AHHH SHUCKS The Maine Clambakes drop fifth consecutive with 10-7 loss to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies on Saturday afternoon. Roman Anothony went two-for-five with a pair of doubles while Nick Yorke went two-for-four. Alex Binelas went two-for-four after launching his first homer of the season. Tyler Heineman made an MLB Rehab Assignment with three at bats as the DH. Binghamton took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning after a bases-loaded walk from Rowdey Jordan would score Matt Rudick. In the bottom of the inning, Anthony hit his first double of the day before eventually scoring on a balk call with Blaze Jordan at the plate. Heineman put the Clambakes on top with a single to center field to score Phillip Sikes. Binelas would go on to crush his first homer of the season to center field. With the three-run shot, Maine led 5-1. In the top of the fifth, JT Schwartz singled to right field to score Thomas to cut the lead to three. Kevin Parada hit a single to left field to score Thomas in the top of the sixth but Portland held a 5-3 lead. Binghamton went on to score five runs on five singles in the top of the seventh inning to regain an 8-5 lead. In the top of the eighth, Rowdy Jordan hit a leadoff single before Jeremiah Jackson homered to left field to bring him home. With the two-run shot over the Maine Monster, Binghamton doubled the lead. Anthony hit his second double of the day and eighth of the season in the bottom of the eighth. The double off the Maine Monster scored Eddinson Paulino. In the bottom of the ninth, a leadoff walk out Tyler McDonough aboard before a single from Binelas put two on. Yorke hit a sacrifice fly to center to score McDonough but Binghamton ultimately defeated the Clambakes, 10-7.

SEA DOGS STREAKS Blaze Jordan is riding a seventeen-game streak while going 25-70 at the plate with nine runs, five doubles, two homers, twleve RBI, five walks, and eight strikeouts. He is batting .357 across those seventeen games which now also represents the longest hit streak in the Eastern League this season. Kyle Teel is also riding a five-game hit streak of his own while going 7-20 with two doubles, one RBI, two walks, and seven strikeouts. Teel is batting .350 across the last five games.

MAYER ATOP THE MOUNTAIN Marcelo Mayer hit three doubles on Friday night after going three-forfour at the plate which is the most doubles in a game for a Sea Dogs bat this season. After another double Friday night, Mayer leads the Eastern League in the category with thriteen total ties for first in all of Double-A, alongside Jacob Wilson (MID). Mayer ties for the lead league with the most extra-base hits amongst Eastern League bats this season with sixteen total, while tying for first in all of Double-A. He ranks third in hits (34) in the league and ties for first in runs (23). Mayer also while ties for the seventh most RBI (19).

TOP 'DOGS Portland currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in doubles with 69 collectively. Portland leads the Eastern League in batting average with a team average of .259 and ranks second in Double-A behind the Springfield Cardinals (.262). Portland ranks third in the Eastern League in homers with 29 total, just behind the Somerset Patriots (33) and the Bowie Baysox (32).

PROMISING PROSPECTS IN PORTLAND The top three prospects in Boston's system (according to MLB. com) will begin the season in Portland with Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), and Kyle Teel (3) headling the Opening Day Roster. In total, the current Sea Dogs roster boasts nine of Boston's Top 30 Prospects according to MLB.com with Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Nick Yorke (6), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25), and Angel Bastardo (26) completing the group.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY: May 12, 1997 – Mark Kotsay hit a sixth-inning home run to snap a 10-10 tie and the Sea Dogs defeated the Bowie Baysox, 11-10. Kevin Millar, John Roskos and Lionel Hastings all homered against Bowie starter Sidney Ponson, who allowed ten hits and nine runs in four frames. May 12, 2016 – Nate Freiman clubbed 2 doubles and drove in 3 runs, lifting the Sea Dogs to a 6-2 win over Binghamton...Keith Couch earned his first win of the season, working 6+ scoreless frames.

PITCHING PREVIEW LHP Zach Penrod will have the start in the series finale for what will be his fifth start of the season. Penrod last pitched on 4/30 against Reading where he tossed 5.0 innings allowing two runs on five hits while walking two and striking out seven. This will mark his first career start against Binghamton after being aqquired as a Minor League Free Agent signing in August 2023.

Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

MICKEY JIANG - COACH

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

KYLE SASALA- COACH

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.


