YESTERDAY: Following a two hour, 33 minute rain delay, the Captains lost a seven-inning game to the West Michigan Whitecaps, 9-2. The game was shortened to seven innings by rule because first pitch was after 9 p.m. (9:33). Rey Rivera homered for the second game in a row for the Whitecaps with a three-run homer in the third inning. The top four spots in the Whitecaps' order reached base in 11 out of 16 plate appearances and scored seven runs. The Captains' runs came on a Daniel Schneemann solo homer in the third and a Bryan Lavastida RBI single in the sixth. Whitecaps starter Beau Brieske earned the win after allowing two runs, one earned, over 5.2 innings. Captains starter Eric Mock allowed seven runs over 3.1 innings to take the loss.

BABY COME BACK: The Captains have come from behind in all four of their wins this series against West Michigan. Lake County erased a 2-0 deficit in game one, a 2-0 deficit in game two, 2-1 and 3-2 deficits in game three and a 3-0 deficit in game four. In the first three games of the series, the Captains' comeback came in the eighth inning or later.

REDEMPTION: The Captains have won four of five games against West Michigan this week, after being swept in a six-game series during their first meeting with the Whitecaps. At LMCU Ballpark in May, Lake County's offense averaged just 2.0 runs per game and slanded. 179/.265/.235. The Captains' pitching staff posted a 5.07 ERA at West Michigan. During this series at Classic Park, the Captains are slashing. 272/.343/.380 and are averaging 4.8 runs per game. The Captains' pitching staff has posted a 3.14 ERA during this home series.

HOME COOKIN': The home team has won nine of the first 10 games between the Captains and Whitecaps this season. West Michigan swept a six-game series against the Captains from May 25-30 at LMCU Ballpark. The Captains have won four of the first five games in this six-game series at Classic Park.

KEEPING IT CLOSE: Six of the first 11 games between the Captains and Whitecaps have been decided by three runs or fewer. There have been four one-run games, one two-run game and one three-run game. The Captains are 3-3 in all close games during the series and 1-3 in the one-run games.

WELCOME BACK: In six games since returning from an oblique injury, George Valera has posted a 1.119 OPS (.435 OBP, .684 SLG) with two home runs and one double.

RED HOT JUNE: Since returning from a groin injury on June 1, Quentin Holmes has posted a .974 OPS with a home run, a triple, five RBI, four walks and three steals. Brayan Rocchio has a .963 OPS in June with three homers and six doubles. Will Brennan has 10 extra-base hits (two homers, seven doubles, one triple) in 16 games for a .516 slugging percentage and an .829 OPS.

Austen Wade has a .417 on-base percentage, thanks to nine walks in 11 games.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is second in the High-A Central League (HAC) in doubles (16), third in hits (41), tied for third in extra-base hits (19) and sits fifth in batting average (.297).

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains SS Ernie Clement became the 101st former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 13. Nine former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and RHP Eli Morgan (2018) and Clement. That ties the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, matching 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on Tuesday, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

LAST TIME OUT: Hickman allowed six runs over two innings at Fort Wayne last Sunday, but did not factor in the decision. The right-hander escaped a bases-loaded jam in the first before allowing six runs in the second. The Captains were down 6-1, but rallied to tie the score at 6-6. **Victor Nova** knotted the score with an RBi single in the top of the eighth, but the TinCaps scored a run in the bottom of the eighth against Captains reliever **Kevin Coulter** to beat Lake County, 7-6.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Hickman was named a Preseason All-American by *Collegiate Game*, and Second Team Preseason All-America by *Perfect Game* before the shortened 2020 season.

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Hickman in the fifth round (154th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. This was considered a bit of a steal by some outlets with both *Perfect Game* and *Baseball America* ranking Hickman as the 65th best draft prospect entering the draft.

COLLEGE WORLD SERIES CLINCHER: Hickman's shining moment at Vanderbilt came in 2019 as he helped lead the Commodores to their second National Championship in school history. In the series clinching win, Hickman started for Vanderbilt tossing six strong innings, allowing just one run while fanning 10 Wolverines in the 8-2 win. He also started in the CWS semifinals against Louisville throwing six scoreless frames and surrendering just two hits with three strikeouts. In four total NCAA Tournament starts he went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings.

CAPTAINS AND VANDY: Hickman is just the second Captain ever to come out Vanderbilt. The first and only other Commodore to come to Lake County was catcher on the 2003 Captains and Lake County Manager in 2012, David Wallace.

STAFF LEADER: In 2019 Hickman found himself starting 2019 out of the bullpen despite being the teams Sunday starter as a freshman, appearing out of the bullpen three times in 2018. After coming out of the pen in his first six appearances of 2019 with a 2.50 ERA Hickman rejoined the rotation and thrived. He finished the year with a 2.05 ERA to lead the team and finish 4th in the SEC.

COACHES WORDS: Hickman worked with Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt who has built a powerhouse in Nashville churning out top baseball talent. In recent years Walker Buehler, Sonny Gray and David Price among others have all starred in the big leagues after pitching for Vandy. Corbin says "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better as his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does."

STRIKEOUT BUMP: After striking out just eight batters per nine innings as a freshman in Nashville, Hickman saw an increase in whiffs towards the end of his sophomore season. In his final six starts of the season he struck out nine or more batters five times. He finished 2019 with 129 strikeouts to finish 13th in the country and struck out 12 per nine innings.

PROFESSIONAL STAFF: The teammates Hickman worked with at Vanderbilt have been highly regarded around baseball. Pitchers that Hickman joined in the clubhouse that have recently been drafted include Tyler Brown (2020, HOU), Jake Eder (2020, MIA), Drake Fellows (2019, SD), Zach King (2019, MIA), Jackson Gillis (2019, MIL), Joe Gobillot (2019, TB), AJ Franklin (2019, KC), Patrick Raby (2019, CIN), Maddux Conger (2018, DET) and Justin Wilson (2018, NYY). In 2021, Commodores Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter are both expected to be first round draft picks in 2021 and were teammates of Hickman's in 2019 and 2020. Vanderbilt has also had 12 position players since 2018.
