## SOUNDS WIN WILD GAME, 12-11

Despite scoring 11 runs on 17 hits - their second-most base knocks in a game this season - the Jumbo Shrimp fell 12-11 to the Sounds. Jacksonville jumped out to a lead with a fiverun second thanks to Victor Mesa J..'s three-run home run. Nashville battled back and grabbed the advantage in the sixth on a grand slam from Wes Clarke. The score wound up being tied at 10 into the 10th, and after the Sounds scored two in the top of the 10th, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only one run in the bottom of the inning to fall. The defeat snapped a four-game winning streak.

## STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Somewhat incredibly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 15 of the last 16 games, with 13 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and seven being scoreless. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 22 runs, 18 earned, on 52 hits ( $7.1 \mathrm{H} / 9$ ) in 64.0 innings for a 2.53 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 57 strikeouts ( $8.0 \mathrm{~K} / 9$ ) against 26 walks (3.7 BB/9) during this stretch.

## PITCH (CLOSE TO) PERFECT

Jacksonville has won 11 of their last 17 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 13 of those 17 affairs. Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville ranks second in all of Triple-A in runs allowed (59) and ERA (3.02). The Jumbo Shrimp rank tied for third in batting average against (.235), tied for fifth in hits allowed (133) and 10th in fewest walks (65) during this stretch.

## ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 15-26 (.366) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 20-15 (.571) road record is one of only seven winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 187 runs in 36 games ( 5.2 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home ( 162 runs, fourth-fewest in Triple-A, in 41 games, 4.0 per game). Jacksonville has surrendered 208 runs (14th-most) in 41 home games ( 5.1 per game) compared to 157 (tied for fourth-fewest) on the road (4.4 per game).

## LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5 -foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 39 of his last 44 games, notching 18 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 61 for-176 (.347/.404/.489/.893) at the plate with 13 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 30 RBIs, 19 walks and 24 runs.

## FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 52 of Jacksonville's 77 games ( 67.5 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 13 of the club's last 15 contests and eight in a row. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 25 of its last 37 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 24-28(.462) in these affairs.

## GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2 -for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 43 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 48 -for-his-last-147, slashing .327/.402/.660/1.062 with 11 doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 33 RBIs, 20 walks and 28 runs scored. Among the 121 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks 11th in HR/FB (26.8 percent). On the season, the 26 -year-old ranks tied for second in the International League in extra-base hits (32), tied for 11th in home runs (15), 13th in slugging percentage (.549), 14th in OPS (.919), tied for 14th in doubles (16) and tied for 17th in hits (65).

## SHRIMP BITES

The 31 combined hits on Wednesday between Jacksonville and Nashville are the most in a game for the Jumbo Shrimp this season. Meanwhile's Wednesday's three-hour and 23-minute affair matched Jacksonville's longest game this season (May 23 at Gwinnett)... Over his last 28 games, Troy Johnston is hitting .337/.398/.548/.946 with six doubles, two triples, four homers, 15 RBls and 20 runs scored... The Jumbo Shrimp's 17 hits on Wednesday was their secondmost in a game this year.
