WEDNESDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Yard Goats, 5-2. In the second, **Matt Higgins** opened the scoring with an RBI double and later scored on a single by **Diego Velasquez** for a 2-0 Richmond lead. The Yard Goats tied the score, 2-2, in the top of the seventh inning. The Flying Squirrels scored three runs in the bottom of the seventh to pull ahead, 5-2. **Jimmy Glowenke** brought in a run with a groundout, **Luis Toribio** hit an RBI double and **Luis Matos** added an RBI single. **Tanner Kiest** closed his fourth save of the season, working 1.2 scoreless innings. **Nick Sinacola** started for Richmond and threw 4.2 scoreless innings. Hartford starter Bradley Blalock tied a career high with eight strikeouts.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, in the third of a six-game series. This is the only series between the two teams this season. Last year, the two teams met for six games at Dunkin Park in Hartford, with Richmond winning four-of-six. This set is the Flying Squirrels' final series this year against an opponent from the Northeast Division. Thursday's game was rained out and will be made up as part of a doubleheader on Saturday.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won four straight games after going 4-12 in their previous 16 games from July 13-August 2. They had lost five straight games from Sunday through Friday before beating the Curve on Saturday night and Sunday afternoon. In their current four-game winning streak, the Flying Squirrels are hitting a league-best .338 (50-for-148) dating back to Saturday night, which is the highest in the Eastern League during that time.

THE YARD GOATS clinched their first postseason appearance in franchise history by winning the Northeast Division in the Eastern League's first half with a 38-30 record, finishing 2.5 games ahead of Binghamton and Portland. The Yard Goats will face the second-half division champ in this year's Eastern League playoffs. For the season, the Yard Goats lead the Eastern League in stolen bases (157). Hartford's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including RHP Chase Dollander (No. 2), OF Adael Amador (No. 3), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 4), INF Sterlin Thompson (No. 7), LHP Sean Sullivan (No. 16), SS Ryan Ritter (No. 25), and RHP Zach Agnos (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes nine Hartford players, including Dollander (No. 1), Amador (No. 2), Fernandez (No. 4), Thompson (No. 6), Sullivan (No. 13), INF Warming Bernabel (No. 16), RHP Bradley Blalock (No. 20), LHP Mason Albright (No. 22) and LHP Luis Peralta (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Dylan Cumming makes his seventh Double-A start and 12th appearance. He last pitched last Friday at Altoona and allowed five runs over five innings, striking out five. In his previous outing on July 28 against Binghamton at The Diamond, he threw six relief innings and struck out nine, allowing two runs. For the season, Cumming has the second-most strikeouts (107) in the Giants system. Among Giants minor league pitchers who have worked at least 80 innings, Cumming leads the system in K/9 (11.46) and strikeout percentage (29.9%). Cumming began the year with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine games (seven starts). He was named the Northwest League Pitcher of the Month in April after going 1-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP) in five games (four starts). On April 17 against Vancouver, Cumming started and threw three innings in a combined no-hitter with Nick Sinacola and Seth Corry. Cumming spent last year with Low-A San Jose in his professional debut season, going 7-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 34 games (seven starts). He worked as a reliever most of the season before making starts across July, August and September. Cumming began his collegiate career at Chicago State, where he pitched three seasons before the program was disbanded in 2020. He pitched his final two seasons at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Va., and was with the Burlington Sock Puppets in the 2022 summer, where he was selected as an Appalachian League All-Star. Cumming signed with the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on February 25, 2023. For more on Cumming, see page two.

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Jarrod Cande makes his 21st start of the season and the first of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Friday at Reading and allowed two runs over six innings, striking out four. His previous outing on July 26 against the Senators, he threw a season high seven scoreless innings. Cande is in his first Double-A season. In the Eastern League this year, he is ranked tied for eighth in BAA (.238). He was selected by the Rockies in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Florida Southern, where he was teammates with Vaun Brown for two seasons. Cande began his collegiate career with two years at Sanford. He spent last season with High-A Spokane and went 4-4 with a 3.25 ERA in 19 starts.

HIT PARADE: Dating back to Saturday, the Flying Squirrels have 50 hits over four games, combining for a league-leading .338 (50-for-148) batting average. They have at least 10 hits in each of those games. On Saturday in a 4-1 win at Altoona, the Flying Squirrels had 10 hits. On Sunday afternoon in the series finale, they scored nine runs and tied a season high with 17 hits. In the opener of the current series against the Yard Goats, the Flying Squirrels picked up 12 hits in a 10-7 win. On Wednesday night, Richmond collected 11 hits and won, 5-2.

COMEBACK KIDS: On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels came from behind to win after trailing by five runs early. The five-run comeback win was tied for the third-largest in franchise history. They have come back to win after trailing by six runs twice, first on July 28, 2017 against the SeaWolves in a 9-7 win and again on July 24, 2022 against the Baysox in a 7-6 victory, Sunday's 9-7 win was the eighth comeback win after trailing by five runs. The most recent prior to Sunday was on June 23, 2023 in the first game of a doubleheader against the Senators at The Diamond, capped with an eighth-inning, walk-off single by **Wade Meckler** for his team-record-tying fifth hit of the game. Sunday was the fourth comeback win after trailing by five-or-more runs under **Dennis Pelfrey**, this most for any manager in franchise history.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 74 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 71. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. It is also tied for the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 againsts Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

KING OF THE HILL: Turner Hill is batting .364 (12-for-33) with two doubles, a triple and five RBIs in his last nine games dating back to July 23, including three multi-hit games. Last Wednesday at Altoona, he picked up three hits, including a double. On Thursday night, he belted a bases-clearing, three-run double. Since his Double-A debut on June 27, Hill is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in batting average (.303).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 44 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .309 (54-for-175) with three homers, nine doubles, eight walks and 24 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 34 games. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 16-of-36 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .307 (43-for-140) in that stretch.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked seventh among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,665), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 59 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is one shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 29 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes an appearance by Andy Thomas on June 1 against the SeaWolves. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season. In last week's series at Altoona, three players made their Flying Squirrels debuts, including Zach Morgan, Justin Wishkoski, and Julio Rodriguez. Pitcher Jack Choate made his Double-A debut on Tuesday night against the Yard Goats.

PROSPECT WATCH: One of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, which is SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: On Thursday afternoon, Parker Dunshee was called up by the Atlanta Braves and made his MLB debut. Dunshee pitched for the Flying Squirrels in 2023, going 4-1 with a 2.56 ERA in 23 games before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento in August. He signed with the Braves as a free agent and had split this season between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett. On Thursday, he pitched out of the bullpen for the Braves against the Brewers and struck out the side in his first full MLP insign. first full MLB inning.

Sharlon Schoop went 4-for-5 with a three-run homer and totaled six RBIs, which was a single-game team record at the time. Darren Ford also had four hits. Nick Noonan hit a three-run homer.
