**LET'S WIN A SERIES:** After winning three thrillers in the first three games of the series against the Charleston RiverDogs, the FredNats dropped a rain-shortened tilt on Friday night, 7-2. Tonight, Fredericksburg looks to win its third striaght series against Charleston behind RHP Marc Davis, who had the best start of his professional career last time out. Last week against Down East, Davis faced the minimum in three scoreless and hitless innings, allowing just one walk that he erased himself with a pickoff. For the first time this week, Fredericksburg faces a left-handed starter on the mound in Charleston's Drew Dowd. The Freddies are 3-3 against southpaw starters this season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jarlin Susana couldn't build on the momentum of his last two starts, issuing six walks and allowing six runs in a rainshortened 7-2 loss to Charleston. The skies opened up in the bottom of the 7th inning, and the wind was so strong that the Charleston staff was unable to safely get the tarp on the field in time. Jeremy De La Rosa hit two triples and scored a run in his third rehab game, and Brandon Pimentel drove in his 38th run of the season to tie for second place in all of Minor League Baseball.

**LEAVE 'EM LOADED**: The FredNat pitching staff have stranded the bases loaded in crucial moments late in all three wins in this series with the RiverDogs. In Tuesday's game, Fredericksburg got a game-ending double play in the 10th with the bases loaded. On Wednesday, Merrick Baldo left the bases loaded to end the game with the tying runs in scoring position when he struck out Christopher Barete. Thursday night, Bubba Hall left them loaded with a one-run lead in the 8th.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 15-1 this season when scoring first, including all five wins two weeks ago against Delmarva, all four wins last week over Down East, and the first three wins this week against Charleston. Last night's game was the first time all season the FredNats lost when scoring first.

**CONTINUED**: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 21 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .246 with RISP, compared to .112 in losses. The FredNats have struggled at the plate with runners in scoring position this week, going a combined 7-for-26 against Charleston, but the FredNat bullpen has held on to leads the first three games of the series before last night's rain-shortened loss

**BULLPEN WORK**: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. In 163.2 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the unit has allowed 40 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.20. The Freddies are also 11/12 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is first in the Carolina League and tied with High-A Wilmington's Todd Peterson for the second-most saves in Minor League Baseball with six. The team is 16-0 when holding a lead after seven, and 18-0 when leading after eight innings this year. Bryan Polanco has been a strong contributor to the bullpen, logging 25.1 innings and allowing just seven earned runs.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 162-130 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Marc Davis is set to make his sixth start of 2024, in his return to the mound from Tommy John Surgery in 2022.

Davis had a promising start to his professional career, as the right-hander posted a 3.97 ERA out of the bullpen in '22, while earning a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod as well.

**JUCO BANDIT:** Davis played three seasons at Florida Southwestern State, a junior college located in Fort Myers, FL. With the Buccaneers, Marc worked primarily as a reliever; 34 of his 44 total appearances came out of the bullpen. He recorded a stellar 3.14 ERA to go along with a 1.41 WHIP for his collegiate career, while striking out a whopping 14.55 batters per nine innings.

**TWO-WAY TALENT:** Davis was recruited as a two-way player out of South Gwinnett High School. He impressed scouts at the plate on the travel circuit, with exit velocities north of 90 MPH as a teenager, and displayed excellent range as a shortstop. Of course, he also possessed a rocket arm, and ultimately chose to focus on the mound.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Marc turned in three shutout innings against the Wood Ducks at home last week. He held Down East hitless, while walking just one batter and striking out four.
