dinals were victimized by a big inning for the 2nd straight night as the San Antonio Missions used a three-run bottom of the 7th to defeat Springfield 5-2 on Friday night at Nelson Wolff Stadium. RJ Yeager homered for the Cardinals, a solo shot to lead off the top of the 4th, giving him a career-high 15 for the season. Nathan Church tallied two hits for the Cardinals to run his hitting streak to 9, but Springfield went just 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position and is 2-for-28 over their last three games ...



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander Ryan Bergert makes his 23rd start of the season for San Antonio... The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals! **HISTORIC CARDS MAKE HISTORY AGAIN:** With their 2-1 win over the Missions on Wednesday, the Springfield Cardinals collected their 78th victory set a new franchise record for wins in a season. The 2024 club surpassed the 2012 & 2017 teams who each won 77 games. The wins record caps a season that has seen the Cards notch several franchise firsts.

- » Springfield has won 41 road games this season to set a new franchise record, eclipsing the 38 road wins in 2008.
- » The Cards began the season with a franchise record 9-game winning streak.
- » Cooper Hjerpe and Andrew Marrero combined to throw the first no-hitter in franchise history in a 5-0 win in game one of a doubleheader on June 20 at Corpus Christi.
- » **Chandler Redmond** set the new franchise record with his 60th home run in a Springfield uniform.

**ON PACE...:** With just 2 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- » Springfield's pitching staff is currently 4 strikeouts shy of the franchise record for K's in a season fo 1,263 set in 2019. The strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,277.
- » With an average of .332, Bryan Torres is on pace to break the record for highest batting average held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005.
- With 26 saves, Matt Svanson is one save shy of the franchise record of 27 (Mark Worrell, 2006 & Chris Perez, 2007).

**GRINDIN':** All season long, the Cardinals have been one of the toughtest teams to strike out in Minor League Baseball. The Birds have whiffed 985 times in 135 games and have a strikeout rate of just 19.1%. Both of those numbers rank as 2nd-best in the minor leagues. The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (High-A, MIL) have the fewest whiffs in MiLB (946 in 131 G), while the Reno Aces (Triple-A, ARI) have the lowest K-rate at 19%.

**HOLDING 'EM DOWN:** While the 2024 campaign has been a roller coaster ride of sorts for the Cardinal pitching staff, the Birds' arms have been at their best since the beginning of August, compiling a 3.42 ERA over their last 38 games, a mark that is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of July the Cardinals sported a 4.64 ERA, 9th in the circuit.

**LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT:** While the Cardinals have out-hit their opponents over the last week, Springfield has struggled with runners in scoring position over their last 6 games. Since last Saturday, September 7 against NW Arkansas the Cardinals are batting .120 (7-for-58) with runners in scoring position, and are just 1-for-28 (.036) over their last 3 games in San Antonio.

**YEAGER BOMBS:** Cardinals INF **RJ Yeager** has been a consistent producer for Springfield in the middle of its lineup all season long. With his solo shot on Friday night, **Yeager** set a new career high with 15 HR and is top-15 in the Texas League in both HR and RBI (64).

**CARDS WELCOME BIG BAT BACK INTO FOLD:** Cardinals C Jimmy **Crooks** was activated from the IL on Tuesday, putting perhaps Springfield's most productive hitter back into the middle of the lineup. At the time he was placed on the IL August 27, **Crooks** was leading all qualified hitters the Texas League with a .359 average, 10 HR and 39 RBIs since June 23. **Crooks** is 4-for-10 with a double in the first 3 games of the series.

**TAKE ME TO CHURCH:** Cardinals OF **Nathan Church** has been swinging a hot bat down the stretch in the 2024 regular season. **Church** has hit safely in all 9 September games and has notched multiple hits in each of his last two. For the month, the UC Irvine product is batting .361 (13-for-36) and has 7 BB and an OBP of .465. **Church** was named the Caridnals Minor League Player of the Month in April when he hit .349 with 3 HR, 18 RBIs and a .914 OPS.

**SLAM THE DODR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 26-for-26 and his 51 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer is 16-for-16 in save opportunities. **Svanson** had a run of 19 apperances without allowing an earned run snapped on Sunday afternoon in Wichita when he allowed 2 ER on 4 H in the 8th inning of Springfield's 5-2 win. The Cardinals are 58-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


