LAST NIGHT: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (30-24, 66-56) fell to the Corpus Christi Hooks (27-27, 58-65), 7-3, on Thursday night at HODGETOWN. Corpus Christi jumped out to a two-run lead when Will Bush launched a two-run home run in the first inning. **Cristofer Torin** put the Sodpodes in the run column in the home half by sending an elevated 0-2 fastball over the wall in left center field to cut the Corpus Christi lead to one run. In the fourth, Justin Thomas Jr. drove in a pair on a double to left field and Trevor Austin put Corpus Christi up 6-1 on his two-run single in the next at-bat. Amarillo scratched across runs in the bottom of the fourth and seventh innings to pull within three. However, Joey Mancini was called upon for the final six outs for Corpus Christi and retired the side in order in both innings of work to complete the Hooks victory.

AOA-OK: Avery Owusu-Asiedu saw his 14-game hit streak to begin his tenure with the Sodpodes come to an end last night, but he extended his on-base streak to 15 games with a walk in the third inning (8/11-c)...it remains the second-longest active stretch on the team as **Trent Youngblood** extended his active on-base streak to 16 games by drawing a walk in the fifth...since joining Amarillo on August 11, AOA is batting .458 (27x59) with a .535 OBP, 15 runs, five doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 26 RBI and a 1.620 OPS while leading Double-A baseball in hits (27), total bases (64), and RBI (26)...between Amarillo and High-A Hillsboro, he has now reached base in 22 straight contests (8/1-c).

FOREVER YOUNGBLOOD: Trent Youngblood has now reached base in 16 straight games (8/11-c)...over that span, the utility player is batting .258 (16x62) with a .370 OBP and .468 slugging percentage, good for an .838 OPS.

GRAN TORIN-O: Checking in with another multi-hit effort tonight was **Cristofer Torin**...he has collected two or more hits in six straight games (8/21-c), the longest such streak by a Sod Poodle since Dominic Fletcher (5/8/22-5/14/22)...no player in franchise history has ever had multi-hit games in seven straight contests...Torin joined Wichita's Ben Ross as the only two players in the Texas League this year with a six-game multi-hit streak...over 19 August games, the shortstop is batting .395 (32x81) with 23 runs, five doubles, three home runs, and a 1.035 OPS...he leads the Texas League in runs this month while sitting tied for second in hits and fifth in batting...over his last three series (8/11-c), Torin's 26 hits is 2nd across all of Double-A.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES: By swiping second base in the fourth inning to extend his single-season high, **Drew Jones** became the fifth Sodpode to reach the 30 stolen base threshold in a season in franchise history...he is on pace for 33 stolen bases in 2026, which would tie for third all-time in a single season for Amarillo...Jones also drove in a run on a line drive double to left field to extend his current on-base streak to 10 games (8/15-c).

MENENDEZ AT WORK: Antonio Menendez has been excellent since returning to the Amarillo bullpen on August 18 and continued that trend with 1.1 perfect innings of relief on Thursday...he has allowed one run over 5.0 innings pitched in his most recent four games, posting a 1.80 ERA and 0.40 WHIP as opposing hitters are batting just .067 (1x15) against him.

HOOK 'EM: After a 17-hit performance on Wednesday and batting .410 (25x61) across the first two games of the series, the Sod Poodles bats were limited to just five hits by four different Hooks pitchers on Thursday...the Corpus Christi pitching staff has kept the Amarillo lineup in check the most out of any Texas League South Division opponent, as the team's .239 average and .342 on-base percentage sit as the lowest marks in 2026.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Avery Short blanked Sacramento over 5.0 IP for Triple-A Reno Thursday, allowing three hits and one walk in the 5-0 Aces win.

SUMMARY

- Currently ranks No. 20 in Arizona's top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline).
- Made his professional debut with High-A Hillsboro as the Hops starting pitcher on April 3 of this year.
- Selected in the D-backs in the 3rd round (92nd overall) of the 2025 MLB Draft out of the University of Georgia...agreed to a \$700,000 signing bonus.
- Was taken in the 16th round (474th overall) of the 2024 MLB Draft by the Pittsburgh Pirates, but did not sign.

LAST TIME OUT

- Tulsa's first batter of the game got the Drillers on the board as Taylor Young belted a solo homer in the bottom of the first.
- The momentum for the hosts carried over into the second after each of the first three Tulsa batters reached base safely to load the bases for Chris Newell...the Drillers' center fielder crushed a first pitch breaking ball for a grand slam to quickly put the hosts in front, 5-4.
- Was pulled from the game after his third walk of the second inning...wound up taking home a no-decision as the Soddies manufactured a 7-6 win.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Earned his first Double-A win on July 30 vs. San Antonio after allowing three runs across 5.0 innings pitched in Amarillo's 6-4 victory.
- Tossed a gem in his professional debut on April 3, blanking the Eugene Emeralds over four full frames while striking out eight...Curley would punch eight tickets in three more games to match his career-high before he struck out nine batters on July 8.
- Did not walk a batter until his fifth appearance of the season...had racked up 24 strikeouts in his first four games.
- Earned his first win after blanking Everett across 5.0 innings pitched on May 26.
- Logged his first quality start on June 7 at Spokane after finishing six full frames for the first time as a professional...held the Indians scoreless on six hits and a walk as part of his second of three wins in a row...did not allow an earned run from May 26-June 14 as part of the personal three-game win streak.
- Left the Northwest League ranking third in strikeouts (90), sixth in ERA (4.52) and WHIP (1.42), and 10th in BAA (.289).

SIC 'EM

- Transferred to Georgia for his junior season after spending his first two collegiate seasons at VCU.
- Began 2025 as a late-inning option for the Bulldogs before quickly becoming the No. 1 starter in the rotation in mid-March...posted a 4-4 record, two saves, 3.55 ERA (26 ER/66.0 IP) with 27 walks and a team-high 85 strikeouts.
- Limited opponents to a .179 batting average overall...SEC foes batted just .181 against him...led the NCAA in opponents' average against (.158) through conference tournament play.

SCOUTING REPORT

- Sits at 94-97 mph and reaches 100 with his fastball with maintained velocity through longer outings, producing high spin rates and difficult carry.
- Throws three breaking balls: a high-80s cutter, a mid-80s slider with impressive depth, and low-80s curveball with more vertical snap.
- Will only throw from the stretch regardless if there are runners on base or not, citing his belief in consistency and repeatability in his delivery will provide him success at the professional level.

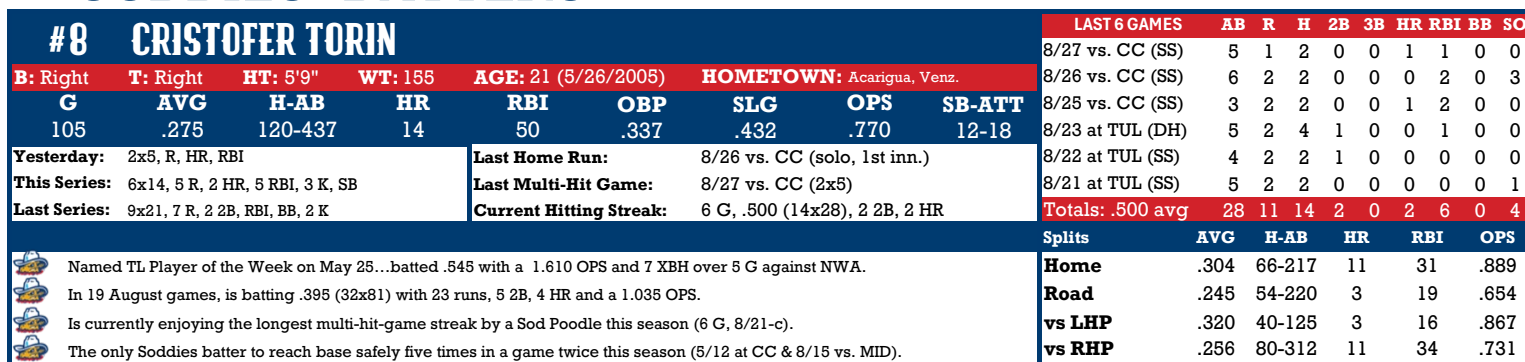
