 39 games, Jacksonville mustered at least four runs in an inning six times. However, over their last eight contests, the Jumbo Shrimp put up four runs or more in an inning seven times. Relatedly, over these last eight games, Jacksonville has piled up 52 runs (6.5 per game). Over the previous 12 contests, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated only 36 runs (3.0 per game - second-fewest in Triple-A).

PINTAREST

Jacksonville outfielder **Andrew Pinter** got off to a slow start to the season, slashing just .240/.296/.280/.576 with two doubles, three RBIs, six runs and two stolen bases in his first 12 games. The Provo, Utah native has been on a tear in the 28 games since. During this stretch, Pinter is hitting .370/.411/.500/.911 with five doubles, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBIs, six walks, 11 runs and 10 stolen bases. On the season, Pinter ranks eighth in the IL in average (.333), tied for 11th in hits (46), tied for 13th in steals (11) and 24th in OBP (.383).

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 20-5 at home this season, tied for the most home wins of any MiLB team while outscoring their opponents by a 111-81 margin at VyStar Ballpark. The road for Jacksonville, however, has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 9-12 on the road, getting outscored by an 115-103 margin. Jacksonville has hit similarly at home (.723 OPS) versus on the road (.710 OPS). However, their team ERA is 2.43 at home (1st, also 3rd in MiLB) compared to 5.41 on the road (23rd).

PÉREZ DAY

Miami Marlins phenom **Eury Pérez** will continue a rehab assignment by starting Thursday's game against Memphis. After undergoing Tommy John Surgery and missing the entirety of the 2024 season, Pérez began his rehab assignment on April 26 for Low-A Jupiter. With the Hammerheads, he surrendered only three runs, two earned, on nine hits in 10.0 innings. He struck out 12 against three walks, working as many as 4.0 innings and 48 pitches in a game. Pérez was the Marlins 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year and was consensus top-15 prospect across the sport in 2023. He made his MLB debut on May 12, 2023 against the Cincinnati Reds. In 19 starts that year for Miami, Pérez had a record of 5-6 with a 3.15 ERA with 108 strikeouts in 91.1 innings. He finished seventh in NL Rookie of the Year voting.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 38 of their last 46 games, with multiple steals in 29 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have seven games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank first in Triple-A and fourth in the minor leagues with 109 stolen bases.

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 38 games, a whopping 28 have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 19-9 (.679) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 21-10 (.677) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 11-6 (.647) mark in one-run games. Those 11 one-run victories are tied for the most in the International League and tied for third in the minor leagues.

SHRIMP BITES

At 29-18, Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2010 Jacksonville Suns also started the campaign 29-18... Five different Jumbo Shrimp rank in the top 16 in the International League in stolen bases.

ABOUT EURY

-Eury stands 6-foot-8, but his parents, Eddy and Xiomara, are just 5-foot-3 and 5-foot-2, respectively. Eury is their only child.

-Pérez signed with the Miami Marlins for a \$200,000 bonus on July 2, 2019 as an international free agent.

-Pérez split the 2022 season between Low-A Jupiter and Double-A Pensacola. In 18 combined starts, he posted a 3-3 record and 3.97 ERA with 110 strikeouts in 77.0 innings of work. Following the season, he was named the Marlins' Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

-When he was coming up through the minor leagues, Pérez was a consensus top-15 prospect in all of baseball in 2023, ranking as high as No. 7 by *Baseball America*. He was called up straight from Double-A Pensacola to make his major league debut on May 12, 2023 for the Miami Marlins at loanDepot park. Pérez did not factor into the decision, going 4.2 innings and yielding two runs on four hits with seven strikeouts against two walks. The Marlins fell to the Cincinnati Reds 7-4. Pérez's first major league strikeout was of Tyler Stephenson.

-Pérez earned his first major league win six days after his debut. He yielded just one run on five hits with six strikeouts and one walk in 5.0 innings in Miami's 5-3 victory over the Washington Nationals on May 18, 2023 at loanDepot park.

2025 SEASON

-Pérez began a rehab assignment with Low-A Jupiter on April 26. Prior to joining Jacksonville, he has gone as many as 4.0 innings in a start and thrown as many as 48 pitches (both May 16 vs. Fort Myers).

2024 SEASON

-Pérez did not pitch after undergoing Tommy John Surgery.

2023 SEASON

-In nine home starts at loanDepot Park, Pérez went 3-2 with a 1.97 ERA (45.2 IP, 31 H, 13 BB, 57 K, .190 BAA). In 10 road starts in the major leagues, Pérez pitched to a 2-4 record and 4.34 ERA (45.2 IP, 41 H, 18 BB, 51 K, .236 BAA).

-Over 183 plate appearances in the major leagues, left-handed hitters slashed just .189/.290/.358/.648 against Pérez. In comparison, over 188 plate appearances, right-handed hitters batted .236/.275/.483/.758 against Pérez.

-Among major league pitchers, Pérez ranked in the 94th percentile for fastball velocity (97.5 mph), the 93rd percentile in whiff percentage (33.7 percent), 92nd percentile in breaking ball run value (9), 88th percentile in expected batting average against (.208), 85th percentile in both strikeout percentage (28.9 percent) and extension (6.9), 75th percentile in chase rate (31.0 percent) and 74th percentile in expected ERA (3.61).
