Aug. 8: RubberDucks 4, Baysox 3: Alfonsin Rosario launched a two-run home run while Rodney Boone and Tommy Mace combined to allow just one run over 7.2 innings to lead Akron to its fifth straight win. The five game winning streak is tied for the Ducks longest in the second half and is one away from tying the season long of six (June 13-19).

<u>Today's starting pitcher:</u> Yorman Gómez makes his fourth Akron appearance on Saturday. The right-hander struck out six over 4.1 scoreless against Erie on Sunday. Since coming to Akron, Gómez has allowed just two runs (one earned) while striking out 13 over 13.2 innings pitched. Combined between Akron and Lake County, he is tied for the lead in the Guardians organization in wins (10), third in ERA (2.52), third in strikeouts (96), eighth in innings pitched (89.1), fourth in average against (.203) and fifth in WHIP (1.13).

Cooper is gold: Cooper Ingle has been one of the best hitters in the Eastern League this season. The RubberDucks catcher leads the EL in doubles (29) and walks (63) while ranking third in OBP (.389), sixth in extra-base hits (38), seventh in OPS (.833), hits (91) and runs (54), eighth in RBI (49) and total bases (147), and ninth in batting average (.275) and slugging (.444). During the RubberDucks current homestand, Ingle is batting .333 with four doubles and six RBI. In 14 games against Chesapeake this season, Ingle is batting .313/.433/.521 with seven doubles and 11 RBI.

<u>Barstad heating up:</u> Cameron Barstad has been on fire as of late for the RubberDucks. The RubberDucks catcher is batting .333 in his last six games including his first three-hit performance as a member of the Guardians organization. Since the calendar flipped to July, Barstad has appeared in 20 games and has recorded 17 hits including 5 doubles and a home run while driving in 13.

<u>Closing time:</u> Zane Morehouse picked up his eighth save of the season on Sunday, which is fourth best in the Eastern League and second best in the Guardians organization. As a team, the RubberDucks are tied second in the EL (HFD 32, BNG 33) and tied fourth in Double-A in saves this season with 32.

<u>Coming in clutch:</u> Jorge Burgos and Joe Lampe have been two of the best with runners in scoring position this season. Burgos is batting .330 with seven doubles, eight home runs and 66 RBI with RISP while Lampe is batting .299 with seven doubles, two homers and 39 RBI with RISP. With men in scoring position and two outs, Burgos is batting .292 while Lampe's average jumps to .320. With a hot road trip that saw him pick up seven RBI, **Angel Genao** is now batting .302 with runners in scoring position with Akron this season.

RubberDucks host the Baysox: Akron and Chesapeake will face off for the third and meeting between the two clubs and the second meeting at Canal Park in 2025. Akron leads the season series 10-5 between the two teams. Akron leads the all-time series between the two franchises 344-275. Top prospects in this series include: Guardians (MLB.com): #1 IF Travis Bazzana, #3 IF Angel Genao,

Welcome to the party: Alfonsin Rosario joins the RubberDucks on Tuesday after being promoted from High-A Lake County. The outfielder was batting .268 with 16 home runs, 12 stolen bases and 47 RBI in 82 games for the Captains this season. Rosario picked up his first Double-A hit in his first game with the RubberDucks and launched his first Double-A home run in this Akron game. Combined between Akron and Lake County, Rosario is second in the Guardians organization in home runs with 17 (Milan Tolentino leads with 18).

<u>Bazzana is back:</u> The 2024 No.1 overall pick **Travis Bazzana** has been on fire since returning from the IL. He picked up two hits in his return on July 18. Overall since coming off the injured list, Bazzana is batting .295 (18-for-61) with 14 runs scored, seven doubles and six RBI in 16 games. Bazzana hit his first home run since coming off the IL on Aug.2, a game tying two-out ninth inning three-run home run against Erie. His last two Double-A home runs have tied the game for the RubberDucks at home with two outs in the ninth.

<u>Good eye:</u> The RubberDucks have walked 453 times this season, which is most in the Eastern League and third most in Double-A. **Cooper Ingle** (63) leads the RubberDucks and is tied for the Eastern League lead. The RubberDucks have worked eight or more walks in a game 11 times this year including 10 walks against the Baysox on May 17 and Richmond on July 11. 15 Akron batters have worked double digit walks so far this season, and six (Ingle, **Dayan Frias**, **Jorge Burgos**, **Jake Fox**, **Joe Lampe** and **Alex Mooney**) have drawn 30+ walks.

<u>Can't start a fire without a spark:</u> The RubberDucks are outscoring opponents 68-31 in the first inning and 124-81 over the first two innings this season. Akron is 51-13 when scoring first (second most wins in the Eastern League when scoring first). The RubberDucks batters have 171 hits the first time through the order this year. **Cooper Ingle** is batting .298 with five home runs in innings where he leads off this season.

2025 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF

#26 Manager Greg DiCenzo enters his fifth season with the Guardians organization. The 2024 season will be DiCenzo's second as RubberDucks manager, and fourth as a manager in the Guardians organization. He guided the RubberDucks to an 80-58 record and an Eastern League playoff appearance in 2024.

Prior to becoming Triple-A Columbus' bench coach in 2023, DiCenzo spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons as the manager in High-A Lake County. He guided the Captains to a 141-108 record in his two seasons including a Midwest League finals appearance in 2022.

A native of Duxbury, MA, DiCenzo was the head baseball coach at Holy Cross for 12 seasons prior to joining the Cleveland organization. The Crusaders went 137-109 in Patriot League play during his tenure, including a 2017 Patriot League Championship, and posted 20-win seasons in 10 of those 12 years.

#55 Hitting Coach Jordan Becker enters his sixth season with the Guardians organization and second with the RubberDucks. In 2023, Becker served as the hitting coach for Lake County.

Becker joined the Cleveland organization in 2019 after a collegiate coaching career that saw stops at Riverside Community College and New Mexico State University.

#29 Hitting Coach lan Forster enters his sixth season in the Guardians organization and second season in Akron. Forster will also be a hitting coach for RubberDucks and returns to Akron after serving as the RubberDucks assistant hitting coach in 2023. He was the Arizona Complex Guardians hitting coach in 2024

A graduate of North Olmsted High School, Forster played four years at Baldwin Wallace University in Berea.

#12 Pitching Coach Kevin Erminio enters his sixth season in the Guardians organization and first season with the RubberDucks. Prior to coming to Akron, Erminio was the pitching coach for the Lake County Captains for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.

Erminio joined the Guardians organization after a collegiate coaching career that included stops as a pitching coach in Oxford at Miami University and 13 seasons at Kennesaw State.

#54 Pitching Coach Michael Poole enters his third season in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. He will be a pitching coach in 2025 after spending 2024 as Akron's assistant pitching coach. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Poole was the pitching development coach on the Arizona Complex Academy staff.

A native of Akron, Poole played at Cuyahoga Community College and Lake Erie College before starting his coaching career at Inspiration Academy (FL) in 2019. Poole was an assistant coach at LSU-Eunice for the Bengals D2 JUCO World Series Championship season in 2021.

#49 Bench Coach Marc Mumper enters his third season in the Guardians organization and first season in Akron. He will also serve as the Guardians organization's assistant infield coordinator. Prior to coming to Akron, Mumper spent 2024 as the bench coach for Lake County.

A native of Highlands Ranch, CO, Mumper played 157 games from 2016-19 for Grand Canyon University. He then went on to coach at the college level in several different roles from 2019-22 before joining the Guardians organization.

#41 Development Coach Seth Caddell enters his second season as a coach in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. Before joining the RubberDucks coaching staff in 2024, Caddell played in the Guardians organization for three seasons as a catcher.

Athletic Trainer Derrik Diaz enters his eighth season in the Guardians organization and second season with the RubberDucks. He also serves as the Guardians organization's assistant coordinator for Dominican Republic Medical Services. Diaz was the Eastern League Athletic Trainer of the Year in 2024. Prior to coming to Akron, Diaz served as the head athletic trainer for the Dominican Republic Complex in 2023.

Assistant Athletic Trainer Karina Gonzalez enters her third season in the Guardians organization and second season in Akron. Prior to coming to Akron, Gonzalez spent the 2023 season at the Guardians complex in Goodyear.

Strength and Conditioning Coach Mo Cuevas enters his 10th season with the Guardians organization and third season in Akron. He was the Eastern League Strength Coach of the Year in 2024. Prior to joining the RubberDucks, Cuevas served as the Guardians rehab strength and conditioning coach in 2022.

Baseball Technology Fellow Kade Enders enters his first season in Akron. A native of Medina, Enders previously worked as an intern for USA baseball, video associate for the Los Angeles Dodgers and baseball performance science video intern for the Tampa Bay Rays before joining the Guardians organization.

We Are the RubberDucks

On October 29, 2013, team owner **Ken Babby** and general manager **Jim Pfander** stood before a capacity audience at the Akron Civic Theater and announced that the team would be known henceforth as the **Akron RubberDucks**. In addition to being symbolic of the fun, family-friendly brand of entertainment offered by minor league baseball, the name also honors Akron's long history as the "**Rubber Capital of the World.**" Brandiose Marketing of San Diego, California designed the team logo, colors, and various marks and insignias. Please note that for print coverage, *RubberDucks* is spelled as one word with a capital "*D.*" In broadcast coverage, referring to the team as "the 'Ducks" is an acceptable variation of the team's nickname.
