YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 12-2. Blake Sabol hit a two-run homer in the first to give the Curve a 2-0 lead. Mike Gigliotti closed the score to 2-1 with an RBI single in the second. Altoona scored two runs in the fourth before another two-run homer by Sabol in the fifth extended the lead to 5-1. Andres Alvarez and Nick Gonzales each homered in the sixth to push the lead to 9-1. Armani Smith hit an RBI single in the seventh for his first Double-A hit and RBI to close the score to 9-2. Altoona scored three more runs in the eighth for a 12-2 lead.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The two teams met for a six-game series in Richmond from April 12-17, the first home series of the year for the Flying Squirrels. Richmond won four games in that set, taking the decisive finale with a walk-off grand slam in the 10th inning by Will Wilson. The Flying Squirrels and Curve will face off for another six-game series in Altoona from July 12-17.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS won four-of-six in last week's series at Harrisburg and have won 11-of-17 since April 28. The Flying Squirrels have won four series, lost one and split one this year. They won the season-opening set at Bowie from April 8-10, won their first home series against Altoona from April 12-17, lost a series at Erie from April 20-24, won five-of-six against the Baysox at home from April 26-May 1, split a home series against the RubberDucks from May 3-8 and won last week's road series against the Senators. Richmond leads the Eastern League's Southwest Division by one game over second-place Akron.

THE CURVE have gone 6-11 over their last 17 games since April 28. On the year, the Curve have won one series, lost four series and split one series. Last week, they dropped four-of-six at home against the Patriots. Altoona's roster includes 12 of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including Nick Gonzalez (1), Henry Davis (2), Quinn Priester (4 - on IL), Liover Peguero (6), Matt Frazier (10), Mike Burrows (11), Carmen Mlodzinski (14), Kyle Nicolas (18), Jared Triolo (19), Tucapita Marcano (24), Tahnaj Thomas (28) and Luis Ortiz (30). In the Eastern League, Liover Peguero is ranked fifth in batting average (.309), tied for sixth in RBIs (21), tied for second in hits (38), tied for second in doubles (11), tied for second in extra-base hits (16) and tied for third in total bases (62). Mike Burrows is sixth in ERA (2.35), tied for 10th in strikeouts (40), seventh in BAA (.188), ninth in WHIP (0.98) and tied for first in winning percentage (1.000). Kyle Nicolas is 10th in BAA (.202). Colin Selby is tied for fourth in saves (4).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Matt Frisbee makes his sixth start of the season. Last time out, he worked a season-high 5.1 innings at Harrisburg on Thursday but also surrendered a season-high six runs (four earned), with five of the six runs scoring in the fourth through sixth innings. Last year, he began the season with the Flying Squirrels and went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA in five starts in the month of May, earning a promotion to Triple-A Sacramento on June 3. In 11 outings (nine starts) with the River Cats, he went 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA and was assigned back to Richmond on August 6. He made six more starts to finish the season with the Flying Squirrels, going 1-3 with a 6.16 ERA. On May 13 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked six perfect innings and combined with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo for the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Frisbee was drafted in the 15th round in 2018 by the Giants out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Left-hander Omar Cruz makes his fourth start of the year and his eighth overall appearance. He began the year as a reliever, posting a 1.46 ERA through four outings. He pitched out of the bullpen on April 15 against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond and struck out seven over four scoreless innings. Cruz moved into the starting rotation on April 30 and has gone 1-2 with a 5.52 ERA in three starts. Last time out, he allowed four runs in five innings in a loss against the Patriots on Thursday. Cruz made 14 starts for the Curve last year, going 3-4 with a 3.44 ERA. He has faced the Flying Squirrels once in his career, working five scoreless innings at PNC Field on August 27, 2021. Cruz signed as an international free agent with the San Diego Padres in 2017. He was traded to the Pirates on January 18, 2021 as part of a three-team trade with the Pirates sending RHP Joe Musgrove to the Padres, the Mets sending C Endy Rodriguez to the Pirates, the Padres sending LHP Joey Lucchesi to the Mets and the Padres sending RHP David Bednar, CF Hudson Head, RHP Drake Fellow and Cruz to the Pirates. Last year, he was named an MiLB.com Pirates Organization All-Star.

LOPSIDED: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -8 runs. In their last seven losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 7.9 runs. Of those seven losses, three have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg on Sunday and a 12-2 loss at Altoona on Tuesday. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in six of their last seven losses, with the only exception being a 10-3 loss on May 7 to Akron, and the team is averaging 1.3 runs per game. On the other hand, the Flying Squirrels' last 11 wins in the same time frame have come by an average of 2.8 runs, including four one-run games.

WINNING EARLY: The Flying Squirrels are sitting in first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division, 1.0 game over second-place Akron. Richmond's 20-14 record is tied for the second-best start in franchise history through 34 games, even with the team's start in 2021 and behind only the 2010 inaugural season.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,057). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 44 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (45). Sean Roby is second in the league with nine homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 179 home runs.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last five games played since Wednesday, Brandon Martorano has hit three homers and driven in nine runs. On Wednesday, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup on Friday and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On Saturday, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. Martorano is tied for eighth in the league with 20 RBIs this season.

SHANE TRAIN: On Thursday, Shane Matheny hit a pair of solo homers, the second two-homer game of the season for him and the third of his professional career. He hit two home runs against the Baysox at The Diamond on May 1. He also had a two-homer game on August 25, 2019 with High-A San Jose at Stockton, part of his career-best 10 homers that season. This year, Matheny has hit five home runs, already surpassing his season total of four from 2021 with the Flying Squirrels.

ROBUST: Sean Roby is second in the Eastern League with nine home runs on the season. With his two-run homer on April 29, Roby tied the franchise record for the most home runs in a calendar month, evening Jarret Parker's record of eight from May 2013. Seven of Roby's home runs have come at The Diamond, which ties him for the fifth-most homers in a season at home in franchise history. He snapped an eight-game stretch without a homer with his solo shot on Friday night at Harrisburg. For the season, Roby has hit five of his nine homers against the Curve.

TOASTY: After hitting .263 (10-for-38) over his first 10 games of the year, Frankie Tostado is batting .367 (29-for-79) with three homers, four doubles and 12 RBIs over his last 20 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year. Last Wednesday, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. Tostado is ranked first in the Eastern League in batting average (.333) and hits (39).

WINNING WITH WALKER: Reliever Ryan Walker is leading the Eastern League with six wins this season, picking them up across his first seven relief appearances of the season. In his first two outings of the year, Walker allowed five runs over 2.2 innings. Over his last eight outings since April 17, Walker has not allowed a run, holding opposing batters to a .040 (1-for-25) batting average with one hit and one walk while striking out 12 in 8.1 innings.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Frankie Tostado is ranked first in the Eastern League in batting average (.333), first in his (39) and tied for sixth in total bases (58). Sean Roby is second in homers (9), seventh in SLG (.523) and tied for sixth in total bases (57). Brandon Martorano is tied for ninth in RBIs (20). Mike Gigliotti is eighth in OBP (.396) and tied for seventh in stolen bases (9). Ryan Walker is first in wins (6) and Solomon Bates is tied for second (4). Chris Wright is tied for fourth in saves (4). Jake Dahlberg is sixth in innings pitched (35.2) and tied for fifth in winning percentage (.667). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for ninth in innings pitched (33.2).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-40 Giants prospects, including Will Wilson (14), R.J. Dabovich (17), Tyler Fitzgerald (34), Diego Rincones (36) and Kai-Wei Teng (40). Franklin Labour is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and Brett Auerbach (28).
