### Inland Empire 66ers (12-25) AT RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (27-10)



**RHP Peyton Olejnik (0-4, 4.45 ERA) vs. RHP Logan Tabelaing (2-0, 2.03 ERA)**

**TODAY'S GAME:** Tonight is our annual Star Wars Night, with characters and games throughout the ballpark. Fans will also enjoy post-game Fireworks, thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE 66ERS:** Today's game is the 11th of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the fifth of 12 here at home. Last year, the Quakes went 7-5 here at home against the 66ers, 17-7 overall. Four straight wins in this series, coupled with five of six in San Bernardino in late-April give the Quakes a 9-1 mark against the 66ers through ten games.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes scored the final nine runs of Friday night's game at LoanMart Field, as they dropped the Inland Empire 66ers by a final of 9-2. Samuel Munoz (4) ripped a go-ahead homer in the third and the Quakes never looked back, notching their sixth straight win overall. Munoz reached base four times and scored three runs. Eduardo Quintero reached base five times, going 2-for-2 with three walks, an RBI and a run scored. Mairo Martinus, Elijah Hainline and Victor Rodrigues all had two hits each, helping Rancho to a 10-hit effort overall. Quakes' starter Aidan Foeller (2-1) earned the win with five innings of work, while Inland starter Francis Texido (1-3) suffered the defeat.

**WELCOME TEOSCAR:** The Los Angeles Dodgers have sent the Quakes their first rehabbing player of 2025, as outfielder Teoscar Hernandez will join the Quakes for the first time ever. Hernandez has been sidelined since May 6 with a left groin strain and is expected to be in Rancho for just one game. The Dodgers signed him in 2024 to a one-year deal, before winning the World Series and then resigning him to a three-year deal with a club option in 2028. Hernandez played for the Lancaster JetHawks in the Cal League back in 2014, where he hit .294 with 17 homers and 75 RBIs.

**ALL THIS WINNING:** Last night's win gives Rancho their fifth straight series-win and six series-wins in seven total series. They have the best record in the Cal League at 27-10 and are a season-best 17 games over the .500 mark, after winning six straight and 18 of their last 21 games overall. Their home record is 16-3, thanks to six straight wins at LoanMart Field. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history and second as a Dodgers' affiliate.

**OFFENSIVE OUTBURST:** The Quakes have put up some remarkable numbers offensively over the first four games in this series. After setting a franchise record with 25 runs in Tuesday's series-opener, they followed up with 12 in Wednesday night's win and nine in each of the last two games. Over this four-game stretch, they've scored 55 runs on 59 hits over their 32 offensive innings this week. They've also scored in 21 of those 32 innings. Rancho's offense is currently first in the league with a team average of .276 and a league-best 33 home runs in 37 games.

**LOGAN TABELING:** 23-year-old right-hander Logan Tabelaing makes his ninth overall appearance this year and second start, his second outing and first start against Inland Empire. In his last outing, Tabelaing struck out two and walked two over three scoreless hitless innings in a no-decision at Visalia on May 11th. In his only outing against the 66ers, he allowed one run on two hits over one inning in a no-decision on April 24th. The undrafted free agent out of Illinois signed with the Dodgers in July of 2024.

**PEYTON OLEJNIK:** 22-year-old righty Peyton Olejnik makes his seventh start and his second against the Quakes. In one start against Rancho, he allowed four runs on seven hits over 4.2 innings in a loss on April 25th. In his last outing, he allowed five runs (four earned) on five hits over six innings in a loss vs Stockton on May 7th. Olejnik was drafted by the Angels in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Miami (OH).
