CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by the Philadelphia Phillies as an amateur free agent on August 1, 2022.

2024: Promoted to Double-A Reading on August 13. Began season on High-A Jersey Shore's Opening Day Roster. Went career-long seven-scoreless innings with five strikeouts on July 19 in no-decision at Brooklyn. 6.2 innings on July 9 vs Hudson Valley, allowing two runs and one-earned. Took loss on July 1 at Wilmington, allowing six runs on three home runs. Earned win with six innings of one-run ball on May 11 vs Wilmington. Earned win with six-scoreless frames, striking out eight, on May 4 vs Bowling Green. Was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week following start. Struck out career-high nine over six innings on Apr. 16 in win vs Brooklyn. Also allowed just one-earned run. Had back-to-back wins to open season. Struck out nine batters in 8.2 innings at the national finals and posted 3.12 ERA. Named second team All-PSAC East.
