Today: It's a Big Lug Bobblehead Giveaway and LAFCU Fireworks night, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Lansing is 10-9 against Great Lakes this year and 146-147 all-time after splitting the first four games of this series. The Nuts are currently 5-5 during their 12-game, 13-day homestand vs. Fort Wayne and Great Lakes.

Last Night: Loons 7, Lugnuts 5. In front of 8,203, Great Lakes catcher Griffin Lockwood-Powell belted a three-run go-ahead home run in the top of the ninth inning, completing the third cycle in Loons franchise history, to launch the visitors to the victory. In the losing cause, Colby Thomas went 4-for-5 with two singles and two doubles – but grounded into a double play with Daniel Susac aboard in the bottom of the ninth, ending the game.

Crowd Control: Last night's crowd of 8,203 was the fifth largest Lugnuts attendance of the year and the sixth crowd drawn this season above 8,000, a larger crowd than Wisconsin, Quad Cities, Peoria, Great Lakes, Cedar Rapids and Beloit have drawn all this season. Lansing has the two largest gates in the Midwest League in 2023 with 11,521 on July 4th and 9,128 on May 31st. After averaging 2,648 per game during a frigid April, the Nuts drew an average of 4,054 per game in May; 5,396 per game in June; 5,581 per game in July; and are currently averaging 5,760 per game in August, totaling 260,375 fans overall this year.

Home Cooking: The Lugnuts' offense has responded to the large crowds this season, topping the circuit in home batting average (.258), home base hits (481), home triples (17), and home total bases (763), and ranking second in doubles (101) and third in home roundtrippers (49).

Pitcher's Best Friend: After turning another double play yesterday, the Nuts now lead the league with 105 double plays turned

Saving the Day: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 13 in 16 games played in August (81%).

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .271 (79-for-291). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - .297/.384/.484, .868 OPS. He has reached base 39 times in the last 20 games thanks to 26 hits and 13 walks.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has the A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon Univeristy. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop Max Muncy, opened the year on the Lugnuts' roster after first joining the team last year, where he was teammates with 2020 first-rounder Tyler Sodestrom. Muncy is now withMidland; Soderstrom is in the Majors.

No. 2 - SS Jacob Wilson No. 7 - C Daniel Susac No. 19 - OF Colby Thomas Big League Nuts: Eight Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 181 all-time. Those eight: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; and Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11. Davis Schneider, who debuted with Toronto on August 4, played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Marcus Knecht hit a grand slam in a 6-2 win at Bowling Green. He would follow up with another slam the next day in Lansing, the Nuts' only grand slams of the season.

2016: Manager John Schneider mandated that the Lugnuts show up only two hours before Saturday's series opener against South Bend at Cooley Law School Stadium. The offense showed up late during the game – but scored five runs in the bottom of the 8th for a 5-2 victory, ending a four-game losing streak, before a roaring crowd of 8,404. The rally included two run-scoring wild pitches from Cubs reliever Jared Cheek and a two-run tie-breaking triple from Justin Atkinson.

2018: A Harry Potter Night crowd of 10,232 at Cooley Law School Stadium watched the Lugnuts fall to South Bend, 5-3. The previous day's Lugnuts starting pitcher, Osman Gutierrez, was traded to the Miami Marlins before the game for Tom Koehler.

In a Nutshell: Signed by scout Juan C. De La Cruz, who also signed Pedro Santos, Bryan Restituyo and German Ortiz... added to Lugnuts roster to replace the promoted Joelvis Del Rosario on August 17... making his Lugnuts debut today, the 919th all-time Nut... 12th different Lugnut to start a game.

Hometown Hero: Others from La Romana: Ervin Santana, Edwin Encarnacion, Antonio Alfonseca, Jumbo Diaz and former Lugnuts Felix Pie and Miguel Castro.

Road to Lansing: Yehizon was part of an international signing class headlined by Robert Puason... he is the third member of that class to join the Lugnuts, following pitcher James Gonzalez and catcher Carlos Amaya.

2023: Sanchez started on Opening Day for the Stockton Ports, allowing three runs on four hits and two walks in two innings striking out two in a 10-5 loss to Modesto... his finest outing this year came after he was transferred back to the Arizona Complex League, striking out eight Rangers in six innings on August 8... better against right-handers than left-handers: .275 vs. .326 in the AzCL .333 vs. .436 in Stockton.

2022: Turned in several gems for the Stockton Ports as the year went on, turning in five six-inning outings, allowing only one unearned run in 12 1/3 innings in three appearances in July... on two consecutive occasions, allowed four home runs (June 22 vs. San Jose and June 28 vs. Fresno).

Quoting Nathaniel Stoltz: Sanchez still has good stuff, with a sinking fastball that touches 97, a big-breaking slider that freezes hitters, and a decent changeup, but he put up over a 15 ERA repeating Stockton and has allowed a shockingly high amount of homers for a groundball power pitcher. A demotion to the ACL has at least temporarily ameliorated the home run problem, but there's long been a wide gap between the 22-year-old's stuff and his results.
